



2017 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Post-Game Notes

GAME 2: #5 Arizona State (72), #12 Utah (54)
Thursday, March 2, 2017

This was the first Tournament matchup between these two teams. ASU's overall Tournament record is now 13-14. The Utes are now 2-6.

ASU advances to play #4 seed UCLA tomorrow at 2:00 p.m. PT. The Bruins won both regular season games with the Sun Devils, 69-60 in Westwood and 55-52 in Tempe. The Tournament record between the teams is even at 2-2.

The #5 seeds now have a 4-1 edge over the #12 seeds in the Tournament

Utah has started today's lineup in 26 of its 30 games this season.

ASU's 72 points equaled its season high vs. a Pac-12 opponent (72-62, 2OT vs. Cal, 1/1/17).

All 11 Sun Devils who played, scored. 9 of them grabbed at least 1 rebound.

ASU's Quinn Dornstauder earned her 7th career double-double of her career (5th of season.) Her 12 boards equaled a career high (12, at Colorado, 1/8/17). It was her 20th double-figure scoring game of the season (14th in last 18 games.)

Sun Devil Sophie Brunner moved into a tie for 6th place on the school's career scoring list with 1,363 points (Kristen Kovesdy, 2003-06). It was her 22nd 10+ point scoring effort of the season. Sabrina Haines also scored in double figures (5th of season).

Utah's Wendy Anae fouled out for the first time this season (4Q, 7:53).

ASU was +26 in the 29 minutes that Haines played.
