## PAC-12 FOOTBALL SEASON IN REVEIW

- Pac-12 Champion Washington provided the Pac-12 with a CFP semifinalist for the second time in three years, joining Oregon which reached the 2015 CFP championship game. The Huskies captured the Pac-12 championship after posting a 41-10 victory over South Division champion COLORADO. Washington posted its second-ever 12-win season, while Colorado posted its first 10-win season since 2001 and just the eighth such season in school history.
- The Pac-12 placed a pair of teams, No. 3 USC and No. 4 WASHINGTON, in the top four of the final Associated Press Top 25. It's the third time two Pac-12 members appeared in the top four of the final AP Top 25. This also occurred in 2010 (No. 3 Oregon, No. 4 Stanford) and 2000 (No. 3 Washington, No. 4 OREGON STATE) ... For the third time in four years, the Pac-12 placed five or more teams in the final AP poll.
- Pac-12 teams finished the bowl season with a 3-3 mark, which included USC's dramatic 52-49 victory over Penn State. USC has won its last seven Rose Bowl games vs. Big Ten opponents, while the Pac-12 has won eight of the last 10 Rose Bowl Games in which it was pitted against the Big Ten ... UTAH edged Indiana in the Foster Farms Bowl, 26-24, behind the leg of place kicker Andy Phillips who connected on four field goals ... STANFORD got a big defensive stop on North Carolina's attempt at a two-point conversion with 0:25 remaining in the game and pulled out a 25-23 victory in the Hyundai Sun Bowl.

## PAC-12 HONORS

### OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR Jake Browning, QB, WASH

Completed 223 passes in 353 attempts for 3,162 yards and a school record 42 touchdowns with just seven interceptions. Browning ranks fifth in the FBS in passing efficiency (176.5). Guided the Huskies to their first Pac-12 title since 2000.

### PAT TILMAN DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR Adoree' Jackson, DB, USC

Has been a dynamic three-way performer for the Trojans. Jackson is fourth on the team with 51 tackles and has four interceptions to go with 11 pass break-ups. In his role as a PR/KR, Jackson has 19 punt returns for 302 yards (15.9 avg) and two TDs, and 22 kick returns for 671 yards (30.5 avg) and two TDs.

### COACH OF THE YEAR Mike MacIntyre, COLO

Following the greatest one-season turnarounds in Pac-12 history, MacIntyre earns the honor after leading the Buffaloes to a 10-2 record overall and a 8-1 mark in Conference play, claiming the school's first South Division title. After completing the 2015 season with a 1-8 Pac-12 record and a 4-9 mark overall, the Buffs were picked to finish last in the Pac-12 South as they entered the 2016 campaign.

SANTA CLARA, CALIF. – The Washington Huskies made their first appearance in the Pac-12 Football Championship Game on Friday night, and seemed very much at home. Amid a sea of purple and gold-clad fans, the Huskies rolled to a 41-10 win over the Colorado Buffaloes and earned their first conference title since 2000. In the process, coach Chris Petersen's team made a statement to the College Football Playoff selection committee: They're ready to play for even higher stakes.

"We think we've got a heck of a team," Petersen said. "And I think we belong in [the College Football Playoff]. I think [the committee] will do what they should do, which is the right thing."

Washington's first drive was a best-case scenario, as the Pac-12 North champs marched the length of the field and immediately punched it into the end zone. Myles Gaskin and Lavon Coleman combined to take the Huskies 65 yards in seven plays, and Coleman's one-yard run put UW on the board.

It was the first time all season Colorado has allowed an opponent to score on their opening drive.

On the other hand, the Buffs' opening drive couldn't really have gone worse. On the fifth play of the drive, Sefo Liufau was sacked and slow to get up. He limped off the field and was replaced by redshirt freshman Steven Montez. The drive stalled and the Buffs turned it over on downs.

But CU's defense buckled down on the next Husky drive, forcing their own turnover-on-downs and gave themselves solid field position at their own 45.

And this time they were able to capitalize. Montez completed two passes for 34 yards and Phillip Lindsay continued his dominance on the ground, muscling his way over the goal line from three yards out to put the Buffs on the board.

