### TOP SEEDS STILL UP FOR GRABS IN FINAL WEEKS OF PAC-12 PLAY

• Just two weekends remain in the regular season and the top-four seeds of the Pac-12 Tournament in Las Vegas are still up for grabs. Earning its highest-ever *Associated Press* ranking this week, the No. 2/3 OREGON Ducks are in the driver's seat to claim their second-straight regular-season crown despite suffering its first loss of the season on Monday.

• Six games highlight the Pac-12 Networks schedule this week, including a top-20 rematch between the No. 17/15 ARIZONA STATE and No. 7/7 STANFORD. The Sun Devils are sitting in fourth place in the standings and are looking to maintain that lead over UCLA, which is right behind ASU. The Bruins travel to face Oregon and No. 12/8 OREGON STATE this week.

• At least four Pac-12 teams have been ranked every week this season and the Ducks continue to lead the Conference spending all but two weeks in the top five in both the AP and the *USA Today*/WBCA Coaches polls. The Cardinal has been in the top 10 in all but four weeks and OSU, fresh off an upset win over rival Oregon, received its lowest ranking in the AP this week at No. 12 but has not been lower than No. 11 in the coaches' polling. ARIZONA STATE has been steady in the rankings, this week claiming the No. 17/15 spot.

• After the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) announced the top-10 finalists for each of the five national positional awards, 10 of the 50 hail from the Pac-12, the most for any conference in the country.

• Stanford's Alanna Smith was voted Pac-12 Player of the Week for the third time this season. Recording her 1,500th-career point, she posted a pair of double-doubles in the Cardinal's sweep of the LA schools last week, including hitting the game-winning layup against USC. She was also named Naismith Trophy National Player of the Week.

• For the sixth time this season, UTAH's Dre'Una Edwards was voted the Pac-12 Freshman of the Week, marking the ninth time a Ute has received the rookie nod, a Pac-12 single-season record.

• Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu needs just 10 assists to become the fifth player in league history to log 700 career assists. The last player to reach the threshold was UCLA's Jordin Canada who is the first to get to 800 (831 career assists).

• Scoring in the conference is up this season, in part due to ARIZONA's Aari McDonald, CALIFORNIA's Kristine Anigwe, WASHINGTON STATE's Borislava Hristova, Smith, Ionescu and UTAH's Megan Huff, who all rank in the NCAA's top 32 in scoring.

**2019 PAC-12 WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT**  
**MGM GRAND GARDEN ARENA, LAS VEGAS, NEV.**  
**THURSDAY-SUNDAY, MARCH 7-10**

After a record-setting six years in Seattle, the 18th-annual Pac-12 Women's Basketball Tournament presented by New York Life heads to Las Vegas for two years. The 2019 tournament will be held at the MGM Grand Garden Arena from March 7-10, 2019 and will receive unprecedented television coverage once again as each game of the tournament is scheduled to be televised either on the Pac-12 Networks or ESPN2.

The tournament made its debut in 2002 and has been held annually since. The University of Oregon campus was host the first season. The Conference's premier women's sporting event then moved to HP Pavilion in San Jose for a six-year run (2003-08). It spent four years (2008-2012) in Los Angeles, with Galen Center playing host. The final two-year run of the event saw it combined with the men's tournament, and the semifinal and championship games were played at the STAPLES Center. The tournament then moved to Seattle's KeyArena for six years where it saw record attendance numbers each year.

The winner of the 12-team tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship. The tournament seeds and regular-season Conference Champion are determined by the 18-game regular-season Pac-12 schedule.

## CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

### PAC-12 IN THE POLLS

At least four Pac-12 teams have been ranked in the *Associated Press* and *USA Today* WBCA Coaches polls and as many as six have appeared in a poll this season. Three league teams earned top-10 rankings in the preseason polls, a first in the league's history. On Dec. 17, six Pac-12 teams were ranked in the *USA Today* WBCA Coaches poll for just the third time in league history and second time in two years. The last time six teams were in the national coaches poll was the preseason ranking released prior to the 2017-18 and 2006-07 campaigns.

