



# POST-GAME NOTES

2015 Pac-12 Men's Basketball Tournament  
Thursday Mar. 12 // Las Vegas // MGM Grand Arena  
Final Score: #3 Utah 80, #6 Stanford 56

- With today's victory, Utah will take on 2nd-seeded Oregon in the semifinals tomorrow.
- Utah is now 4-3 all-time in the Pac-12 Tournament.
- 3-seeds are now 22-13 and 6-seeds are now 11-15 all-time at the Pac-12 Tournament.
- Delon Wright's 20 points marks the 25th time he has scored in double figures this season. It is also the 7th time he has scored 20+ points in a game. Wright has led the Utes in scoring 14 times this season.
- Wright also tied his season high with 3 blocked shots today.
- Jordan Loveridge tied his season high in points with 18 today. The last time he scored 18 occurred back in November when Stanford beat Ball State on opening night.
- Loveridge also set a new season high in shots made as he buried 7 today. His previous season high was 6 against Washington State on Jan. 21. He also tied his career high in assists after dishing 5 helpers today.
- Jakob Poeltl had a nice game in the post today. He shot 5-for-7 and scored 16 points. It is the 8th time he has scored in double figures this year.
- It was a 3-man show today for the Utes as Wright, Loveridge and Poeltl scored 54 of Utah's 80 points. The trio also shot a combined 19-for-28 from the field. Loveridge and Wright combined to shoot 7-for-9 from long range as well.
- Starting at the 11:15 mark in the second half, Utah really started rolling. Over the next 8:50, the Utes went on a 24-3 run to close the game out.
- Utah has been rather consistent on the defensive end this season. The Utes are holding its opponents to 57.4 points per game this year, and allowed 56 today. Also, teams are shooting 38.0% against Utah, and Stanford shot 37.3% today.
- The Utes are now 3-5 when trailing at halftime, 22-2 when shooting a higher percentage than the opponent, 13-1 when shooting 50% or better from the field, 18-3 when shooting better from 3-point range than the opponent and 19-2 when outrebounding their opponent.
- Utah dominated the second half in all aspects of the game. They outscored Stanford 46-17, outrebounded them 29-5, out shot them by 25% and made 5 more 3-pointers.
- This is the 15th time that Utah has beaten its opponent by 20+ points, which is the most of any team in the country.
- Chasson Randle was able to get back on track after scoring just 10 points in the first round, about 9 fewer than his season average. He tallied 12 points in the first half alone and finished with 22.
- Today's performance by Randle is the 31st time he has scored in double figures and is the 14th time he has scored 20+ points.
- Randle's 2 points is the most he has scored since Jan. 31 when he had 33 against Washington State.
- It looked like Stefan Nastic was still rolling from yesterday's 21-point performance as he scored 11 in the first half today. However, he was held scoreless in the second half and fouled with just over 4 minutes to play.
- Randle and Nastic scored 33 of Stanford's 56 points and made 11 of the Cardinal's 19 shots as well.
- Anthony Brown was held to just 2 points today on 1-of-6 shooting. That is the lowest mark of the season for him and is just the 4th time all season he has scored in single digits.