The teams traded zeros for the next couple of drives before the Huskies were able to break through. Once again led by the run game, Gaskin and Coleman combined for 41 yards to set up Jake Browning's second completion of the night, a 15-yard touchdown pass to Darrell Daniels to give Washington a 14-7 lead at the half.

When play resumed, the Huskies came out on a mission – to show why they're among the top four teams in the country.

Liufau returned to the field as Colorado received the opening kickoff, but had his first pass bounce off of Jay MacIntyre's hands right to Taylor Rapp. The Pac-12 Defensive Freshman of the Year took it all the way to the house for a 35-yard pick six.

On the very next Colorado possession Rapp put his name in the record books, picking off another Liufau pass and becoming the first player with two interceptions in the Pac-12 Football Championship Game. The freshman was later named MVP of the game.

"I didn't see any of this coming," Rapp said. "It's all so crazy, it's all so surreal. It feels like a dream out there."

Coach Petersen had a different take.

"It didn't surprise me in the slightest," Petersen added about his talented freshman's MVP honor.

With the defense coming alive, the passing game followed suit. Later in the third Browning scrambled to avoid a sack, tossed in the general direction of John Ross, who did what John Ross does best – made a phenomenal play. His leaping catch and run into the end zone made it 31-7, and UW never looked back.

Was that impressive connection from Browning to Ross simply Browning trying to throw it away?

"No, no he was not," Gaskin laughed.

A late rushing score from Chico McClatcher made it 41-10 and sealed the deal for the Huskies.

### NORTH vs. SOUTH...

WASHINGTON is the first team other than Oregon or Stanford in six seasons to win the Pac-12 North Division ... COLORADO is the fifth different school in the last six years to win the Pac-12 South Division ... It's worth noting that no team has come through Conference play unscathed since the league expanded to 12 teams. In five of the six seasons of Pac-12 play, the North Division champion finished Conference play with one loss. Only the 2013 season produced a North Division champion with more than one loss when Oregon and Stanford each finished tied at 7-2. While in the South Division, Colorado now joins Arizona State (2013) as the only South Division champions to finish with 8-1 records.

**MORRIS TROPHY HONOREES...** Junior DE **Solomon Thomas** of Stanford and senior OG **Isaac Asiata** of Utah have been named the 2017 Morris Trophy winners.

It's truly a players award as the league's starting offensive linemen vote for the defensive lineman of the year, while the league's starting defensive linemen vote for the offensive lineman of the year.

Thomas led Stanford and ranked in the top five in the Pac-12 in sacks (7.0) and tackles for loss (13.0). Thomas also led the Cardinal with 36 solo tackles, and tied for the team lead with 55 total tackles.

Asiata earned second team All-Pac-12 honors after appearing in 928 snaps this season. He started all 12 games at left guard, and started all 38 games over the last three seasons. He scored a touchdown this season against USC after falling on a fumble in the end zone.

The award, which was first presented in 1980, is sponsored by Anthony's Restaurant and Athletic Awards of Seattle.

## PAC-12 FOOTBALL NOTEBOOK

**PILING UP THE POINTS:** Eighteen times a Pac-12 team has topped 50 points in a game this season ... WASHINGTON STATE has scored 50 or more points in a game a record four times this season. It's 125 combined points in back-to-back games (69 vs. Arizona, 56 vs. California) are the most ever for the Cougars over two games ... WASHINGTON led the Pac-12 with 41.8 points per game, just 0.1 shy of its single-season school record of 41.9 ppg set in 1991. It has scored 40 points or more in 10 games ... USC scored 40 or more points in a game seven times, while CALIFORNIA and COLORADO each scored 40 or more points in a game six times.

**35 TD PASSES:** Washington's **Jake Browning** (43), Washington State's **Luke Falk** (38) and California's **Davis Webb** (37) have each thrown 35 or more TD passes this season. Nine times over the last three seasons a Pac-12 quarterback has thrown 35 or more TD passes in a season. Prior to the 2014 season, a Pac-12 quarterback tossed 35 or more TD passes just four times in the history of the Conference. Browning's 43 TD passes matched the Pac-12 single-season record of 43 set last in 2015 by California's Jared Goff.