### PAC-12 FAN SUPPORT

Nearly 22,000 fans went to two games in Oregon and Oregon State over four days from Feb. 15-18 when the rivals battled in a home-and-home series. Both the Ducks' and Beavers' fan base has seen a dramatic increase from last season, with UO averaging nearly 3,000 more in attendance compared to last season. OSU has also seen an increase in attendance from last season, as have five additional programs: Arizona, Arizona State, California, Stanford and Utah.

### MORE COACHING MILESTONES

Oregon State head coach Scott Rueck became the seventh coach in Pac-12 history to reach 200 wins at a Pac-12 institution. Stanford's Tara VanDerveer and ASU's Charli Turner Thorne are Nos. 1 and 2 on the all-time wins list in league history. Rueck also just won his 100th league game, making him the eighth all-time to reach the threshold.

### SIX PAC-12 TEAMS IN LATEST BRACKETOLOGY; NCAA REVEALS TOP 16

ESPNW's Charlie Creme latest bracketology projects six Pac-12 teams in the NCAA Tournament teams based on results as of Feb. 18. The NCAA also announced its first of two top-16 reveals on Monday, Feb. 11 with Oregon earning a No. 1 seed, Stanford a No. 2 seed and Oregon State a No. 3 seed, if the season had ended on Monday. A top-16 seeding would give them all the right to host first- and second-round games. Arizona State, California and UCLA are all in Creme's field of 64 this week. Utah is on the bubble after having been in Creme's bracket the last several weeks.

### NO EASY ROAD FOR PAC-12 TEAMS

Boasting the No. 2 Conference RPI, Pac-12 teams have faced tough schedules and, with two weeks left in the season, it does not get much easier. Six Pac-12 future schedules are ranked in the top 17. Arizona State's and Arizona's upcoming schedules are ranked Nos. 1 and 2, respectively, with UCLA's remaining slate ranking No. 10. (NCAA metrics are through Feb. 17 games.)

### PAC-12 SCORING IS UP

As a collective group as of Feb. 18, the Pac-12 has the best scoring average among all conferences at 72.5 points per game. League teams also have the best collective shooting percentage (.440) and 3-point shooting percentage in the country (.346), and second-best free throw percentage (.715).

Compared to 2017-18, the Conference's numbers are up in each of those categories, recording 3.5 ppg better than a year ago when it average 69.00 ppg for seventh-best among the leagues. In 2017-18, Pac-12 teams were shooting 42.95 pct. (3rd), 33.77 pct. from long range (4th) and has a slight improvement from last season's 71.16 free throw shooting (9th). Pac-12 teams have also seen improvement on the boards, last year averaging 37.00 rpg. This season, teams are averaging 38.2 rpg which ranks ninth.

### NCAA STATISTICAL LEADERS

California's Kristine Anigwe is putting together a strong senior campaign as one of the top players in the country. Posting a double-double in each of her team's games so far, she is the national leader in the category (25, as of Feb. 18) and is the rebounding leader as well (15.7 rpg), while ranking seventh in scoring (23.3 ppg).

Tallying 16-career triple-doubles, Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu five Pac-12 distributors among the top 25, ranking third overall with a 8.2 apg. Utah's Dru Gylten who ranks 25th in the country but is second among the nation's freshmen in the category (5.4 apg).

Five from the Pac-12 are also among the top 15 in assist-to-turnover ratio (three are in the top 10) with Arizona State's Reili Richardson ranking second with a 3.93 A/T/O, UO's Maite Cazorla is fifth at 3.59 A/T/O and Ionescu is ninth (3.31).

The Ducks' Ruthy Hebard has the second-best shooting accuracy in the nation with an amazing 69.8 percent. Three Ducks rank in the top-10 in three-point shooting, Ionescu coming in sixth (.467). Oregon State's Aleah Goodman is also in the top 15 at 12th with a 45.1 percent long-range accuracy.

