THREE PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TEAMS UNDEFEATED, SIX TEAMS RANKED

Three teams are still undefeated heading into this week, including COLORADO which earned its first *Associated Press* ranking in two seasons, coming in at No. 21. To put in perspective, the Buffs won just seven games all of last season ... Six teams are ranked this week in at least one poll, UCLA continuing in the top 10 with a No. 9 ranking in the *USA Today/WBCA Coaches* poll and No. 10 in the AP. STANFORD is No. 11 and WASHINGTON is No. 13 in both. OREGON STATE is sitting at No. 24 in the writer's poll and No. 18 in the coaches', while ARIZONA STATE is No. 24 in the latter ... At 5-0 to start the week, UTAH takes on two intra-state rivals at home, while CALIFORNIA, 6-0 so far this season, puts its record on the line late this week at Nebraska ... USC has a tough matchup at No. 25/19 Texas A&M on Wednesday and ASU could host a potential top-25 clash against No. 19/23 Florida at the Sun Devils' home tournament ... WASHINGTON's Chantel Osahor was voted the Pac-12 Player of the Week after recording the program's first-ever triple-double, and OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu was tabbed the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the second-straight week after leading the Ducks to an upset of then-No. 24 Michigan State with a triple-double of her own ... Needing just two points to move into second on the Pac-12's all-time scoring list, UW's Kelsey Plum is averaging a nation's-leading 29.9 points per game and is just 111 points away from breaking the all-time scoring mark. The Huskies play three games in seven days starting Dec. 1.

2017 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT
KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 2-5



After drawing a record attendance in 2016 and near-record crowds the previous three seasons, the 16th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 2-5, 2017 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2015 championship game was the second-most attended in the history of the event.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TELEVISION SCHEDULE

All 11 games of the Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament at KeyArena in Seattle will be nationally televised, with 10 appearing on Pac-12 Network and the championship game on ESPN2 on March 5. Pac-12 Network launched in the summer of 2012 with one national and six regional networks devoted solely to Pac-12 sports. CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

RECORDS WATCH

WASHINGTON's Kelsey Plum is already one of the most prolific scorers in Pac-12 history. The fastest in league history to 2,000-career points, she is only the third player in Conference history to score at least 2,500 points. Having scored over 700 points in each of her three years, she needs just over 100 to break the all-time scoring mark. Her name in the top five all-time is among elite company, with two WNBA Rookies of the Year, two No. 1 WNBA picks, four WNBA first-round picks, two WNBA Most Valuable Players and a pair of WNBA Champions occupying the four other spots.

Plum's total scoring is impressive, but it does not end there. Entering the season, Plum was averaging 23.3 points per game for her career, which would have been good enough for the Pac-12 record. She already owns the record for career free throws made and will shatter the mark previously held by former Oregon State standout Tanja Kostic (1993-96, 608). Plum is the only player in league history to make over 700 free throws in a career.

Plum is not the only one looking to break records. OREGON STATE's Sydney Wiese is among the top-five all-time in Conference history in three-point field goals made. She has netted at least 66 in each of her first three seasons, knocking down 112 in her freshman campaign.

VANDERVEER NEARING 1,000

In her 31st season on the bench at Stanford, Hall of Famer Tara VanDerveer has accumulated a 986-226 record in her 37+ years as a collegiate head coach and an 834-175 mark on The Farm, nearing the 1,000-win mark. Only the late Pat Summitt of Tennessee has won 1,000 women's basketball games and three coaches in men's and women's basketball in total have reached the milestone. VanDerveer's teams have won 20 or more games 31 times, including each of the last 15 seasons. In 2013, she became just the fifth college women's basketball coach to win 900 career games.

CANADA NEARLY POSTS BACK-TO-BACK TRIPLE DOUBLES

UCLA's Jordin Canada recorded the 23rd triple-double in Pac-12 history and sixth triple-double in UCLA history when she had 11 points, 10 rebounds and a career-high 12 assists in a home win over Southern on Nov. 18. She nearly had the first back-to-back triple-double in UCLA history and the first in the Pac-12 since 2002 but finished one assist shy with 19 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists in a home win over Cal Poly on Nov. 20. She is one of four Bruins all-time to record a triple-double. In that game versus Southern, Canada also became the 32nd Bruin to reach 1,000-career points.

NCAA ACTIVE CAREER LEADERS

WASHINGTON's Kelsey Plum's and OREGON STATE's Sydney Wiese's impact on their respective programs can be seen in the NCAA's active career leaders list. Plum leads all active players in career points and is out in front by nearly 600 points, and is the leader in made free throw attempts with over 700. The next player has under 500 to their credit. Plum's effectiveness at the free throw line is not just getting there, but also making them, currently boasting the best career free throw percentage (88.0). She is also tops in field goals made and free throw attempts. Her career scoring average is second among the active leaders, just over a point behind the leader.

Wiese is the active leader in career three-pointers made and ranks in the top five in total assists, three-point field goals per game, three-point percentage and three-point attempts.

UCLA's Jordin Canada's career assists average is also in the top five among the active players.

NEW HEIGHTS

With six players standing 6-foot-3 or taller, OREGON is tied with Kansas State and Texas for the tallest roster in Division I women's basketball this season. Oregon's tallest player is 6-foot-6 freshman forward Lydia Giomi from West Seattle, Wash., the tallest player on the Oregon roster in 10 years (Jessie Shettlers, 6-foot-6, 2003-07).

In the Pac-12, the next tallest teams are CALIFORNIA, STANFORD and USC, each with five players standing at 6-3 and taller. The tallest player in the Conference is ARIZONA's Eugenie Simonet-Keller, a center from France who is listed at 6-8. The second-tallest player is CALIFORNIA's Chen Yue, a center from Beijing, China, who is listed at 6-7.

HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

The Pac-12 is coming off a historic campaign that saw two teams advance to the NCAA Women's Final Four for the first time in the history of the Conference. OREGON STATE and WASHINGTON made their first-ever trips to the national semifinal last season. It followed historic rounds that included three Elite Eight teams and four Sweet Sixteen teams, both first-time accomplishments for the league. Owning the No. 1 Conference RPI in the country for the majority of the season, Pac-12 teams went 5-0 in the first round after receiving five NCAA Tournament bids for the second-straight season. Conference teams won 14 NCAA Tournament games last season, a league record.

ALL-STAR RETURNS

Seven of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including the Conference's leading scorer and All-American Washington's Kelsey Plum. Also back is three-time all-Conference honoree Sydney Wiese of Oregon State who is looking to earn her fourth-straight honor. California's Kristine Anigwe was voted all-league after an impressive rookie campaign. She went on to be selected the USBWA's National Freshman of the Year.

Also back from last year's All-Pac-12 team are Arizona State's Sophie Brunner, UCLA's Jordin Canada, Stanford's Erica McCall and Utah's Emily Potter.

NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The 2016-17 campaign welcomes two new faces. A new but familiar face will be roaming the sidelines in Tucson. Taking over the Arizona helm is former Wildcat great Adia Barnes. Barnes is familiar with the Conference, not just as a player, but spending last season as an assistant coach at Washington, helping the team reach the program's first-ever NCAA Final Four.

New to the league is Colorado's JR Payne. Payne arrives in Boulder after spending two seasons at Santa Clara and five at Southern Utah before that. Her first coaching position was an assistant coach to now current Oregon head coach Kelly Graves.

ROAD TO DALLAS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Dallas this season, the site of the 2017 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Dallas, teams will have to go through regional sites at Lexington, Ky., Oklahoma City, Okla., Bridgeport, Conn., and Stockton, Calif. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