**ALL-PURPOSE X TWO:** Since the Conference began keeping all-purpose yardage since 1978, five Pac-12 players have averaged better than 200 all-purpose yards per game for a season, but STANFORD's **Christian McCaffrey** is the only player to do it twice. He set the Pac-12 single-season mark last season with 276.0 yards per game when he set the FBS record with 3,864 all-purpose yards, then led the nation again in 2016 with 211.5 yards per game.

**GET YOUR KICKS:** The Pac-12 swept the national honors in the kicking game in back-to-back seasons. ARIZONA STATE PK **Zane Gonzalez** earned the Lou Groza Award (UCLA's Ka'imi Fairbairn won in 2015) as the nation's top place kicker after a stellar season in which he hit 23-of-25 (.920), including 7-of-9 from 50 yards or beyond. He concluded his career as the FBS career recordholder for career field goals (96) ... UTAH punter **Mitch Wishnowsky** grabbed the Ray Guy Award (Utah's Tom Hackett won in 2014 and 2015) as the nation's top punter. Wishnowsky averaged 47.7 yards per boot, placing 34 of his 60 punts inside the 20-yard line.

**IT'S UNANIMOUS:** For just the fourth time in Conference history, four student-athletes earned unanimous All-America honors. Here's the esteemed group:

### NOTES FROM THE NORTH

**CALIFORNIA:** With 4,295 passing yards, senior QB **Davis Webb** became the second Cal quarterback in school history to throw for 4,000 yards in a season (Jared Goff, 4719 in 2015). He threw for 300 or more yards 10 times in 2016. His 37 passing TDs this season rank second on Cal's single-season list ... Junior PK **Matt Anderson** set the single-season modern era record in points scored with 117 points ... Junior WR **Chad Hansen** finished his career third on Cal's single-season reception list (92) and receiving yards (1,249 yards) ... On January 14, California hired **Justin Wilcox** as head coach, replacing Sonny Dykes. Dykes was 19-30 in four seasons.

**OREGON:** Freshman QB **Justin Herbert** became the first true freshman at Oregon to start at quarterback since 1983. In his third start, Herbert set a school record for total offense (512) and tied the single-game passing record (489). Herbert's 12 TD passes in his first three starts matched the most TD passes in a three-game stretch in school history. He tied Marcus Mariota (2012) and Joey Harrington (2000) ... Freshman LB **Troy Dye** led the Ducks in tackles (91). Dye was the first true freshman at Oregon to start the opener at linebacker in over 38 years ... On December 7, Oregon hired **Willie Taggart** to replace Mark Helfrich. Helfrich was 37-16 in four seasons.

**OREGON STATE:** The Beavers snapped an eight-year losing skid in the Civil War with a 34-24 come-from-behind win over Oregon ... Sophomore RB **Ryan Nall** has rushed for 329 yards on 50 carries with 5 TDs in two Civil War games. Nall rushed for 950 yards in 2016 and has 1,405 in his career ... The Beavers played one of the nation's most difficult schedules. Seven of OSU's opponents reached bowl eligibility.

**STANFORD:** Won six in a row and has posted over 500 yards of total offense in three of the last four games ... Has averaged 37.2 ppg over the last six games (223 points), after scoring just 119 points (17.0 ppg) through the first seven games of the season. Junior RB **Christian McCaffrey** lead the nation in all-purpose yards (211.5 ypg) and was fourth in rushing (145.7 ypg). He rushed for 991 yards over his last five games, including a Big Game record 284 yards ... Sophomore QB **Keller Chryst** started the last six games and was a perfect 6-0 in those starts.

**WASHINGTON:** The Huskies recorded their second 12-win season in school history (12-0 in 1991) ... Washington had a 176-40 scoring advantage in the first quarter this season, and 335-105 in the first half ... Led the FBS in turnover margin (+1.29) ... Sophomore RB **Myles Gaskin** rushed for 1,000 yards (1,373) for the second straight season ... Sophomore QB **Jake Browning** set the UW and tied the Pac-12 single-season record with 43 TD passes ... Junior WR **John Ross** (17 TD receptions) and Junior WR **Dante Pettis** (15 TD receptions) are the first pair of Husky teammates to have double digit TD receptions in the same season.

