



POST-GAME NOTES

2015 Pac-12 Men's Basketball Tournament
Thursday Mar. 12 // Las Vegas // MGM Grand Arena
Final Score: #4 UCLA 96, #12 USC 70

- With today's victory, UCLA will face the top seed Arizona in the semifinals tomorrow.
- UCLA is now 22-13 all-time at the Pac-12 Tournament.
- 4-seeds now own a record of 19-15 and 12-seeds own a record of 1-4 at the Pac-12 Tournament.
- Hamilton finished the game with not only a career high in points (36), but he also drained 7 3-pointers, also a career high. His 36 points are the most any Bruin has scored in one game all season and are the most points by any player at this year's Pac-12 Tournament. It is also the 20th time he has eclipsed double-digit scoring figures.
- Hamilton also put his name in the Pac-12 Tournament record book. His 36 points are fifth on the all-time single-game scoring list. He passed the likes of Sean Elliott, Gary Payton and Brandon Roy.
- He finished 7 points shy of Washington State's Klay Thompson's record of 43 points when he did it back in the 2011 Pac-10 Tournament. He also was 2 buckets shy of tying the record for the most made shots in a game (15), which was also set by Thompson. Finally, he fell 1 3-pointer short of Thompson's record for most 3-pointers in a game (8).
- Isaac Hamilton exploded for 18 points in the first half today. He had scored 18 or more points in a single game just 3 times this season.
- The last time a UCLA player scored 35 or more points was when Dijon Thompson scored 35 against Arizona State on Feb. 10, 2005.
- Tony Parker scored 14 points today, the 17th time he has scored in double-figures.
- Norman Powell's 14 points marks the 27th time he has scored in double-figures.
- Bryce Alford assisted on 7 made baskets today. That is the 13th time he has recorded 6+ assists this season.
- UCLA is now 16-1 when leading at halftime, 16-3 when shooting better than their opponent, 11-1 when they shoot better than 40% from 3-point range and 7-0 when they shoot above 50% from the field.
- Today's game is the 3rd time that UCLA has eclipsed the 90-point mark.
- USC had held its previous 5 opponents to a combined 37.5% shooting. Today was a much different story as UCLA shot 38-for-63 (60.3%).
- Following possibly the best game of his career, Elijah Stewart scored in double-figures for the 6th time in his last 8 games. He finished the game with 12 points.
- Katin Reinhardt scored in double-figures for the 20th time this season after scoring 20 points today. It is also the 4th time in 5 games he has done so. He improved on yesterday's performance after scoring only 8 points.
- Nikola Jovanovic got back on track after scoring only 8 points yesterday. He scored 17 points today, which is the most he has scored since he tallied 30 against Oregon State on Jan. 24.
- Reinhardt and Jovanovic shot a combined 14-for-21 (66.7%) today. The rest of the Trojans shot a combined 12-for-38 (31.6%).
