



2018 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Post-Game Notes

GAME 1: #9 Colorado (66), #8 Utah (56)
Thursday, March 1, 2018

#9 Colorado advances to play #1 Oregon, tomorrow at 11:30 a.m. The two teams have not met in previous Tournaments. The Ducks beat the Buffaloes 74-55 during the regular season.

The Buffaloes advance to the Tournament's quarterfinal round for the first time since 2015.

Colorado head coach JR Payne won her first Tournament game (1-1).

Colorado won the season series between the two teams, 2-1.

The 9th seed has won 8 of 15 Tournament games with the 8th seed.

Utah used the starting lineup of Williams, Bean, Potter, Clark and Boclair for the 3rd time this season (Emily Potter has started all 30 Ute games this season). Colorado's lineup up Caylao-Do, Robinson, Leonard, Correal and Jank was used for the 12th time (Two time All Pac-12 selection, Kennedy Leonard started all 30 games for CU.)

At the 5:23 mark of the first quarter, Utah's Tanaeya BoClair scored the 1000th point of her career, the 28th Ute to do so.

Colorado used a 12-0 run over from 1Q, 0:38 to 2Q, 8:08, to takes its first lead of the game (22-14).

BoClair scored in double figures for the 5th time this season. Tori Williams did so for the 14th time in 2017-18.

Four Buffaloes scored in double figures: Kennedy Leonard for the 24th time in 30 games, Annika Jank (12th), Zoe Correal (6th) and Quinessa Caylao-do (4th).

Leonard had a season high 8 rebounds. Her career best of 9 also came against Utah (1/25/17).

Utah's 2 steals equaled a season low; it was the lowest against a Pac-12 foe.

Utah's Emily Potter failed to record a block for only the 3rd time this season.
