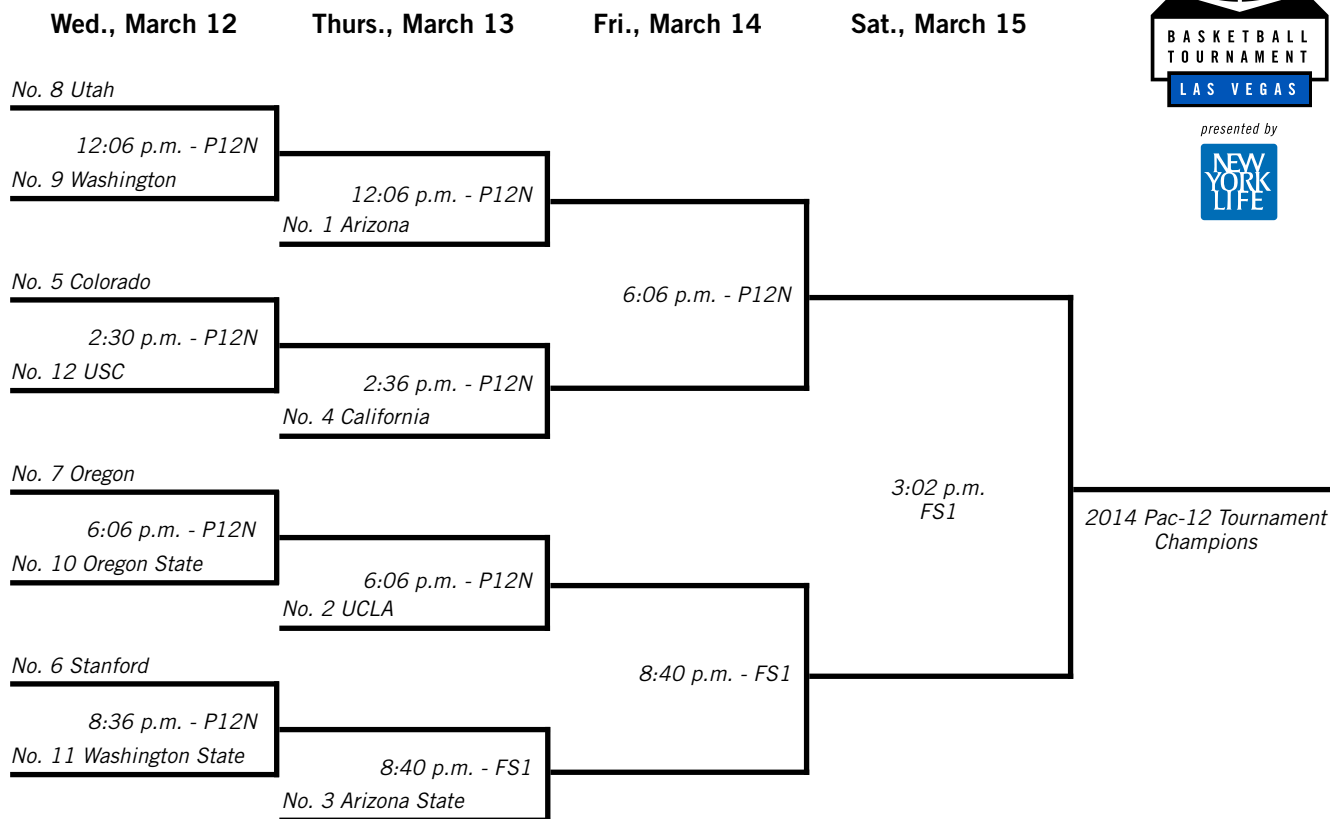

- The Pac-12 is fourth in the Sagarin conference ratings thanks in large part to eight league teams listed among the top 60. Seven Pac-12 teams were among the top 55 in the latest NCAA RPI (see page 5 for Pac-12 rankings). No other conference has more teams ranked in the NCAA RPI top 55 than the Pac-12.
- The Pac-12 posted a non-conference record of 119-32 (.788), with a home record in non-league games at 94-6 (.940). . . In league play, home teams were 72-36 (.667) in Pac-12 play. . . ARIZONA was perfect at home this season, posting a 18-0 mark. The Wildcats have won 21 straight in McKale Center. . . One other team had just one blemish on its home court record this season - ARIZONA STATE (16-1).
- The Pac-12 Women crowned their Tournament champion Sunday evening as USC defeated Oregon State, 71-62. The No. 5-seeded Women of Troy pulled off the challenging feat of winning four straight games to claim its first tournament title.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT BRACKET SEEDING

