Three Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top 10 of this week's AP Top 25 poll in #4 ARIZONA, #5 UCLA and #6 OREGON, a feat matched only by the ACC. It marks the fourth week this season the league placed three teams in the top 10.

Lauri Markkanen, ARIZONA

- Averaged a double-double of 22.5 points and 12.0 rebounds to lead Arizona to a road sweep of the Washington schools.
- Opened with 19-point, 11-rebound double-double in victory at Washington State, then posted first career 20-10 outing with 26 points and 13 boards in win at Washington.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

DRAWING A CROWD: 88 games into the 108-game Pac-12 slate, league contests are drawing 8,599 fans per game. That mark would be the highest average since the formation of the Pac-12 for 2011-12, besting the 8,380 during 2015-16, which featured a 8,104 average through 89 league games.

ROAD RARITIES: Of the 40 two-game Conference road swings so far in 2016-17, eight times has a team completed a sweep:

OREGON at WASH/WSU
ARIZ at CAL/STAN; USC/UCLA & WSU/WASH
UCLA at COLO/UTAH & WSU/WASH
USC at WASH/WSU
UTAH at WSU/WASH

HOME SWEET HOME: OREGON owns the nation's longest home court winning streak at 42 consecutive games, while ARIZONA has won its last 20 at home, tied for fourth nationally.

OREGON (2016-17) has joined ARIZONA (1988-91, 1998-2000, 2014-15) and STANFORD (2003-04) as the only Conference programs to go a perfect 9-0 at home in consecutive league seasons.

PAC-12 TIPOFF

4x20: Four Pac-12 teams reached the 20-win mark by Feb. 4, marking the earliest point in any season since the formation of the Pac-8 in 1968 that four Conference teams reached 20 wins.

INSIDE THE RANKINGS: ARIZONA's 94 consecutive weeks in the AP Top 25 dates back to 2013 and is the second-longest nationally behind Kansas' streak of 158. OREGON's stretch of 24 consecutive appearances is its longest in program history, surpassing 21 from 2007-08.

WEST COAST BLOCK PARTY: Five Pac-12 teams are ranked inside the national top 30 in blocked shots: OREGON (1st, 7.0 bpg), WASHINGTON (6th, 6.0 bpg), USC (10th, 5.7 bpg) and UCLA (16th, 5.4 bpg) and CALIFORNIA (26th, 5.1 bpg).

EVERY GAME'S A BATTLE: Through 88 league games as of Feb. 19:

- >> Average scoring margin is 13.3 ppg.
- >> 39 have been decided by single digits.
- >> 13 have been decided by one possession (3 pts or less).
- >> 6 decided by a team's final possession.
- >> 3 overtime games (4 total OT periods).

RECORDS WATCH

ARIZONA's **Sean Miller** is the 21st coach in league history to reach 100 career Conference victories. His .745 winning percentage in league games (105-36) is third to only **John Wooden** (.810) and **Lute Olson** (.764) among those to reach the 100-win plateau.

OREGON (7.0 bpg, 1st in NCAA) is ahead of WASHINGTON's Pac-12 single-season record block mark of 6.59 set last season.

At his current clip of 23.2 points per game, WASHINGTON's **Markelle Fultz** is aiming to become the first freshman to lead the league in scoring since CALIFORNIA's **Shareef Abdur-Rahim** in 1995-96 (Conference freshman record 21.1 ppg). Fultz would be only the third freshmen to pace the league in scoring along with Abdur-Rahim and **Cliff Robinson** (USC, 1977-78).

With 206 assists, UCLA's **Lonzo Ball** is already third on the Pac-12's freshman single-season assists list. At 7.6 apg, he's on pace to shatter the rookie mark of 229 set by OREGON STATE's Gary Payton in 1986-87. Jason Kidd's 222 at CALIFORNIA in 1992-93 are second-most ever by a freshman.

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** has entered the Pac-12 career top 10 in three-point field goals as his 301 triples (5th active in NCAA, most among Power 6 players) are tied for seventh all-time. Alford's 1,802 career points are the most among active players from Power 6 programs (17th active in NCAA) and rank 36th in Conference history.

The 54 career double-doubles for WASHINGTON STATE senior **Josh Hawkinson** are the highest active total in NCAA Division I. Hawkinson is also third among active Division I players in rebounding with 975 career caroms, a total which currently ranks tied for 17th in Pac-12 history, 17 shy of 15th place occupied by WSU career leader Steve Puidokas and UCLA's Don MacLean.

OREGON junior **Jordan Bell** (207 blocks) has moved into a tie for sixth on the Pac-12's career blocked shots list, while COLORADO senior **Wesley Gordon** (196 blocks) is just behind in eighth and OREGON's Chris Boucher (179) is fast nearing the top 10.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LAURI MARKKANEN, ARIZONA Freshman, 7-0, F, Jyväskylä, Finland

- National Player and Freshman of the Year candidate Lauri Markkanen earned his second Pac-12 Player of the Week award in voting conducted by media who cover the league.
- Markkanen's honor marks the seventh weekly award for a Pac-12 freshman so far in 2016-17, tying the most in a season since the award was created in 1983, matching the seven rookie selections in 2007-08.
- The 7-0 forward from Jyväskylä, Finland averaged a double-double of 22.5 points on 53 percent shooting (16-30) and 12.0 rebounds to lead league frontrunner Arizona to a road sweep of the Washington schools. It marked the Wildcats' third road sweep of the Conference season.
- Markkanen opened the week with a 19-point, 11-rebound double-double in a 78-59 victory at Washington State on Thursday, then posted his first career 20-10 outing with 26 points and 13 boards as Arizona edged Washington, 76-68, on Saturday.
- Markkanen appears on the current finalist lists for the John R. Wooden, James Naismith and Oscar Robertson National Player of the Year awards, the Wayman Tisdale National Freshman of the Year honor and the Karl Malone National Power Forward of the Year.

GROWING THE PAC-12 GLOBAL GAME

// This past July, 12 student-athletes from 10 Pac-12 schools traveled to Australia for three exhibition games, two of which came against the Australian National Team - nicknamed The Boomers - in its prep for the 2016 Rio Olympic Games. The Boomers prevailed in both games - 92-83 and 93-63 - en route to fourth place in Rio.

// Following the All-Star tour of Australia in July, the Pac-12 and FOX Sports Australia have reached a multi-year partnership to televise league games in the country - 21 games including a Game of the Week and eight Pac-12 Tournament games will air in Australia in 2016-17.

// 29 international student-athletes from 20 different countries appear on Pac-12 rosters for 2016-17, including multiple players from Canada (7), Democratic Republic of Congo (2), England (2) and Senegal (2).

#PAC12HOOPS IN THE PROS

A total of 56 former Pac-12 student-athletes appeared on 2016-17 NBA opening day rosters. All but one Pac-12 member institution has representation in the NBA, with UCLA (13), Arizona (12) and Washington (8) among the top-10 programs in the nation. The Pac-12 had five players taken in the latest NBA Draft, including an NCAA-best three in the lottery, and have had 28 players selected over the last four years.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE-SEEDING & TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Seeding: The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 4. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Tie-Breakers: Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

- Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.
