PLUM GOES FOR 3,000 POINTS

• Six Pac-12 teams continue to be ranked this week, marking the seventh-straight week at least six league teams are ranked in one or both polls. WASHINGTON is back in the top 10 at No. 8 in the *Associated Press* poll and No. 9 in the *USA Today/WBCA Coaches* poll. OREGON STATE makes its first appearance of the season in the top 10, coming in at No. 10 in both polls.

• This week's Pac-12 women's basketball schedule does not lack intrigue, starting with a top-25 clash between OSU and No. 17/13 UCLA in Los Angeles on Friday on Pac-12 Network. The Beavers are the only team undefeated in Conference play and the Bruins are looking to bounce back from a disappointing weekend.

• The final game of the week features another matchup with national implications with Washington traveling to No. 19/18 ARIZONA STATE on Sunday on Pac-12 Network. Both teams have just one loss in league play.

• Owning the No. 1 Conference RPI in the nation, the Pac-12 is the only league in the country with five teams in the top 15. 11 of the 12 squads have RPI in the top 100.

• The Pac-12's all-time leading scorer already, Washington's Kelsey Plum needs just 29 points to reach 3,000 for her career which would make her the only men's or women's player in league history to reach the milestone. It would also make her just the 12th player in NCAA history to score 3,000-career points. She also needs just five free throws for 800 and eight threes for 300.

• CALIFORNIA sophomore Kristine Anigwe scored her 1,000th point over the weekend in just her 47th-career game, making her the fastest to 1,000 in Pac-12 history. It also ties for the 20th-fastest in collegiate women's basketball history (AIAW and NCAA included).

• STANFORD's Tara VanDerveer needs just seven more victories to reach 1,000 for her career, which would make her just the second women's basketball coach in NCAA history to achieve the milestone, and just the fourth among men's and women's coaches across all divisions.

• Plum was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week, also earning the national player of the week distinction from ESPNW, after leading the Huskies to a pair of wins. WASHINGTON STATE's Chanelle Molina was voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the second-straight week after leading the Cougs to the program's biggest-ever win and a sweep of the LA schools for the first time in more than 20 years.

2017 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 2-5



After drawing a record attendance in 2016 and near-record crowds the previous three seasons, the 16th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 2-5, 2017 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2015 championship game was the second-most attended in the history of the event.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

Pac-12 Network launched in the summer of 2012 with one national and six regional networks devoted solely to Pac-12 sports. MS. 3,000

Already the Pac-12's all-time leading scorer, Washington's Kelsey Plum is on pace to score 3,000-career points, needing just 29 to become the first men's or women's player in league history to reach the milestone.

Only 11 players in NCAA Division I history have scored 3,000 points and Plum would become the 12th all-time. She currently ranks 13th in the NCAA record book. Missouri State's Jackie Stiles owns the all-time NCAA record with 3,393 points set in 2001.

ANOTHER MILESTONE WITHIN PLUM'S REACH

Washington's Kelsey Plum is not short of reaching milestones. In addition to nearing 3,000-career points and 300-career threes, she also needs just five free throws for 800 for her career. The only player to make 700 free throws in Pac-12 history, Plum already claimed the record coming into the season and continues to add to it, nearly 200 free throws ahead of the second-place person on the list (608, Tanja Kostic, OSU, 1993-96).

ANIGWE SCORES 1,000TH POINT

California's Kristine Anigwe joined the 1,000th-point club on Jan. 8 to become just the 28th player in Cal history to reach the milestone. Only a sophomore, Anigwe needed just 47 career games, ranking her in a tie for 20th-fastest all-time in collegiate women's basketball history, which includes AIAW and NCAA. She is also the fastest in Pac-12 history, which dates back to 1986-87. Oregon State's Carol Menken scored her 1,000th point in her career which spanned 1979-81, prior to the start of women's sports in the Pac-12, which ties for the fastest ever in collegiate women's basketball history.

PLUM BREAKS ALL-TIME SCORING RECORD

The most prolific scorer in Pac-12 history, Washington's Kelsey Plum broke the Pac-12's all-time scoring record in just the 11th game of her senior campaign, surpassing 2014 WNBA Rookie of the Year Chiney Ogumike of Stanford. The fastest in league history to 2,000-career points, she is only the third player in Conference history to score at least 2,500 points, having scored over 700 points in each of her three seasons. Her name in the top five all-time is among elite company, with two WNBA Rookies of the Year, two No. 1 WNBA picks, four WNBA first-round picks, two WNBA Most Valuable Players and a pair of WNBA Champions occupying the four other spots.

Plum's total scoring is impressive, but it does not end there. Plum's career average of 24.4 points per game would be good enough for the Pac-12 record.

WIESE BREAKS 3-POINT RECORD; PLUM NOT FAR BEHIND

Plum is not the only one breaking records. OREGON STATE's Sydney Wiese topped four-time Stanford All-American Candice Wiggins in the three-point category. Wiese is the first player in Conference history to make 300-career threes.