The Pac-12 also boasts four of the nation's most prolific scorers, ranking among the top 30. Arizona's Ari McDonald is third with a 24.8 scoring average, Anigwe is seventh (23.3), Washington State's Borislava Hristova ranks 14th (20.9) and Stanford's Alanna Smith comes in at No. 21 (20.3).

Oregon leads the country with the best three-point shooting at 44.1 percent as three Pac-12 teams rank among the top 10. With Ionescu and Hebard leading the way, Oregon is the country's leader in scoring (89.7 ppg), field goal percentage (52.4) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.97).

### IONESCU UNDISPUTED TRIPLE-DOUBLE RECORD HOLDER

Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu has recorded 16-career triple-doubles, more than any man or woman in NCAA history, her latest coming in a win over against Arizona on Jan. 20.

The Jan. 20 triple-double was the sixth of the season for the junior guard, the most in the country. Posting back-to-back triple-doubles

## CONFERENCE NOTEBOOK

during the week of Dec. 17, 2018, Ionescu set the NCAA men's and women's career record held by Kyle Collinsworth of BYU. She was already the NCAA's women's record holder heading into the season, wasting no time adding to her total by logging her first triple-double in the season opener at Alaska Fairbanks.

### GOING THE DISTANCE

The 3OT game between Arizona and UCLA on Jan. 27 was the first in league history since 2001 when Washington and USC needed the three extra periods to decide a game in Seattle. The Huskies won that contest, 91-79. The only other 3OT game since 2001 involving a Pac-12 team was in 2008 when UA went the distance against Loyola Marymount, winning the road contest, 93-88.

### VANDERVEER REACHES ANOTHER MILESTONE

Stanford head coach Tara VanDerveer captured her 900th victory on the Farm becoming just the fifth DI coach, men's or women's, with that many at a single school. She joins Pat Summitt (Tennessee), Geno Auriemma (Connecticut), Mike Krzyzewski (Duke) and Jim Boeheim (Syracuse). Nearly two years ago on Feb. 3, 2017, she became just the second women's coach to reach 1,000 career wins.

### ANIGWE REACHES 2,000-1,000

When California's Kristine Anigwe eclipsed the 1,000-career rebound match, she became just the 11th player in Pac-12/10 history to collect 2,000 points and grab 1,000 boards. The All-American also became the 23rd player in league history to grab 1,000 boards and was only the 20th player to score 2,000-career points.

Anigwe became just the second player in league history to rank in the top five in both scoring and rebounding, joining former Stanford All-American and WNBA Rookie of the Year Chiney Ogwumike.

### NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

With the non-conference regular-season slate wrapped up, the Pac-12 posted a 109-27 record and .801 winning percentage, the best win percentage of all conferences. It marks the fourth time in six years that Pac-12 teams have won over 100 non-conference regular-season games and the third time in three years teams have posted a collective winning percentage of over .800.

### SISTER ACTS

Washington State's three Molina sisters - Chanelle, Celena, and Cherilyn are the only trio of active sisters in the Power 5 conferences. Other sister acts in the Pac-12 include the USC's Moore duo - Minyon and Mariya. The Trojans' Desiree Caldwell older sister Reece is a member of the California Golden Bears and is pursuing a master's degree in public health. The Sabally sisters wear the same colored jersey in Eugene. Older sister Satou was the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year last season but freshman Nyara will sit out this season because of an injury.

### PRESEASON RANKGS

For the third-straight year and just the fourth time ever, the Pac-12 had five teams ranked in the preseason *Associated Press* poll, including three in the top 10 for the first time ever. It was the most of any league in the country in the top 10.

Also for the first time ever, the Pac-12 had three teams in the top 10 of the WBCA Coaches poll and four total teams ranked. For a week-by-week listing of team rankings, go to page 2.

