FOUR TOP-25 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL GAMES SCHEDULED THIS WEEK

Perennial power and 14th-ranked Tennessee visits two of the Conference's top teams this week as No. 15 STANFORD hosts the Lady Vols on Wednesday night on ESPNU before No. 7 OREGON STATE gets its turn on Saturday on the Pac-12 Network ... Pac-12 teams boast a 78.4 winning percentage in the non-conference season so far, finding success from long-range as well as employing stifling defense. Five Pac-12 teams have three-point field goal percentages ranked in the top-17 in the country, led by ARIZONA (2nd, 44.9) and OREGON (3rd, 43.8), with a sixth team ranking just outside the top-25. USC's stifling defense that has limited opponents to under 48 points per game, is second-best in the nation and is one of four league squads to rank in the top-25 in the category. OSU's 8.0 blocks per game leads the nation with three other Pac-12 teams ranking among the top 25 in blocks, as well ... The second-winningest coach in Conference history, ASU's trip to the East Coast marked head coach Charli Turner Thorne's 400th-career victory ... Five Pac-12 teams are ranked again this week in the *Associated Press* poll and eight in total are receiving votes in at least one of the two major polls ... UTAH's Emily Potter was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week while Cal's Kristine Anigwe is the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the fourth time this season ... The beginning of next week kick off the final week of non-conference action with No. 11 Florida State visiting ASU (ESPNU), while No. 19 UCLA heads to No. 21 Cal for a clash that will not impact the league standings. The game will be on Pac-12 Bay Area.

2016 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 3-6



After three-consecutive years drawing near-record crowds, the 15th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 3-6, 2016 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2015 championship game was the second-most attended in the history of the event.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

SAN FRANCISCO - The Pac-12 Conference office announced today the Pac-12 Women's Basketball Players of the Week for the week of Dec. 14-20. UTAH's Emily Potter was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week and CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe was voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the third-straight week.

Redshirt sophomore forward Emily Potter (Winnipeg, Manitoba) set career highs in both points (28) and rebounds (19) in a convincing 74-58 win over Creighton, leading the Utes to a 1-1 week. She was 11-for-20 (.550) en route to the career high, also dishing out three assists and collecting a pair of blocks. She followed up with a 9-for-14 (.643) performance for 24 points in the 73-59 loss at BYU and also grabbed 17 boards to record a seventh double-double in eight games this season. Potter averaged 26.0 points and 18.0 rebounds over the two games last week, shooting 58.8 percent from the floor (20-for-34). She is averaging 12.1 rebounds per game this year, which ranks ninth in the NCAA, to go along with 18.9 points per game. It is Potter's first-career player of the week nod and the fourth all-time for Utah since joining the Conference in 2011-12.

Forward Kristine Anigwe (Phoenix, Ariz.) is the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the fourth time in five weeks of the season. Anigwe led the Golden Bears to an 87-80 overtime victory over Nebraska on Sunday, tallying 29 points and 10 rebounds in the contest. She shot 62.5 percent from the floor, also going 9-for-10 from the free throw line. Anigwe averages 21.0 points per game on the season, which ranks 21st in the nation. She is the second-highest scoring freshman in the country, netting at least 22 points in five-consecutive games, including a 43-point outing on Dec. 6. Anigwe's fourth rookie weekly selection is Cal's seventh overall all-time..

A player of the week has been selected every week since 1986-87, the first year the Conference sponsored women's sports. A freshman of the week was first selected in 2012-13. The Pac-12 Player and Freshman of the Week are voted on by a panel of media that regularly cover Pac-12 women's basketball.

RECORDS WATCH

OREGON's Jillian Alleyne has been one of the Conference's top rebounders since arriving on campus in 2012-13, leading the Pac-12 in rebounding the last two seasons. It is not surprising then that she ranks among the great Pac-12 rebounders of all time and is second only to former three-time All-American and 2014 John R. Wooden Award winner Chiney Ogumike (Stanford).

Alleyne's total numbers are impressive, but her career average is as well. Having averaged at least 11.9 rpg every season, her career average of 14.5 rpg through three seasons would break the all-time record currently held by former UCLA standout Natalie Williams who maintained a 12.8 rpg in her career from 1991-94.

FRESHMEN PHENOMS

With Pac-12 coaches hauling in some of the nation's top talents, the promise of potential that can make immediate impacts are beginning to show. Two of the nation's top-scoring freshmen are in the Pac-12. CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe, who has been named Pac-12 Freshman of the Week four times already this season, is the second-highest scoring freshman in the country, averaging 21.0 ppg, and ranks 21st among all players in the NCAA. WASHINGTON STATE's Borislava Hristova ranks 36th in the country with a 19.4 ppg average also making her the fourth-highest scoring freshman in the country. The two impact players are two of just nine underclassmen in the country to rank in the top 36 in scoring.

Also making an impact this season is OREGON's Maite Cazorla. Leading the Pac-12 in assists per game at 6.5 apg, she owns the highest assists average among freshman in the country and ranks 14th among all players. No other freshman is in the top 27 in the country in the category.

COACHING MILESTONES

ARIZONA STATE head coach Charli Turner Thorne is the latest Pac-12 mentor to reach a coaching milestone. On Dec. 14 against Hartford, Turner Thorne picked up her 400th-career victory. Turner Thorne has been roaming the sidelines for 22 seasons, 19 of them in Tempe.

Both COLORADO coach Linda Lappe and OREGON coach Kelly Graves reached coaching milestones over the Thanksgiving break. Lappe, in her sixth season at her alma mater, picked up Division I win No. 100 on Nov. 27 in a win over Massachusetts, while Graves, who is in his second season in Eugene but has logged 19 seasons on a Division I sideline, picked up his 400th-career victory the following day on Nov. 28.

Other coaches approaching century milestones are ARIZONA's Niya Butts needs four victories to No. 100 in eight years as a head coach; OREGON STATE head coach Scott Rueck is two victories short of 100 Division I victories; and USC's Cynthia Cooper needs four to get to No. 200.

WASHINGTON STATE head coach June Daugherty has been a head coach for 27 years and won career-No. 400 last season, but is approaching her 100th victory at WSU, needing just two more wins.

ALL-STAR RETURNS

Coming off a season where five Pac-12 teams earned NCAA Tournament bids for the second-straight season, the Conference looks to be as competitive as ever thanks, in part, to the return of eight of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees from 2014-15. Defending regular-season Pac-12 Champion OREGON STATE has the most all-Conference honorees returning, welcoming back three, including the 2014-15 Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year in SR C Ruth Hamblin.

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The 2015-16 campaign welcomes a new face. New to the Conference is Utah's head coach Lynne Roberts. Roberts landed in Salt Lake City by way of the University of the Pacific. Last year she was named Co-West Coast Conference Coach of the Year after leading the Tigers to a 21-10 record.

Roberts joins an impressive cast of coaches across the 12 schools with a collective 146 years of experience. Leading the way is Hall of Fame head coach Tara Van Derveer, who will be on the Stanford sideline for her 30th season and 37 years for her career. ARIZONA STATE's Charlie Turner Thorne also boasts over 20 years of experience, entering her 22nd season as a head coach and 19th with the Sun Devils. WASHINGTON STATE head coach June Daugherty is logging her 27th season as a head coach, nine of which have been spent in Pullman. Just shy of 20 years of coaching is OREGON's Kelly Graves, who has been on the sidelines for 19 seasons, including two in Eugene.

ROAD TO INDIANAPOLIS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Indianapolis this season, the site of the 2016 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Indy, teams will have to go through regional site at Bridgeport, Conn., Dallas, Lexington and Sioux Falls, S.D. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
