## PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL PREPARES FOR FINAL NON-CONFERENCE GAMES

Two top-20 matchups highlights the final week of non-conference action. 10th-ranked OREGON faces #19/20 Texas A&M in Las Vegas for the Duel in the Desert tournament. It is the second meeting between the teams, the Ducks winning the first in the semifinal of the WNIT a month ago ... A clash between two of the most storied women's basketball programs takes place when #18/24 STANFORD hosts #7/7 Tennessee on Thursday on Pac-12 Network ... Five league teams continue to be ranked in the *Associated Press* poll. #11 UCLA, #17 OREGON STATE and #24 CALIFORNIA join the Ducks and Cardinal in the top 25. In the *USA Today/WBCA Coaches* poll, UO is #10, Stanford is No. 24, the Bruins are 12th and OSU is No. 17. ARIZONA STATE and USC are receiving votes in both polls ... Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu was selected the Pac-12 Player of the Week for the third time after breaking the Pac-12 record and tying the NCAA record for career triple-doubles, recording her seventh 11 games into her sophomore campaign. COLORADO's Annika Jank is the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week for the second-straight week and third time this season ... Arizona State makes an appearance on Pac-12 Networks this week, hosting Arkansas on Thursday ... Seven Pac-12 teams have RPI in the top 50, with six appearing in the top 35.

# 2018 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT KEYARENA, SEATTLE, WASH. • THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 1-4



After drawing a record attendances the last two seasons, the 17th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament remains in Seattle in partnership with Force 10 Sports Marketing, LLC, the Seattle Sports Commission and Seattle Center. The tournament will be held at KeyArena from March 1-4, 2018 and will receive unprecedented national television coverage once again with each game of the tournament scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The City of Seattle has embraced women's basketball and women's athletics. The WNBA's Seattle Storm loyal fan base has increased over the last several years. The majestic city provides convenient travel for teams and fans, with non-stop flights available from every Pac-12 city. In the three years the Pac-12 Tournament has been in the Emerald City, the four-day event has seen its biggest successes, recording three of the top four attendances in the 14-year history. The 2017 tournament set a record for total attendance and had the event's first sold-out session.

The Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament made its debut in 2002 and was held on the University of Oregon campus in Eugene, Ore. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion at San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeding and Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

## PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TELEVISION SCHEDULE

A record-110 games will be broadcast on Pac-12 Network and five on ESPN Network. In addition, all 11 games of the Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament at KeyArena in Seattle will be nationally televised. Pac-12 Network launched in the summer of 2012 with one national and six regional networks devoted solely to Pac-12 sports. ## CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

### RECORDS WATCH

With her third triple-double of the season and just 11 games into her sophomore campaign, OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu broke the Pac-12's all-time triple-doubles career mark and tied the NCAA record.

The 2016-17 Pac-12 women's basketball season was all about chasing records and this season picked up where it left off last year with chasing down records. Ionescu kicked off the 2017-18 campaign posting a triple-double in the first game of the season to resume the chase. Below is the NCAA triple-doubles career list:

### PAC-12 IN THE RPI

Heading into the final week of non-conference play, seven Pac-12 teams have RPI in the top 50, including six in the top 35, as of Dec. 17. Leading the way is OREGON with a RPI of No. 10. CALIFORNIA (No. 14) and UCLA (No. 20) are also in the top 20.

### CLIMBING THE CHARTS

UCLA's Jordin Canada needs just two points to become the 38th player in league history to hit 1,700 points while CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe entered the league's scoring lists, becoming the 65th player in Pac-12 history to score 1,500 points.

### NCAA STATS LEADERS

Although known for its defensive presence, OREGON STATE has been having a stellar offensive season so far. The Beavers lead the nation in field goal percentage (53.5) and second in three-point shooting by just .1 percent (44.5). And despite having to replace an All-American guard in Sydney Wiese, OSU is leading the country in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.88) while boasting an offense that ranks 18th in the nation (84.3 ppg). Defensively, the Beavs are still one of the best in the country ranking 10th in scoring defense (35.5), fourth in defensive shooting percentage (31.4) and 18th in opponent three-point shooting (25.4). Leading the way for her team from three-point range is Aleah Goodman who is currently the nation leader in three-point shooting (59.4).

