THIS WEEK IN PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

Five Pac-12 teams are ranked in this week's *Associated Press* poll for the second-straight week. Last week's appearance of five teams in the writers' poll was the most for the Conference since six teams were ranked in the second polling of the 2006-07 campaign ... OREGON STATE has not budged from the top 10 in both national polls, earning a No. 7 ranking by the writers and the *USA Today/WBCA* Coaches poll. STANFORD (14/12), UCLA (20/RV), CALIFORNIA (22/21) and ARIZONA STATE (24/24) join the Beavers in the polling ... Cal's Kristine Anigwe was voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the third time in four weeks, averaging 35.0 points and 12.0 rebounds per game, including a 43-point outing. OREGON's Jillian Alleyne was selected the Pac-12 Player of the Week recording a double-double for the 23rd-consecutive game, while approaching the Pac-12's all-time rebounding record. The Ducks are off to a 7-0 start, their best start since 2004-05 ... Oregon, OSU and USC are three of 16 teams remaining in the country that are still undefeated ... With four 30-point games under her belt already this season, WASHINGTON's Kelsey Plum is leading the NCAA in scoring this week, netting an average of 28.4 points per game ... After being off for a week, the No. 14/12 Cardinal is back on the court for a top-15 matchup, traveling to No. 6/6 Texas on Sunday for a ESPN clash. WASHINGTON STATE, however, tips off the week's action hosting regional for Gonzaga on Tuesday night on the Pac-12 Networks.

2016 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 3-6



After three-consecutive years drawing near-record crowds, the 15th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 3-6, 2016 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2015 championship game was the second-most attended in the history of the event.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

SAN FRANCISCO - A pair of post players nab the Pac-12 Women's Basketball Players of the Week for the week of Dec. 1-6, the Conference office announced today. OREGON's **Jillian Alleyne** was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week and CALIFORNIA's **Kristine Anigwe** was voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the second-straight week.

Senior Jillian Alleyne (Fontana, Calif.) posted a pair of double-doubles in leading the Ducks to wins over San Jose State (104-74) and Utah Valley (79-68) at home. Averaging 24.0 points and 19.5 rebounds per game over the two contests, she has recorded a double-double in 23-consecutive games, besting her previous streak of 22 set between her sophomore and junior seasons. It is also an Oregon record. Alleyne was 12-for-17 for 26 points in the victory over SJSU also grabbing 20 rebounds for her ninth 20-rebound game of her career and her first of the season. She had 22 points and 19 boards in the win over UVU, also adding three blocks. Alleyne shot 71.9 percent from the floor as UO is off to a 7-0 start to the season, the team's best since 2004-05.

Freshman post player Kristine Anigwe (Phoenix, Ariz.) had another impressive week, averaging 35.0 points and 12.0 rebounds per game to help the Golden Bears to a 1-1 week. Anigwe had 43 points in a win over Sacramento State over the weekend, tying for the seventh-highest point total in league history with only 15 others tallying just as many or more all-time. Anigwe led Cal to the 117-99 decision, as the Bears also set the program's single-game scoring record. Anigwe had back-to-back 12-rebound games, tallying 27 points in the loss to Saint Mary's (Calif.), 64-63, to open the Cal Classic in Berkeley, and was named to the All-Tournament team. She also shot 64.4 percent (29-45) from the floor and 75.0 from the free throw line (12-16) for the weekend. It is Alleyne's fourth-career player of the week honor and Oregon's 42nd all-time. Anigwe earns the weekly honor for the third time this season and is the seventh weekly rookie nod for the Golden Bears all-time.

A player of the week has been selected every week since 1986-87, the first year the Conference sponsored women's sports. A freshman of the week was first selected in 2012-13. The Pac-12 Player and Freshman of the Week are voted on by a panel of media that regularly cover Pac-12 women's basketball.

RECORDS WATCH

OREGON's Jillian Alleyne has been one of the Conference's top rebounders since arriving on campus in 2012-13, leading the Pac-12 in rebounding the last two seasons. It is not surprising then that she ranks among the great Pac-12 rebounders of all time and is second only to former three-time All-American and 2014 John R. Wooden Award winner Chiney Ogumike (Stanford).

Alleyne's total numbers are impressive, but her career average is as well. Having averaged at least 11.9 rpg every season, her career average of 14.5 rpg through three seasons would break the all-time record currently held by former UCLA standout Natalie Williams who maintained a 12.8 rpg in her career from 1991-94.

COACHING MILESTONES

Both COLORADO coach Linda Lappe and OREGON coach Kelly Graves reached coaching milestones over the Thanksgiving break. Lappe, in her sixth season at her alma mater, picked up Division I win No. 100 on Nov. 27 in a win over Massachusetts, while Graves, who is in his second season in Eugene but has logged 19 seasons on a Division I sideline, picked up his 400th-career victory the following day on Nov. 28.

Other coaches approaching century milestones are ARIZONA STATE's Charli Turner Thorne, who needs just two wins for her 400th in 22 seasons of coaching; ARIZONA's Niya Butts needs five victories to No. 100 in eight years as a head coach; OREGON STATE head coach Scott Rueck is four victories short of 100 Division I victories; and USC's Cynthia Cooper needs five to get to No. 200.

WASHINGTON STATE head coach June Daugherty has been a head coach for 27 years and won career-No. 400 last season, but is approaching her 100th victory at WSU, needing just three more wins.

ALL-STAR RETURNS

Coming off a season where five Pac-12 teams earned NCAA Tournament bids for the second-straight season, the Conference looks to be as competitive as ever thanks, in part, to the return of eight of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees from 2014-15. Defending regular-season Pac-12 Champion OREGON STATE has the most all-Conference honorees returning, welcoming back three, including the 2014-15 Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year in SR C Ruth Hamblin.

OFFENSIVE RETURNS: Eight of the Conference teams return its leading scorer from a year ago eight also welcome back its top rebounder, including the Pac-12's leading scorer and rebounder in SR F Chiney Ogumike of Stanford.

Last year, the Pac-12 had five of the nation's top 25 rebounders and they are all back this season (stats are final from the 2012-13 season): Ogumike (12.9), Oregon's Jillian Alleyne (11.9), California's Gennifer Brandon (11.1), Washington's Aminah Williams (10.8) and Utah's Michelle Plouffe (9.4).

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The 2015-16 campaign welcomes a new face. New to the Conference is Utah's head coach Lynne Roberts. Roberts landed in Salt Lake City by way of the University of the Pacific. Last year she was named Co-West Coast Conference Coach of the Year after leading the Tigers to a 21-10 record.

Roberts joins an impressive cast of coaches across the 12 schools with a collective 146 years of experience. Leading the way is Hall of Fame head coach Tara Van Derveer, who will be on the Stanford sideline for her 30th season and 37 years for her career. ARIZONA STATE's Charlie Turner Thorne also boasts over 20 years of experience, entering her 22nd season as a head coach and 19th with the Sun Devils. WASHINGTON STATE head coach June Daugherty is logging her 27th season as a head coach, nine of which have been spent in Pullman. Just shy of 20 years of coaching is OREGON's Kelly Graves, who has been on the sidelines for 19 seasons, including two in Eugene.

ROAD TO INDIANAPOLIS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Indianapolis this season, the site of the 2016 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Indy, teams will have to go through regional site at Bridgeport, Conn., Dallas, Lexington and Sioux Falls, S.D. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
