Three Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top 10 of this week's AP Top 25 poll in #5 ARIZONA, #6 UCLA and #7 OREGON, a feat matched only by the Big 12. It marks the third time this season the league placed three teams in the top 10.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

DRAWING A CROWD: 72 games into the 108-game Pac-12 slate, league contests are drawing 8,728 fans per game. That mark would be the highest average since the formation of the Pac-12 for 2011-12, besting the 8,380 during 2015-16, which featured a 8,174 average through 78 league games.

ROAD RARITIES: Of the 36 two-game Conference road swings so far in 2016-17, seven teams have completed sweeps:

OREGON at WASH/WSU
ARIZONA at CAL/STAN & USC/UCLA
UCLA at COLO/UTAH & WSU/WASH
USC at WASH/WSU
UTAH at WSU/WASH

During the 2015-16 season, only six times in 48 swings did a Pac-12 team complete a road sweep.

VS. #: There have been five ranked Conference clashes so far in this Pac-12 season, the most regular-season meetings of ranked league teams since 2008-09.
>> Between 2009-10 and 2014-15, there were three total matchups, now nine the past two years.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

HOME SWEET HOME: Two Pac-12 teams have built double-digit home court winning streaks. OREGON owns the nation's longest home streak at 40 consecutive games, while ARIZONA has won its last 20 at home, good for fifth nationally.

INSIDE THE RANKINGS: ARIZONA's 93 consecutive weeks in the AP Top 25 dates back to 2013 and is the second-longest nationally behind Kansas' streak of 157. OREGON's stretch of 23 consecutive appearances is its longest in program history, surpassing 21 from 2007-08.

WEST COAST BLOCK PARTY: Five Pac-12 teams are ranked inside the national top 30 in blocked shots: OREGON (1st, 6.9 bpg), WASHINGTON (6th, 6.0 bpg), USC (7th, 5.8 bpg) and UCLA (19th, 5.4 bpg) and CALIFORNIA (28th, 5.2 bpg).

EVERY GAME'S A BATTLE: Through 78 league games as of Feb. 12:

- >> Average scoring margin is 13.3 ppg.
- >> 34 have been decided by single digits.
- >> 11 have been decided by one possession (3 pts or less).
- >> 5 decided by a team's final possession.
- >> 3 overtime games (4 total OT periods).

RECORDS WATCH

ARIZONA's **Sean Miller** is the 21st coach in league history to reach 100 career Conference victories. His .741 winning percentage in league games (103-36) is fourth to only **John Wooden** (.810), **Lute Olson** (.764) and **Jim Harrick** (.743) among those to reach the 100-win plateau.

OREGON (6.9 bpg, 1st in NCAA) is ahead of WASHINGTON's Pac-12 single-season record block mark of 6.59 set last season.

At his current clip of 23.2 points per game, WASHINGTON's **Markelle Fultz** is aiming to become the first freshman to lead the league in scoring since CALIFORNIA's **Shareef Abdur-Rahim** in 1995-96 (Conference freshman record 21.1 ppg). Fultz would be only the third freshmen to pace the league in scoring along with **Abdur-Rahim** and **Cliff Robinson** (USC, 1977-78).

With 198 assists, UCLA's **Lonzo Ball** is already third on the Pac-12's freshman single-season assists list. At 7.6 apg, he's on pace to shatter the rookie mark of 229 set by OREGON STATE's Gary Payton in 1986-87.

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** has entered the Pac-12 career top 10 in three-point field goals as his 296 triples (5th active in NCAA, most among Power 6 players) are eighth all-time. Alford's 1,776 career points are the most among active players from Power 6 programs (15th active in NCAA) and rank tied for 43rd in Conference history.

The 53 career double-doubles for WASHINGTON STATE senior **Josh Hawkinson** are the highest active total in NCAA Division I. Hawkinson is also third among active Division I players in rebounding with 952 career caroms, a total which currently ranks 22nd in Pac-12 history.

OREGON junior **Jordan Bell** (201 blocks) has moved into seventh on the Pac-12's career blocked shots list, while COLORADO senior **Wesley Gordon** (195 blocks) is just behind in a tie for eighth and OREGON's **Chris Boucher** (174) is fast rising.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LONZO BALL, UCLA Freshman, 6-6, G, Chino Hills, Calif.

- National Player and Freshman of the Year candidate **Lonzo Ball** earned his second Pac-12 Player of the Week award in voting conducted by media who cover the league.
- The 6-6 guard from Chino Hills, Calif., averaged 18.5 points, 8.5 rebounds and 5.0 assists in UCLA's wins over Oregon and Oregon State. He shot 65.2 percent (15-23) from the field through both games and was 5-for-11 from three-point range.
- Ball had 15 points and 11 rebounds, including 10 points and seven boards in the second half, in UCLA's 82-79 comeback win over nationally ranked Oregon on Thursday before recording a team-high 22 points and nine assists in a 78-60 victory against Oregon State on Sunday.
- Ball appears on the current finalist lists for the John R. Wooden, James Naismith and Oscar Robertson National Player of the Year awards, the Wayman Tisdale National Freshman of the Year honor and the Bob Cousy National Point Guard of the Year.
- Ball's honor marks the sixth weekly award for a Pac-12 freshman so far in 2016-17, the second-most in a season since the award was created in 1983, trailing only the seven rookie selections in 2007-08.

GROWING THE PAC-12 GLOBAL GAME

// This past July, 12 student-athletes from 10 Pac-12 schools traveled to Australia for three exhibition games, two of which came against the Australian National Team - nicknamed The Boomers - in its prep for the 2016 Rio Olympic Games. The Boomers prevailed in both games - 92-83 and 93-63 - en route to fourth place in Rio.

// Following the All-Star tour of Australia in July, the Pac-12 and FOX Sports Australia have reached a multi-year partnership to televise league games in the country - 21 games including a Game of the Week and eight Pac-12 Tournament games will air in Australia in 2016-17.

// 29 international student-athletes from 20 different countries appear on Pac-12 rosters for 2016-17, including multiple players from Canada (7), Democratic Republic of Congo (2), England (2) and Senegal (2).

#PAC12HOOPS IN THE PROS

A total of 56 former Pac-12 student-athletes appeared on 2016-17 NBA opening day rosters. All but one Pac-12 member institution has representation in the NBA, with UCLA (13), Arizona (12) and Washington (8) among the top-10 programs in the nation. The Pac-12 had five players taken in the latest NBA Draft, including an NCAA-best three in the lottery, and have had 28 players selected over the last four years.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE-SEEDING & TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Seeding: The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 4. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Tie-Breakers: Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

- Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.