Six Pac-12 players are ranked in the top 15 in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio. ARIZONA STATE's Reili Richardson is fourth and tops in the Conference with a 4.50 ratio, followed by OSU's Katie McWilliams (7th, 4.20), UTAH's Erika Bean (8th, 4.00), UCLA's Jordin Canada (11th, 3.61), OSU's Goodman (13th, 3.30) and OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu (15th, 3.24).

### CENTURY MARK

On the opening day of the season, UCLA scored a school-record 129 points to defeat San Jose State (69) at home. That point total broke a school record and was just a bucket shy of the Pac-12 mark (131, Oregon vs. CS Bakersfield, Nov. 9, 2013). It was the most points scored by a league team since Oregon dropped 130 vs. Southern on Dec. 18, 2013.

### NCAA ACTIVE LEADERS

Four Pac-12 players can be found among the NCAA's active career leaders. UCLA's Jordin Canada has proven herself to be one of the top point guards in the nation. She currently ranks second in career assists (648) among active players becoming just the 10th player in Conference history to dish out 600 assists. She is also fourth among active leaders with 272 steals.

Bruin teammate Monique Billings' 912 career rebounds ranks seventh among the active players in the nation. CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe currently has the fourth-best career scoring average among players in the country at 20.5 points per game and her 9.3 career rebounding average is sixth, while OREGON's Lexi Bando's 45.9 career three-point percentage is second in the nation.

### TRIPLE DOUBLES GALORE

OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu, who tied the NCAA career record and broke the Pac-12 career mark, and UCLA's Jordin Canada opened the 2017-18 campaign with a triple-double each and since, have combined for five, giving the Conference 34 instances all-time. Since the start of the 2015-16 campaign, there have been a total of 12 triple-doubles achieved.

Triple-doubles were a rare occurrence in the Pac-12 prior to the 2012-13 campaign. From Feb. 1996-Feb. 4, 2012, only two players had achieved the feat with former Stanford standout Nicole Powell accounting for six instances from Feb. 2001-Mar. 2002 and former UCLA great Noelle Quinn had one triple-double to her credit in Feb. 2004. Since Feb. 2012, there has been at least one triple-double each year.

### HISTORIC CAMPAIGN

Pac-12 women's basketball is coming off back-to-back historic seasons, sending two teams to the NCAA Women's Final Four for the first time ever in 2015-16 and following up with a Conference-record seven teams earning NCAA Tournament bids. At least one Pac-12 team has reached the national semifinal round in nine of the last 10 years. League teams have not lost in the first round of the NCAA Tournament the last two years, combining for a 12-0 record. Additionally, the Conference has set records for the number of

league teams advancing to the Sweet Sixteen and Elite Eight, with a combined nine teams reaching the round of 16. The Pac-12 has also boasted the top conference RPI in the country the last two seasons.

In addition to the overall success of league teams last year, it was a special campaign following Washington's Kelsey Plum break the all-time NCAA scoring record and celebrating Stanford's Tara VanDerveer's 1,000th-career win, a feat only one other Division women's basketball head coach had achieved and only two men's or women's Division I head coach.

#### ALL-STAR RETURNS

Nine of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including four of the Conference's top-five scorers and three of the top-five rebounders. UCLA's Monique Billings was one of just two players last season to average a double-double, ranking fifth in scoring (16.7) and second in rebounding (10.5). The last two USBWA National Freshmen of the Year are among the all-star returnees, with CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe earning the honor in 2016 and OREGON's Sabrina Ionescu picking up the award in 2017. The Pac-12's assist and assist-to-turnover leader UCLA's Jordin Canada also returns.

Other All-Pac-12 honorees on team rosters this season are Oregon's Ruthy Hebard, Oregon State's Marie Gulich, Colorado's Kennedy Leonard, Stanford's Brittany McPhee and USC's Kristen Simon.

#### NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The Pac-12 welcomes a pair of new coaches to the sidelines this season. USC's Mark Trakh returns for his second stint as head coach of the Trojans. He spent 2005-2009 in Los Angeles, leading USC to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. Most recently, he was coach at New Mexico State where the team earned three-consecutive NCAA Tournament berths. Jody Wynn takes over at Washington after spending the last eight years as head coach at Long Beach State where she led the team to three-consecutive 20-win campaigns and a NCAA Tournament berth.

#### ROAD TO COLUMBUS

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Columbus this season, the site of the 2018 NCAA Women's Final Four. To get to Columbus, Ohio, teams will have to go through regional sites at Lexington, Ky., Albany, N.Y., Kansas City, Mo., and Spokane, Wash. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting.