SETTING THE PAC-12 TOURNAMENT BRACKET: Nine of the 12 seeds for the 2014 Pac-12 Men's Basketball Tournament were determined on a frenetic final day of the Pac-12 regular season. Pac-12 regular season champion ARIZONA enters the event as the No. 1 seed. It's the sixth time in 17 years of the Tournament that the Wildcats have the top seed. . . While UCLA locked in the No. 2 seed earlier last week, it took six games on the final day, including two in overtime, to determine nine of the Tournament's 12 seeds. The quintet of ARIZONA STATE, CALIFORNIA, COLORADO, OREGON and STANFORD created a logjam for third place and had to rely on the Pac-12 tie-breaker to sort out the seeds. Following the league's multi-team tie-breaking procedure, Arizona State emerged as the No. 3 seed as it had the advantage with a 5-3 collective head-to-head record against the other tied teams. . . With the Sun Devils seeded, the multi-team tie-breaking procedure was repeated with the remaining four teams. With a favorable 3-1 record against the other three teams, California grabbed the coveted No. 4 seed and will receive a bye into Thursday's quarterfinal. . . The multi-team tie-breaking procedure was repeated once more with Colorado, Oregon and Stanford, where the Buffaloes were awarded the No. 5 seed after it sported a 2-0 record against the Ducks and Cardinal. . . The two-team tie-breaking procedure was then implemented with Stanford and Oregon. The Cardinal held the head-to-head advantage over the Ducks, picking up the No. 6 seed. Oregon, riding a seven-game winning streak, was awarded the No. 7 seed. . . UTAH and WASHINGTON finished in a tie for eighth with 9-9 league marks. With both teams splitting head-to-head meetings this season, the next step in the two-team tie-breaker was to compare each team's records vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage. Both teams were winless against league champion Arizona. However, Utah grabbed the No. 8 seed with its 1-1 record against UCLA, while Washington was winless against the Bruins and pulled in the No. 9 seed. . . At 8-10, OREGON STATE equaled its best league record over the last 21 seasons and will face rival Oregon as the No. 10 seed. . . In the final Pac-12 game of the regular season, WASHINGTON STATE upended UCLA to grab the No. 11 seed, while USC rounds out the Pac-12 Tournament bracket with the No. 12 seed.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE-SEEDING AND TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Seeding: The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 9. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Tie-Breakers: Procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie

- Results of head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season.
- Each team's record vs. the team (winning percentage) occupying the highest position in the final regular standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

- Results of collective head-to-head competition (winning percentage) during the regular season among the tied teams.
- If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (winning percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (winning percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

- Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

PAC-12 TOURNAMENT TEAM NOTES

ARIZONA: The Wildcats won their 13th conference title, second in the last four years. . . 'Cats hauled in several league honors with junior G **Nick Johnson** (16.1 ppg) claiming Pac-12 Player of the Year, freshman F **Aaron Gordon** (12.34 ppg/7.8 rpg) Pac-12 Freshman of the Year, and **Sean Miller** Pac-12 Coach of the Year. . . Arizona ranks among the top ten nationally in scoring defense (6th - 58.7 ppg), rebound margin (5th - +8.3), defensive field goal percentage (9th - .385), scoring margin (4th - +14.8). . . UA's 109 wins over the last four years is the second-best four-year run in program history. . . 'Cats have been ranked in the AP top five each week since Nov. 18, including an eight-week stretch at No. 1.

