### AROUND THE PAC-12

- ARIZONA No. 3 IN TOP 25:** ARIZONA comes in at No. 3 in both the AP poll and the Coaches poll. The Wildcats have been in the top five of the AP poll for 16 weeks this season, including a stretch of eight consecutive weeks at No. 1.
- No. 1 SEED SET, 11 OTHERS STILL TO BE DETERMINED:** ARIZONA captured the Pac-12 title and with it the No. 1 seed in next week's Pac-12 Tournament in Las Vegas at the MGM Grand Garden Arena. It's the 13th league title for the Wildcats, and first since 2011. With one week to go in league play, all remaining seeds are still up for grabs. (*See tie-breaker procedures on page 3*).
- The Pac-12 continues to rank third in the Sagarin conference ratings thanks in large part to eight league teams listed among the top 60. Seven Pac-12 teams were among the top 53 in the latest NCAA RPI (see page 5 for Pac-12 rankings). No other conference has more teams ranked in the top 53 than the Pac-12.
- The Pac-12 posted a 94-6 (.940) home record in non-league play this season. In league play, home teams are 65-31 (.677) in Pac-12 play. . . ARIZONA was perfect at home this season, posting a 18-0 mark. The Wildcats have won 21 straight in McKale Center. . . One other team had just one blemish on its home court record this season - ARIZONA STATE (16-1).

## PAC-12 MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### MIKE MOSER, F, OREGON

OREGON senior forward **Mike Moser** has been named Pac-12 Men's Basketball Player of the Week for play from Feb. 24-Mar. 2, the Conference office announced today.

The Portland, Ore., native averaged 16.0 points, 16.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists to lead Oregon to a road sweep in Los Angeles. In the 87-83 double-overtime victory over UCLA, Moser recorded 20 rebounds, the most by an Oregon player in 37 years since Greg Ballard reached 20 boards in a five-overtime game in 1977. The redshirt senior added 12 points, five assists, a block and a steal against the Bruins, shooting 4-of-15 from the field and 3-of-4 from the charity stripe. Against USC, Moser tied the game high with 20 points, going 9-of-15 in field goals and 2-of-5 from beyond the three-point line. He added 12 rebounds, four assists, a block and a steal to lead Oregon to a 78-63 road win over the Trojans.

The selection marks the first-career Pac-12 weekly honor for Moser, who transferred to the Ducks from UNLV where he received four Mountain West Conference player of the week awards. It is Oregon's 31st all-time selection and its first since E.J. Singler received a player of the week nod on Feb. 23, 2012.

