Pac-12 teams in the AP Top 25 for the fifth consecutive week: No. 4 UCLA, No. 13 OREGON, No. 16 ARIZONA, and No. 25 USC. The Pac-12's four ranked teams are tied for the second-most of any conference in the nation with the Big 12 and Big East (four), and trails only the ACC's six.

>> It marks the most Conference teams ranked in the AP Top 25 for the longest period of time since the 2007-08 season. (4-5 teams ranked for six consecutive weeks from 11/26/07 - 12/31/07)

Of the 23 NCAA Division I teams with two or fewer losses as of Jan. 10, the Pac-12 boasts four teams in the category, matching the most nationally along with the Big 12 and Big East.

Pac-12 teams rated inside the Top 75 of the NCAA RPI rankings as of Jan. 10 (OREGON, ARIZONA, UCLA, USC, STANFORD, CALIFORNIA, COLORADO), including three in the Top 25.

>> Nine Pac-12 teams are rated inside the Top 100 of the Sagarin ratings.

OREGON's current 13-game winning streak is tied as the fourth-longest in the nation, while ARIZONA's nine-game win streak is the eighth-longest in the country.

>>The Ducks' 12 straight Conference wins dating back to last season are the second-best streak in the country behind Kansas (16).

347

Saturday's "Civil War" meeting will mark the 347th all-time between OREGON STATE and OREGON, the most-played rivalry in NCAA Division I history. The four Pacific Northwest programs (ORE, OSU, WASH, WSU) own the top five most-contested series in NCAA Division I history.

Ivan Rabb, CALIFORNIA

- Naismith and Wooden Award National Player of the Year candidate Ivan Rabb earned his first career Pac-12 Player of the Week award.
- Averaged 17.0 points, 14.0 rebounds, including 17 points, eight boards, deciding free throws and game-saving block in victory at No. 25 USC.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

FAST STARTS: The 4-0 league starts by ARIZONA and OREGON are the best for a pair of Pac-12 teams since ARIZONA and CALIFORNIA both started 5-0 in 2013-14.

ROAD RARITIES: Of the 10 two-game Conference road swings so far in 2016-17, only ARIZONA and OREGON have completed sweeps. During the 2015-16 season, only six times in 48 swings did a Pac-12 team complete a road sweep.

EVERY GAME'S A BATTLE:

Through 22 league games as of Jan. 8:
>> Average scoring margin is 12.6 ppg.
>> 9 have been decided by single digits.
>> 3 has been decided by one possession (3 pts or less).
>> 3 decided by a team's final possession.

HOME SWEET HOME: Three Pac-12 teams have built double-digit home court winning streaks. OREGON owns the nation's second-longest home streak at 35 consecutive games. ARIZONA has won its last 15 at home, good for a tie for ninth nationally, and UCLA has won 10 in a row at home.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

INSIDE THE RANKINGS: ARIZONA's 88 consecutive weeks in the AP Top 25 is the second-longest nationally behind Kansas' streak of 152.

LA-LA-LAND: Two Conference teams have gone undefeated in non-conference play just three times dating to the founding of the Pac-8 in 1967. 2016-17: UCLA (13-0) and USC (13-0) 2013-14: ARIZONA (13-0) and OREGON (12-0) 1994-95: STANFORD (9-0) and UCLA (9-0)

WEST COAST BLOCK PARTY: Four Pac-12 teams are ranked inside the national top 10 in blocked shots: OREGON (1st, 7.4 bpg), WASHINGTON (T5th, 6.6 bpg), UCLA (8th, 6.2 bpg) and USC (9th, 6.2 bpg).

INSTANT OFFENSE: A third of the Pac-12's Top 30 scorers, including six of the Top 10, are in their first seasons in the league:

RECORDS WATCH

OREGON (7.4 bpg, 1st in NCAA) and WASHINGTON (6.6 bpg, T5th in NCAA) are ahead of the Huskies' record-setting block mark of 6.59 set last season.

At his current clip of 22.1 points per game, WASHINGTON's **Markelle Fultz** is aiming to become the first freshman to lead the league in scoring since CALIFORNIA's **Shareef Abdur-Rahim** in 1995-96 (Conference freshman record 21.1 ppg). Fultz would be only the third freshmen to pace the league in scoring along with **Abdur-Rahim** and **Cliff Robinson** (USC, 1977-78).

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** is closing in on the Pac-12 career Top 10 in three-point field goals as his 266 triples (4th active in NCAA, most among Power 6 players) are seven shy of 10th-place Ty Abbott's 273 at ASU from 2008-11. Alford's 1,650 career points are the most among active players from Power 6 programs and rank 72nd in Conference history.

The 49 career double-doubles for WASHINGTON STATE senior **Josh Hawkinson** are the highest active total in NCAA Division I. Hawkinson is also third among active Division I players in rebounding with 857 career caroms, a total which currently ranks 44th in Pac-12 history.

OREGON junior **Jordan Bell** (182 blocks) and COLORADO senior **Wesley Gordon** (182 blocks) are both nearing the Pac-12's career Top 10 in blocked shots, just shy of 10th place Jelani McCoy's 188 (UCLA, 1996-98).

IVAN RABB, CALIFORNIA
Sophomore, 6-11, F, Oakland, Calif.

- Naismith and Wooden Award National Player of the Year candidate **Ivan Rabb** earned his first career Pac-12 Player of the Week award in voting conducted by media who cover the league.
- The AP preseason All-American and Karl Malone Power Forward of the Year nominee from Oakland, Calif., averaged a double-double of 17.0 points and 14.0 rebounds, along with 2.0 steals, 1.5 blocks and 1.5 assists to lead California to a split of its road games against nationally ranked UCLA and USC.
- Rabb opened the week with a 17-point, 20-rebound effort at No. 4 UCLA. The 20 boards are the most in the Pac-12 this season and most for a Cal player since 2006.
- He capped his week with 17 points, eight rebounds, three steals and two blocks in a 74-73 victory at No. 25 USC, converting the deciding free throws with five seconds remaining and blocking a potential game-winning shot as time expired to give the Golden Bears their first true road win over a ranked opponent since 2013.

Five of the Pac-12's coaches were both drafted and played in the NBA (Alford, Hurley, Krystkowiak, Martin, Romar). The other Power 5 conferences have three combined NBA draftees and players (Danny Manning, Kim Anderson, Bryce Drew).

NCAA Division I national championships won by Pac-12 coaches as players (Hurley 1991, 1992; Alford 1987). In total, current Pac-12 coaches played in 31 postseasons (21 NCAAs, 10 NITs), including 11 trips to the Sweet 16 and four national title games.

// 29 international student-athletes from 20 different countries appear on Pac-12 rosters for 2016-17, including multiple players from Canada (7), Democratic Republic of Congo (2), England (2) and Senegal (2).