ARIZONA STATE: Senior C **Jordan Bachynski**, the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, bettered the Pac-12 single-season record for blocked shots he set a year ago. He has 131 rejections to date. His career total of 309 blocked shots is a Pac-12 career record. . . Sophomore G **Jahii Carson's** two-year scoring total stands at 1,232 points. Only two Sun Devils reached 1,000 points quicker than sophomore G Jahii Carson who did it in his 55th game. Ike Diogu reached 1,000 in his 50th game, while James Harden did it in his 52nd. . . ASU has its fifth 20-win season under **Herb Sendek** in his eight years. In the previous 25 seasons (1981-82 to 2005-06) it had three (20-10 in 1990 and 24-9 in 1995 under Bill Frieder and 20-12 in 2003 under Rob Evans).

CALIFORNIA: All-Pac-12 senior G **Justin Cobbs** (15.6 ppg) has 706 in 98 career games and completed the regular season ranked second in the Pac-12 and 23rd nationally with 5.8 apg. He recently moved ahead of Jason Kidd (1992-94) for fourth in school history in assists. His 5.2 apg career average ranks third at Cal. Cobbs is one of just three Golden Bears in school history to record at least 1,400 career points (1,408) and 500 career assists (506). . . The Bears finished in a five-way tie for third at 10-8. It was the 17th consecutive winning record posted by coach **Mike Montgomery** in league play (last 11 seasons at Stanford, six seasons at California)

COLORADO: All-Pac-12 sophomore F **Josh Scott** leads the Buffaloes in field goal percentage (.535), free throw percentage (.820), and is second on the team in points per game average (14.5). His 13 double-doubles, ranks second overall in the conference. . . At 21-10, Colorado has posted its fourth straight 20-win campaign under coach **Tad Boyle**. The 90 victories over his four seasons are the most wins in any four-year span in school history.

OREGON: The Ducks enter the Pac-12 Tournament have won seven in a row, and nine of their last 12. In fact, the three losses were each decided by two points (vs. UCLA, at Arizona, at Arizona State). . . Oregon's 95 victories in the past four seasons breaks the program record for most wins in a four-year span. Oregon won 94 games between 1935-1939. . . The Ducks rank ninth nationally in scoring offense (82.3 ppg) and fourth nationally in free throw percentage (.772). . . Senior G **Johnathan Loyd**, last season's Pac-12 Tournament Most Outstanding Player, sits fourth in a fourth-place tie in the Oregon record books with Luke Ridnour with 150 career steals, while his 442 assists are fifth all-time at Oregon.

OREGON STATE: Senior G **Roberto Nelson**, a second team All-Pac-12 selection, led the league in scoring in league games only for the second straight season, averaging 20.1 ppg. Nelson has scored 1,700 points in his OSU career (4th on the career list). . . The 8-10 league record for the Beavers equaled their best conference mark in the last 21 seasons (also 8-10 in 2005 and 2010). . . Junior F **Eric Moreland**, a Pac-12 All-Defensive team selection, became the career blocked shots leader at OSU (now has 181) and moved into fifth on Oregon State's all-time rebounding list with 744 rebounds.

STANFORD: Redshirt junior G **Anthony Brown** picked up Pac-12 Most Improved Player honors in a vote of the league coaches. Brown, who had a career average of 6.6 ppg entering the season, is third on the team averaging 13.1 ppg. He leads the team, and is third in the Pac-12, shooting .461 from three-point range. . . Senior F **Josh Huestis** earned Pac-12 All-Defensive Team accolades for the third consecutive season. Stanford's all-time leading shot-blocker with 179 career swats, Huestis is averaging 11.5 points and a team-best 8.7 rebounds per game. Huestis has racked up seven double-doubles and stands 39 points shy of 1,000 and one rebound away from 800 for his career.

UCLA: Sophomore G **Kyle Anderson** has averaged closer to a triple-double than any other player in the nation, with 14.9 ppg, while logging 8.7 rebounds and 6.6 assists per game. He leads all Pac-12 players with 15 double-doubles and is the only player in the conference to rank in the top five in rebounds (8.7), assists (6.6) and steals (1.7). . . Coach **Steve Alford** led the Bruins to a 23-8 mark. For him, it was his seventh consecutive 20-win season, and ninth in the last 10 years. . . All-Pac-12 selection **Jordan Adams** leads the Bruins in scoring with 17.5 ppg. In two seasons, Adams has amassed 1,031 career points.