### HISTORIC CAMPAIGNS

Pac-12 women's basketball is in the midst of its most successful run, coming off a fifth-straight season with at least five NCAA Tournament bids. Since 2015-16, the Conference boasts the most NCAA Tournament wins (41) of any league and the best winning percentage among peer conferences (.695), posting double-digit NCAA Tournament victories in each of the last three seasons. The Pac-12 is the only conference to have at least two teams in the Elite Eight the last three years, placing at least four in the Sweet 16 during that time. Four Pac-12 teams appeared in the final *Associated Press* poll, the fourth-straight year the Conference had at least that many teams in the final ranking.

### ALL-STAR RETURNS

Ten of the 15 All-Pac-12 honorees return this season, including national award winners at their respective positions Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu (Nancy Lieberman Award winner) and Ruthy Hebard (Katrina McClain Award winner). Cal's Kristine Anigwe was a three-time All-Pac-12 honoree, with Colorado's Kennedy Leonard also earning a spot on the team the last two seasons. Also returning are UO's Maite Cazorla, Washington State's Borislava Hristova, Utah's Megan Huff, Arizona State's Kianna Ibis, Washington's Amber Melgoza and Stanford's Alanna Smith.

In addition, three former national freshmen of the year dot the Pac-12 rosters. Anigwe and Ionescu both were honored with the award by the USBWA in 2016 and 2017, respectively. Redshirt sophomore Destiny Slocum was bestowed the honor by the WBCA in 2017 before transferring to Oregon State.

### NEW FACES & FAMILIAR FACES

The Pac-12 welcomes a new face to the sidelines as Kamie Ethridge takes over the Washington State bench. Ethridge is one of the legendary figures in women's basketball, earning a place in the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame. Prior to arriving in Pullman, she spent four seasons at Northern Colorado, leading the team to the NCAA Tournament. The other 11 coaches return for the 2018-19 campaign.

The other 11 coaches return for 2018-19, including Hall of Fame head coach Tara VanDerveer who is in her 33rd season at Stanford and is serving her 40th season as a head coach over three stops. The second-most tenured head coach in the Pac-12 is Arizona State's Charli Turner Thorne who is in her 22nd season with the Sun Devils. She is a graduate of Stanford where she was a guard for VanDerveer for three years. The other Pac-12 head coaches have been at their respective institutions for single-digit seasons. Oregon State's Scott Rueck is one shy of the 10-year mark.

### ROAD TO TAMPA

Teams across the country will be focused on getting to Tampa this season, the site of the 2019 NCAA Women's Final Four on April 5 and 7. To get to Tampa, Fla., teams will have to go through regional sites in Albany, N.Y., Chicago, Greensboro, N.C., and Portland, Ore., where the Oregon State Beavers are hosts. Regional play takes place from March 29-April 1, with specific dates to be announced. The first and second round of the tournament will take place on 16 campus sites with the top-16 seeds hosting, March 22-25, 2019. The top 64 teams will learn their fates in the broadcast of the annual selection show on Monday, March 18, 2019.

## PAC-12 TIE-BREAKER PROCEDURE

### 1. SEEDING

All Conference teams that are eligible for post-season play shall participate in the Tournament. The seeding and pairings shall be determined upon completion of the regular season. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine seeding. This shall apply even in the event one or more teams cannot play its entire 18-game Conference schedule. An ineligible team's record and place in the final standings will be utilized in any tiebreaker situations. The team with the best winning percentage in Conference play will be seeded No. 1, the next best winning percentage in Conference play will be seeded No. 2, and so forth.

### 2. TIE BREAKERS

Tie breaking procedures for determining all Tournament seeding will be:

#### 2.1. TWO-TEAM TIE

- a. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
- b. Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.
- c. When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.
- d. Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
- e. Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

#### 2.2. MULTIPLE-TEAM TIE

- a. Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
- b. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating tied teams with inferior records until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

When the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedures will be applied.

- c. Winning percentage against all Division I opponents.
- d. Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

If a coin toss is needed to establish the final seeding and pairings, it will be administered by Commissioner Larry Scott. Each institution involved in the coin toss is entitled to have a representative present. If a representative does not attend, the institution will be advised of the results immediately upon completion. Results of the coin toss will be made available to the wire services and other media outlets by 5 p.m. PST on Sunday, March 2, 2019.