Plum just entered the top three in threes made and is not far behind Wiese. Plum looks to become just the second player in league history to crack 300 in the category.

SIX PAC-12 TEAMS RANKED

Six Pac-12 teams are ranked in this week's *Associated Press* and *USA Today/WBCA Coaches*, marking the seventh-consecutive week at least six league teams are ranked in one or both polls.

Washington is back in the top 10 and leads the Pac-12 at No. 8 and No. 9, respectively, as Oregon State makes its first top-10 appearance of the season, coming in at No. 10 in both polls. Stanford is No. 13 in the AP poll and No. 12 in the coaches. UCLA dropped to No. 17 and No. 13, respectively, while Arizona State is No. 19 and No. 18. California is tabbed No. 24 and No. 23.

Three more teams are receiving votes in one or both polls (Colorado, Oregon, USC). On December 26, seven Pac-12 teams were ranked for the first time ever in the *Associated Press* poll.

COUGS ON THE LOOSE

Washington State snapped a six-game losing streak posting impressive victories to get to .500 overall and a winning record in league play (3-2). The Cougs began a three-game win streak with a victory over Oregon, followed by the pro-

gram's biggest win ever, taking down then No. 9/7 UCLA in Los Angeles. Pac-12 Freshman of the Week Chanelle Molina had 33 points in the win, the most points scored by a player against the Bruins in 14 years.

There was no let down after that win, as WSU swept the LA schools for the first time since 1994-95 with a win over USC two days later.

The Cougs are finding success despite being without two key starters: Louise Brown and Borislava Hristova. Hristova is the team's leading scorer and Brown is the team's leading rebounder.

BRACKETOLOGY NOD

In the latest ESPN Bracketology dated Jan. 3, ESPN's Charlie Creme believes nine Pac-12 teams would receive NCAA Tournament berths, if the season ended today. That is the most of any conference in the country with the ACC claiming eight and the SEC seven.

The Pac-12 currently has the No. 1 RPI in the country with 11 of 12 teams in the top 100, including seven in the top 27.

The Dec. 12 bracketology had an amazing 10 teams listed as deserving of a NCAA Tournament bid.

COUNTDOWN TO 1,000 FOR VANDERVEER

In her 31st season on the bench at Stanford, Hall of Famer Tara VanDerveer has accumulated a 993-228 record in her 37+ years as a collegiate head coach and an 837-176 mark on The Farm, nearing the 1,000-win mark. Only the late Pat Summitt of Tennessee has won 1,000 women's basketball games and three coaches in men's and women's basketball in total have reached the milestone. VanDerveer's teams have won 20 or more games 31 times, including each of the last 15 seasons. In 2013, she became just the fifth college women's basketball coach to win 900 career games.

TOP DAWGS

Washington Huskies Kelsey Plum and Chantel Osahor have been leading the nation in scoring and rebounding for most of the season. Plum is averaging a nation's best 30.7 points per game, while Osahor is grabbing 13.7 rebounds per game.

As a team, UW's 203 makes from long range are the most of any team in the country from that distance, while the 11.3 threes made per game average is third.

ANIGWE TIES ALL-TIME SCORING RECORD

California's Kristine Anigwe, last year's USBWA National Freshman of the Year, netted 50 points to tie the Pac-12's all-time single-game scoring record on Dec. 8 against Sacramento State, making her only the second player in Conference history to score 50 points. Anigwe was 19-for-23 from the floor in that game, also going 12-for-19 from the free throw line.

The original record was set nearly 28 years ago on March 10, 1989 by USC's Cherie Nelson against the Golden Bears. Since then, the record was only threatened twice (USC's Tina Thompson, 49 points, Jan. 27, 1996; Cal's Alexis Gray-Lawson, 47 points, Jan. 23, 2010), until Anigwe tied the mark.

The 50-point outing is also the highest-scoring individual game in the NCAA this season.

TRIPLE-DOUBLES GALORE

So far this season, there have been five instances of triple-double performances by four players this season. It ties for the most occurrences in a season in the Pac-12, which came in 2014. That season, former Cal standout Brittany Boyd had three triple-doubles, Colorado's Lexy Kressl achieved the feat once, as did Oregon State's Ruth Hamblin, who is the only player in Conference history to record a triple-double with points, rebounds and blocks.

This season, Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu has posted a pair of triple-doubles, which ties for the most this season. Washington's Chantel Osahor, UCLA's Jordan Canada and OSU's Sydney Wiese each recorded one.

IONESCU TRIPLE-DOUBLES

In a span of 16 days over three games, Oregon freshman Sabrina Ionescu has recorded triple-double performances twice, not only tying her for the most in the nation this season but also making her just the third player in Pac-12 history to post multiple triple-doubles in a career and in a season. It was also her first triple-double in Oregon history since 1988.