**WASHINGTON STATE:** WSU set school single-season records for points (496) and touchdowns (67) ... For the first time in school history, the WSU running backs combined for more than 1,000 rushing yards and 1,000 receiving yards ... Senior WR **Gabe Marks** completed his WSU career with a Pac-12 career record 316 receptions, the 13th receiver in NCAA FBS history with 300+ career receptions. He also established a school career record with 3,453 receiving yards ... Junior QB **Luke Falk** finished the year with 4,470 passing yards, third-most in WSU season history. Matched his WSU record of 38 TD passes set last season. He owns 89 career TD passes, trailing only Connor Halliday's school record of 90.

### NOTES FROM THE SOUTH

**ARIZONA:** Arizona reclaimed the Territorial Cup after rushing for a school record 511 yards in a 56-35 win against Arizona State. The Wildcats had three players -- **Brandon Dawkins**, **Samajie Grant** and **Zach Green** -- produce 100-yard rushing outputs. The last known game with three individuals gaining 100 net rushing yards in the same game was Nov. 6, 1993 vs. Oregon ... Senior WR **Nate Phillips** caught at least one pass in 45 straight games. He finished his career with 153 catches and 1,946 career yards. Phillips had 15 career TDs, which is tied for 11th all-time at UA.

**ARIZONA STATE:** Junior RB **Kalen Ballage**'s 14 rushing TDs in 2016 are tied for seventh in ASU school single-season history ... The Sun Devils had 22 rushing TDs in the red zone this season (Top-25 in the country) - notable as ASU had just 19 rushing TDs period in 2015 ... **N'Keal Harry** set the school record for receptions (58) and receiving yards (659) by a freshman ... Senior PK **Zane Gonzalez** scored a point in 51 consecutive games (every game he has played at ASU). He was 22-of-24 on his field goals, only twice missing from 53 yards.

**COLORADO:** Ten-win season for the first time since 2001, and its 8-1 mark in league play is CU's first-ever 8-win conference season ... Senior DB **Tedric Thompson** has a CU single-season record-tying seven interceptions (matching Dick Anderson in 1967, Cullen Bryant in 1972) ... Senior QB **Sefo Liufau** has broken 87 school records and among them are career passing yards (9,763) and career total offense (10,702) ... Consistency in the defensive starting lineup has led the Buffs to be ranked 19th in the FBS in total defense (342.5 avg), 20th in scoring defense (21.7 ppg) ... Junior RB **Phillip Lindsay** rushed for 1,252 yards and a Pac-12 best 16 rushing TDs. Lindsay is the first Buff to rush for 1,000 yards since Rodney Stewart rushed for 1,318 yards in 2010.

**UCLA:** Senior LB **Jayon Brown** led the Bruins in tackles for the season at 119 which is tied for 16th on the all-time school single-season list ... Senior DL **Tak McKinley** ranks 11th in the nation in tackles for loss/g (1.6) and 10th in the nation in sacks/g (.91) ... The Bruins allowed 12 TD passes this season. It was the fewest allowed in a season since the 2001 UCLA team also gave up 12 ... The Bruins held six opponents this season to under 400 yards of total offense for the first time since 2010.

**USC:** QB **Sam Darnold**, the Pac-12 Freshman Offensive Player of the Year, has completed 246-of-366 passes for 3,086 yards and a USC freshman record 31 touchdowns with just nine interceptions ... The Trojans closed the season on a 9-game winning streak, their longest since 2008-09 ... Darnold is the first USC QB since Matt Leinart (2004) to throw multiple TDs in seven straight games ... USC's offense closed with nine straight games with 400-plus total yards ... Junior CB-WR-RET **Adoree' Jackson**, the Pat Tillman Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, scored three TDs in the win against Notre Dame - 55-yard punt return, 52-yard catch and run, 97-yard kick return.

**UTAH:** Senior RB **Joe Williams** has rushed for 1,407 yards (156.3 avg) in just nine games this season, including a Utah single-game record 332 yards at UCLA. He's the 13th player in Ute history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season ... Senior DE **Hunter Dimick** was third the nation in sacks with 14.5 and holds the Utah record for career sacks with 29.5 ... Senior PK **Andy Phillips** is the first player in Utah football history to reach 400 points. Phillips concluded his career with 427 career points and a streak of 95 consecutive made extra point, tying the school record with Andre Guard.
