

WOMEN'S OUTDOOR TRACK AND FIELD

OREGON captured its third-consecutive Pac-10 title at Roy P. Drachman Stadium in Tucson, Ariz. The Ducks entered the final event with a 2.5-point lead over ARIZONA, and won the 4x400-meter relay to secure their fifth overall conference crown. Four Pac-10 teams finished in the top-10 at the NCAA Championships in Des Moines, Iowa, with Oregon's second-place finish (45 points) leading the conference. The Wildcats placed fifth (35), USC was close behind in sixth (30) and STANFORD tied for eighth (25). Five Pac-10 athletes won individual NCAA titles. USC senior **Nia Ali**, the Pac-10 Women's Track Athlete of the Year, became the third Trojan to win the 100-meter hurdles, joining Patty Van Wolvelaere (1977-78) and Virginia Powell (2005-06). Ali won with a wind-aided time of 12.63. She also placed sixth in the high jump. Arizona's **Brigetta Barrett**, the Pac-10 Women's Field Athlete of the Year, was one of five athletes to attempt 1.86m (6-1.75) in the high jump and the only one to clear the height en route to the NCAA title. It was the sixth time a Wildcat has captured the event. Barrett set a personal record of 1.93m (6-4) at the Pac-10 Championships. Other 2011 NCAA champions were Oregon's **Melissa Gergel** (pole vault) and **Anne Kesselring** (800 meters) and Arizona's **Julie Labonte** (shot put). Oregon's **English Gardner** was named Pac-10 Women's Newcomer of the Year after winning the 100 meters at the Pac-10 Championships and placing seventh at NCAAs. Gardner ran a blazing 11.03 to break the conference meet record set by UCLA's Gail Devers in 1987. Wildcat head coach **Fred Harvey** was named Pac-10 Coach of the Year after leading the squad to the runner-up finish at the conference championships and fifth-place national finish. Four student-athletes were named to the Capital One Academic All-America Women's Track and Field/Cross Country teams. Oregon's **Jordan Hasay** became the first sophomore ever to be named Capital One Academic All-America of the Year in any sport and was also named to the first team along with Stanford's **Katie Niehaus**. Barrett and Kesselring were second-team selections. Arizona's **Craig Carter** was named National Women's Assistant Coach of the Year after leading Wildcat throwers to a successful season.