Stanford's Nicole Powell, who is serving as the Ducks' assistant coach under Kelly Graves, notched three triple-doubles during the 2001 and 2002 campaign to set the season record. She also has the career record with six.

California's Britty Boyd had three triple doubles in 2014, the only ones of her career, tying her with Powell for the season record and putting her second on the career list.

Four players this season have posted triple-doubles, including Washington's Chantel Osahor, UCLA's Jordin Canada and Oregon State's Sydney Wiese, in addition to Ionescu.

NCAA ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS

Washington's Kelsey Plum's and Oregon State's Sydney Wiese's impact on their respective programs can be seen in the NCAA's active career leaders list. Plum leads all active players in career points, nearing 3,000 for her career (700 in front of the second-place active leader), and is also the active leader in free throws made, nearing 800 (300 ahead of the second-place active leader). Plum does not just get to the free throw line, but also makes them with the best percentage from the line among active leaders at 88.1. She also has the most field goals made and attempted, and free throws attempted among the active leader. Her career scoring average ranks second.

Wiese is first in career three-pointers made and ranks in the top five in total assists, three-point field goals per game and three-point percentage.

In fact, the top-three career active leaders in three-point percentage are all from the Pac-12 with Oregon's Lexi Bando leading the way (46.6), followed by Stanford's Karlie Samuelson (42.8) and Wiese (41.3).

UCLA's Jordin Canada's career assists average is also in the top five among the active players.

STEPPING UP

Pac-12 teams recorded six keys non-conference wins this season. Most recently, California upset then-No. 20/21 Oklahoma in Las Vegas. Arizona State defeated then-No. 19/23 Florida to claim the ASU Classic title on Dec. 4. The Sun Devils overcame a 12-point, fourth-quarter deficit to win the game. Earlier that same week on Nov. 30, USC upset then-No. 25/19 Texas A&M in College Station. Over the Thanksgiving week, Oregon defeated then-No. 24/19 Michigan State by 33 points on Nov. 22, three days after Colorado took down then-No. 15/19 Kentucky at home. ASU has another big win, defeat-No. 15/18 Kentucky in Lexington. The Sun Devils took a late lead in the fourth quarter then needed overtime to clinch the win.

NEW HEIGHTS

With six players standing 6-foot-3 or taller, OREGON is tied with Kansas State and Texas for the tallest roster in Division I women's basketball this season. Oregon's tallest player is 6-foot-6 freshman forward Lydia Giomi from West Seattle, Wash., the tallest player on the Oregon roster in 10 years (Jessie Shettlers, 6-foot-6, 2003-07).

In the Pac-12, the next tallest teams are CALIFORNIA, STANFORD and

USC, each with five players standing at 6-3 and taller. The tallest player in the Conference is ARIZONA's Eugenie Simonet-Keller, a center from France who is listed at 6-8. The second-tallest player is CALIFORNIA's Chen Yue, a center from Beijing, China, who is listed at 6-7.

HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

The Pac-12 is coming off a historic campaign that saw two teams advance to the NCAA Women's Final Four for the first time in the history of the Conference. OREGON STATE and WASHINGTON made their first-ever trips to the national semifinal last season. It followed historic rounds that included three Elite Eight teams and four Sweet Sixteen teams, both first-time accomplishments for the league. Owning the No. 1 Conference RPI in the country for the majority of the season, Pac-12 teams went 5-0 in the first round after receiving five NCAA Tournament bids for the second-straight season. Conference teams won 14 NCAA Tournament games last season, a league record.

ALL-STAR RETURNS

Seven of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including the Conference's leading scorer and All-American Washington's Kelsey Plum. Also back is three-time all-Conference honoree Sydney Wiese of Oregon State who is looking to earn her fourth-straight honor. California's Kristine Anigwe was voted all-league after an impressive rookie campaign. She went on to be selected the USBWA's National Freshman of the Year.

Also back from last year's All-Pac-12 team are Arizona State's Sophie Brunner, UCLA's Jordin Canada, Stanford's Erica McCall and Utah's Emily Potter.

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The 2016-17 campaign welcomes two new faces. A new but familiar face will be roaming the sidelines in Tucson. Taking over the Arizona helm is former Wildcat great Adia Barnes. Barnes is familiar with the Conference, not just as a player, but spending last season as an assistant coach at Washington, helping the team reach the program's first-ever NCAA Final Four.

New to the league is Colorado's JR Payne. Payne arrives in Boulder after spending two seasons at Santa Clara and five at Southern Utah before that. Her first coaching position was an assistant coach to now current Oregon head coach Kelly Graves.

ROAD TO DALLAS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Dallas this season, the site of the 2017 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Dallas, teams will have to go through regional sites at Lexington, Ky., Oklahoma City, Okla., Bridgeport, Conn., and Stockton, Calif. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
