



2019 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Post-Game Notes

GAME 1: #5 Arizona State (66), #12 Colorado (49)

Thursday, March 7, 2019

This was the first Tournament game between Colorado and ASU.

ASU beat Colorado by the identical score on February 15, in Tempe.

The Sun Devils have used the same starting lineup of Richardson, Ryan, Ekmark, Ibis and Johnson-Chapman for 58 consecutive games (since Nov. 25, 2017).

ASU leveled its overall Tournament record at 16-16 and advances to play #4 UCLA in Friday's 11:30 a.m. quarterfinal game. The Sun Devils are 2-3 in previous Tournament games vs. the Bruins. This was ASU's eleventh straight win over the Buffaloes. Colorado's Tournament record drops to 6-8 overall, 4-3 in the first round.

ASU never trailed in the game, leading for 38:59 out of the 40 minutes.

The Sun Devils made 11 3-point field goes, the 8th time they have sank 8 or more this season (only 4 times last season). The 11 made equaled a season high (11, vs. Baylor on Nov. 11.) Ekmark's 6 three's equaled her season best.

ASU's Kianna Ibis was held to less than 10 points for only the 5th time this season.

Alexis Robinson scored 19 points for the Buffaloes, the 17th time she has scored in double figures this season.

Colorado's Mya Hollingshed equaled her career best for steals with 3.

After taking a 29-17 halftime lead, the Sun Devils were outscored 10-1 to open the 3rd quarter, before ASU's Courtney Ekmark hit a three-point FG. The Buffaloes had a 23-14 advantage in the quarter overall.

Ekmark scored in double figures for 17th time this season. Teammate Robbi Ryan had 10+ points for the 9th time in 2018-19.