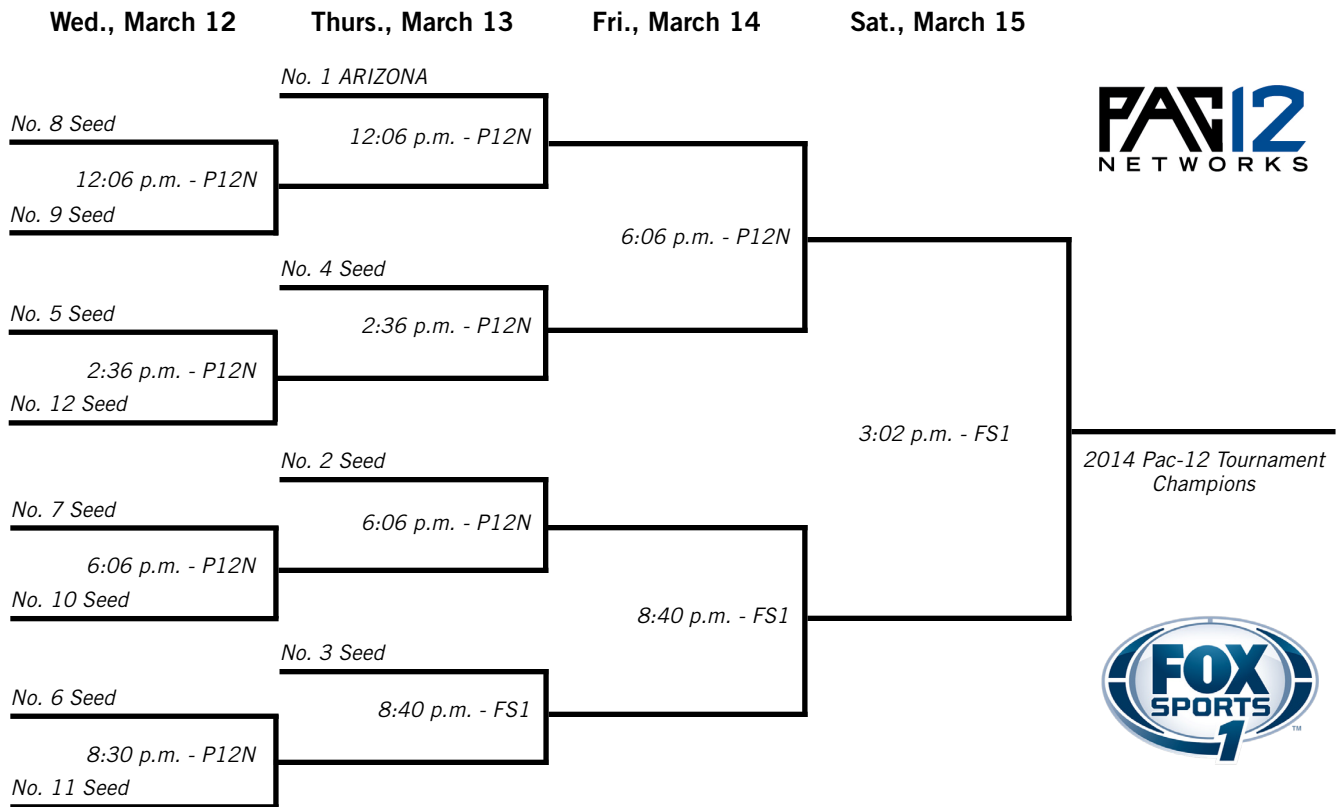
## PAC-12 NOTES

**NCAA TOURNAMENT... MAKING A CASE FOR THE PAC-12:** Between the bracketology reports, RPI, BPI, and Sagarin ratings, the Pac-12 is positioning itself for strong consideration of having multiple participants in the NCAA Tournament. . . The Pac-12 was strong at home in non-conference play, posting a 94-6 record (.940). . . Five teams have posted 20-win seasons, while three additional teams are within two wins of a 20-win season. . . The league has defeated notable 20-game winners San Diego State, Michigan (Big Ten champion), Duke, Arkansas, Connecticut, Kansas (Big 12 champion), Dayton, Xavier, and BYU. . . In the national statistic categories: ARIZONA is among the top five in scoring defense (4th, 58.2 ppg), scoring margin (3rd, 15.9 ppg) and rebound margin (3rd, 9.2 rpg). OREGON (82.8 ppg) and UCLA (82.6 ppg) rank ninth and 10th respectively in scoring offense. The Ducks are third in free throw percentage (.775), while the Bruins are second in thefts (9.72 steals per game), fourth in assists (17.5 apg) and third in assist-turnover ratio (1.66). UTAH is third in field goal percentage (.501). . . ARIZONA and ARIZONA STATE combined to finish 34-1 at home this season.

**ODDS & ENDS:** How difficult is it to win on the road in Pac-12 play? To date, in 42 trips with back-to-back road games, only five times has a team swept their two-game road swing in league play - ARIZONA twice (at UCLA/USC and at Utah/Colorado), CALIFORNIA twice (at Oregon/Oregon State and at Washington State/Washington), and OREGON once (at UCLA/USC). . . At 14-2, Arizona could become the first Pac-12 team to win 15 league games since UCLA claimed the 2008 Pac-10 title with a 16-2 record. . . Only two Pac-12 players have scored in double digits in each of their team's league games - Oregon State's **Roberto Nelson** and Utah's **Delon Wright**. Nelson is leading the league in scoring in conference games only at 20.1 ppg, while Wright is fifth at 17.6 ppg. . . ARIZONA made an adjustment recently to its starting lineup, inserting sophomore guard **Gabe York** into the lineup. The Wildcats have responded by averaging 80.3 points the last four games, up from its 73.1 ppg average before the four-game span. In addition, senior **G T.J. McConnell** has averaged 11.8 points, 6.5 assists, and 3.0 steals, while committing just three turnovers in the last four games. . . Pac-12 teams have played 11 overtime games in league play this season. The Pac-12 record for overtime games in league play is 13, set during the 1986 season.

**MILESTONES:** OREGON STATE junior **F Eric Moreland** established a new school mark for career blocked shots with 176, he passed former Beaver Scott Haskins who swatted 172 from 1989-93. He's third Pac-12 player to currently hold his respective school record for blocked shots, joining STANFORD's **Josh Huestis** (178) and ARIZONA STATE's **Jordan Bachynski** (Pac-12 record 304). . . CALIFORNIA senior **G Justin Cobbs** posted his 495th assist at Arizona State to move into fourth on Cal's all-time list, passing former Golden Bear Jason Kidd (494, 1993-94) in the process. . . Junior **G Chasson Randle**, who is averaging 18.5 ppg, needs six points to reach 1,500 for his career. In doing so, would become the 11th Cardinal all-time to reach that milestone.

## PAC-12 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE-SEEDING AND TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

**Seeding:** The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 8. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

**Tie-Breakers:** Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

### 1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- Each team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.  
When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.
- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

### 2. Multiple-team tie

- Results of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.  
When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.  
If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.
- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.
