#PAC12HOOPS STARTING FIVE

3

Saturday's showdown featuring #14 ARIZONA at #3 UCLA will mark the third Conference clash between two ranked teams so far in this Pac-12 season. Using combined ranking total, it marks the league's best matchup of AP ranked teams since #3 UCLA beat #11 STANFORD, 67-64, in the 2008 Pac-12 Tournament title game.

>> It's the best regular-season matchup since #3 UCLA edged #7 STANFORD, 77-67, in OT on 3/6/08.

5

Five Pac-12 standouts were named to the John R. Wooden Award National Player of the Year Midseason Top 25 list on Jan. 11 (see Pg. 2), tied with the ACC for the most selections in the nation.

>> The five selections are the most for the Pac-12 since five in 2008-09.

Pac-12 teams rated inside the Top 100 of the NCAA RPI rankings as of Jan. 17 (OREGON, ARIZONA, UCLA, USC, STANFORD, CALIFORNIA, COLORADO, UTAH), including six in the Top 60 and three in the Top 20.

>> Nine Pac-12 teams are rated inside the Top 100 of the Sagarin ratings.

14 & 10

OREGON's current 14-game winning streak is the fourth-longest in the nation, while ARIZONA's 10-game win streak is the fifth-longest in the country.

>> The Ducks' 13 straight Conference wins dating back to last season are the second-best streak in the country behind Kansas (19).

8,668

Through 32 of the 108-game Pac-12 slate, league contests are drawing 8,668 fans per game. That mark would be the highest average since the formation of the Pac-12 for 2011-12, besting the 8,380 average during the 2015-16 season, which featured a 7,732 average though 32 league games.

Bryce Alford, UCLA

- Averaged 26.0 points behind 57 percent shooting from the field (17-30) and behind the three-point arc (12-21) in UCLA's road sweep of Colorado and Utah.

- Erupted for career-high 37 points in 104-89 win at Colorado, tying the UCLA program record with nine 3-pointers.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

FAST STARTS: The unbeaten league starts by ARIZONA (5-0) and OREGON (5-0) are the best for a pair of Pac-12 teams since ARIZONA and CALIFORNIA both started 5-0 in 2013-14. Sweeps this week by the Wildcats and Ducks would mark the best league starts for a pair of teams since the Wildcats and Bears both opened 7-0 in 2002-03.

ROAD RARITIES: Of the 14 two-game Conference road swings so far in 2016-17, three teams have completed sweeps:

OREGON at WASH/WSU

ARIZONA at CAL/STAN

UCLA at COLO/UTAH (*only the 4th sweep of mountain schools since 2011-12*)

During the 2015-16 season, only six times in 48 swings did a Pac-12 team complete a road sweep.

Through 32 league games as of Jan. 15:

>> Average scoring margin is 13.4 ppg.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

HOME SWEET HOME: Three Pac-12 teams have built double-digit home court winning streaks. OREGON owns the nation's second-longest home streak at 36 consecutive games. ARIZONA has won its last 16 at home, good for a tie for seventh nationally, and UCLA has won 10 in a row at home, tied for 24th in the country.

INSIDE THE RANKINGS: ARIZONA's 89 consecutive weeks in the AP Top 25 is the second-longest nationally behind Kansas' streak of 153. OREGON's stretch of 19 consecutive appearances is its second-longest in program history behind 21 from 2007-08.

LA-LA-LAND: Two Conference teams have gone undefeated in non-conference play just three times dating to the founding of the Pac-8 in 1967. 2016-17: UCLA (13-0) and USC (13-0) 2013-14: ARIZONA (13-0) and OREGON (12-0) 1994-95: STANFORD (9-0) and UCLA (9-0)

WEST COAST BLOCK PARTY: Four Pac-12 teams are ranked inside the national top 20 in blocked shots: OREGON (1st, 7.6 bpg), WASHINGTON (6th, 6.4 bpg), UCLA (12th, 5.9 bpg) and USC (16th, 5.7 bpg).

INSTANT IMPACT: Five-or-more freshmen appear in the Pac-12 statistical rankings in six different categories: scoring, assists, assist-to-turnover ratio, steals, three-point field goals made and three-point percentage.

RECORDS WATCH

OREGON (7.4 bpg, 1st in NCAA) is ahead of WASHINGTON's Pac-12 single-season record setting block mark of 6.59 set last season.

At his current clip of 22.2 points per game, WASHINGTON's **Markelle Fultz** is aiming to become the first freshman to lead the league in scoring since CALIFORNIA's **Shareef Abdur-Rahim** in 1995-96 (Conference freshman record 21.1 ppg). Fultz would be only the third freshmen to pace the league in scoring along with Abdur-Rahim and **Cliff Robinson** (USC, 1977-78).

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** has entered the Pac-12 career Top 10 in three-point field goals as his 278 triples (3rd active in NCAA, most among Power 6 players) rank 10th all-time. Alford's 1,702 career points are the most among active players from Power 6 programs (10th active in NCAA) and rank 57th in Conference history.

The 49 career double-doubles for WASHINGTON STATE senior **Josh Hawkinson** are the highest active total in NCAA Division I. Hawkinson is also third among active Division I players in rebounding with 877 career caroms, a total which currently ranks 39th in Pac-12 history.

COLORADO senior **Wesley Gordon** (186 blocks) and OREGON junior **Jordan Bell** (184 blocks) are both nearing the Pac-12's career Top 10 in blocked shots, just shy of 10th place Jelani McCoy's 188 (UCLA, 1996-98).

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

BRYCE ALFORD, UCLA Senior, 6-3, G, Albuquerque, N.M.

- **Bryce Alford** earned his second career Pac-12 Player of the Week award in voting conducted by media who cover the league. He also received the honor on Jan. 11, 2016.
- Alford averaged 26.0 points behind 57 percent shooting from the field (17-30) and behind the three-point arc (12-21) in UCLA's road sweep of Colorado and Utah.
- Alford erupted for a career-high 37 points in Thursday's 104-89 win at Colorado, tying the UCLA program record with nine 3-pointers on 14 attempts against CU. His 37 points were the most by any UCLA player in a road game since Jan. 2003.
- Alford added three more triples and went 6-of-12 from the floor en route to 15 points in Saturday's 83-82 victory at Utah.
- Alford is the active career leader among Power 6 leagues with 278 three pointers and 1,702 points, ranking third and 10th overall in NCAA Division I in those categories. This week, he climbed into the Conference's all-time top 10 in made threes and passed Eldridge Recasner into 57th place on the league's career scoring list.

// Following the All-Star tour of Australia in July, the Pac-12 and FOX Sports Australia have reached a multi-year partnership to televise league games in the country - 21 games including a Game of the Week and eight Pac-12 Tournament games will air in Australia in 2016-17.

// 29 international student-athletes from 20 different countries appear on Pac-12 rosters for 2016-17, including multiple players from Canada (7), Democratic Republic of Congo (2), England (2) and Senegal (2).