USC: Junior G **Byron Wesley** (17.6 ppg) has averaged 19.9 points over the last 10 games. He surpassed the 1,000 career points plateau on Feb. 1 at Oregon and now has 1,144 career points, 24th on USC's all-time scoring list. . . The Trojans have one Tournament crown under their belt, winning the Pac-10 postseason title in 2009. . . The future looks bright for freshman G **Julian Jacobs** and freshman F **Nikola Jovanovic**. Among the Pac-12 freshman, Jacobs leads in steals (1.06 spg) and is second in assists (3.65 apg). Jovanovic tops all freshman in field goal percentage (.516), while averaging 8.2 ppg and 4.4 rpg.

UTAH: The Utes are a 20-game winner for the first time since the 2009 season. Their nine league wins are more than the last two seasons combined. Utah had won only one Pac-12 road game in its first two seasons, but has captured two of their last three this year. . . The Utes have won 15 of their 20 games this season by double figures and rank eighth in the nation in scoring margin (+13.2). . . The team is fifth in the nation in field goal percentage (.497), while All-Pac-12 junior G **Delon Wright** ranks 18th nationally at 58.4 percent.

WASHINGTON: Senior **C.J. Wilcox** (18.5 ppg), a second team All-Pac-12 honoree, sits second on the schools all-time scoring list with 1,866 points. He trails only Chris Welp who poured in 2,073 points from 1984-87. On the final week of league play, Wilcox made seven three-pointers to push his total to 88 for the season, and establish a UW single-season record. His school-record 299 career three-pointers rank sixth all-time in the Pac-12 record book. . . Freshman G **Nigel Williams-Goss** is the eighth UW player under coach Lorenzo Romar to earn Pac-12 All-Freshman team accolades. That's more than all but two Pac-12 schools during that time (UCLA -12; Arizona - 9). Williams-Goss leads all Pac-12 freshmen in scoring, averaging 13.3 ppg.

WASHINGTON STATE: Junior G **DaVonté Lacy**, a Pac-12 honorable mention All-Pac-12 pick, leads the Cougars in scoring at 19.1 ppg. He'd rank second in the league, but has not qualified as he has not played in the minimum 75 percent of th team's games. Lacy has connected on 72 three-pointers this season, trailing only Washington's Wilcox (88) and Arizona State's Jermaine Marshall (78). He averages 3.27 three-pointers per game. . . Senior F **D.J. Shelton** (9.9 ppg/9.5 rpg) is tied for third in the league with 12 double-doubles. He averaged a double-double in conference play with 11.2 ppg and 10.4 rpg. His 286 rebounds are the most in a season for a Cougar since James Donaldson pulled down 305 rebounds in 1978.

PAC-12 MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER OF THE WEEK

MIKE MOSER, F, OREGON

OREGON senior forward Mike Moser has been named Pac-12 Men's Basketball Player of the Week for play from Mar. 3-8, the Conference office announced today.

The Portland, Ore., native averaged 16.0 points and 13.5 rebounds to lead Oregon to its second-straight weekend sweep as the Ducks defeated Arizona State and No. 3 Arizona. Oregon finished the regular season on a seven-game win streak with the two victories. In the 85-78 win over Arizona State, the senior posted 22 points and 17 rebounds, just three rebounds shy of becoming the first Duck in 37 years to have a 20-point, 20-rebound performance. Moser went 9-of-11 from the free-throw line, as well as 6-of-11 from the field and 1-of-3 from three-point range. In the 64-57 upset victory over Arizona, Moser posted his fourth-straight double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds, becoming the first Duck to accomplish such a feat since 2007. He added four blocks and an assist against the Wildcats, going 4-of-11 in field goals and 2-of-4 in three-point shots.

The selection marks the second-career Pac-12 weekly honor for Moser, who also received the honor last week. It is the first time that an Oregon player has received back-to-back weekly awards. As a team, it is the second time that Oregon has earned the weekly honor two straight weeks as Luke Ridnour and Luke Jackson were consecutive winners during the 2002-03 season. It is Oregon's 32nd all-time selection.
