The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

## PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE: Nick Wilson, RB, Arizona

DEFENSE: Eric Kendricks, LB, UCLA

SPECIAL TEAMS: Drew Riggleman, P, Arizona

SAN FRANCISCO - Running back **Nick Wilson** of Arizona, linebacker **Eric Kendricks** of UCLA and punter **Drew Riggleman** of ARIZONA, have been named offensive, defensive and special teams Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Wilson, a freshman from Fresno, Calif., ran through Utah to lead the Wildcats to a 42-10 victory, on the road in Salt Lake City. Wilson carried the ball 20 times for a career-high 218 yards and added three rushing touchdowns (17,75 and 19 yards) to hold off the Utes while Arizona played the second half without its starting quarterback Anu Solomon. In a three minute span in the fourth quarter, Wilson rushed for 114 yards and two touchdowns on six carries. With Arizona leading 21-10, and pinned at its own 5-yard line, Wilson carried five-straight times as the Wildcats marched 95 yards in just over two minutes on their first possession of the fourth quarter. Wilson's 75-yard touchdown capped the pivotal drive, which gave UA some breathing room. It was Wilson's third-straight 100-yard game and his first 200-yard game. The game pushed his season rushing total to 1,085 yards, making him the first Arizona freshman to rush for over 1,000 yards in a single season.

Kendricks, a senior from Fresno, Calif., led UCLA with 14 tackles, a tackle for loss and an interception in the Bruins 38-20 win over USC. His interception, the third of this season, helped to set up a late second quarter touchdown scoring drive which handed the Bruins a huge momentum lift and a 24-14 halftime lead. He has led or tied for the team tackles lead in all games this season. Kendricks now ranks second on the all-time school list for tackles, just eight shy of matching Jerry Robinson's total of 468 set in 1975-78. He recorded the ninth double-digit tackle effort of the season, one short of the school record, and the 23rd of his career. Kendricks leads the Pac-12 with 11.6 tackles per game (5th in the nation) and in solo tackles with a mark of 8.1, which ranks first in the FBS.

Riggleman, a junior from Tucson, Ariz., played a key role in Arizona's 42-10 win over Utah. Riggleman punted seven times for an average of 52.0 yards, including a booming 67-harder that nearly matched his career-long of 70 yards, and downed three punts inside of the 20-yard line. Riggleman's punts helped Arizona to a five-yard advantage in starting field position. The Utes went three-and-out three times after Riggleman punts and gained only 183 total yards with no points on the seven drives after he punted. Arizona is second in the Pac-12 in punting and Riggleman's 46.5-yard punting average ranks second-best in school history and is tied for third-best in the nation.

### AROUND THE PAC-12...

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The visiting teams are now 29-20 (.592) in league road games. The four teams ranked in this week's AP Top 25 (Oregon, UCLA, Arizona and Arizona State) have combined overall road record of 17-2 (.895).

**NORTH SET, SOUTH YET TO BE DETERMINED:** OREGON clinched the North Division's spot in the Pac-12 FCG (Dec. 5 at Levi's Stadium). As for the South Division, UCLA controls its own destiny. Should the Bruins win Friday vs. Stanford, they would represent the South Division in the Pac-12 FCG. Should the Bruins stumble, waiting in the wings will be the winner of the Territorial Cup (ARIZONA vs. ARIZONA STATE).

**MORE MANNION:** OREGON STATE senior QB **Sean Mannion** keeps adding to his Pac-12 career-best passing numbers, which is currently 13,438 yards. That's ninth all-time in the FBS. He needs 47 yards to move past Philip Rivers of North Carolina State (13,484 from 2000-03). Mannion also owns the top spot on the Pac-12's all-time list for total offense. He's at 12,637 yards in total offense and counting.

**AWARD WATCH LIST:** The National College Football Awards Association (NCFAA) awards continue to release their list of semifinalists. The Doak Walker Award, honoring the nation's to running back, announced its 10 semifinalists last week and USC junior **Javorius Allen** is among them...The Walter Camp Player of the Year Award announced its list of 15 semifinalists, which included OREGON QB **Marcus Mariota**, WASHINGTON LB/RB **Shaq Thompson**, and ARIZONA's **Scooby Wright**... OREGON's **Jake Fisher** is a semifinalist for the Outland Trophy honoring the nation's top interior lineman...The Hornung Award, honoring the nation's most versatile player, tabbed STANFORD's **Ty Montgomery** and WASHINGTON's **Shaq Thompson** as two for their five finalists... The Maxwell Football Club has announced its 20 finalists for Coach of the Year and three Pac-12 coaches made the list - ARIZONA's **Rich Rodriguez**, ARIZONA STATE's **Todd Graham**, and OREGON's **Mark Helfrich**.

**BOWL ELIGIBLE:** The Pac-12 has eight bowl eligible teams with two more looking to reach the six-win mark this week. OREGON STATE (5-6) and CALIFORNIA (5-6) have one more chance to become bowl eligible.

**TOUCHDOWN PASSES:** WASHINGTON STATE's **Connor Halliday** and Oregon's **Marcus Mariota** lead the league with 32 touchdown passes each, followed by CALIFORNIA's **Jared Goff** with 31 and USC's **Cody Kessler** with 30. That group matches the 2011 quartet of USC's Matt Barkley (39), Stanford's Andrew Luck (37), Oregon's Darren Thomas (33), and Washington's Keith Price (33), as the most Pac-12 quarterbacks to throw 30 or more touchdowns in a single season. COLORADO's **Sefo Liufau** (27) and ARIZONA's **Anu Solomon** (25) aren't far behind.

**IN A RUSH:** If CALIFORNIA's **Daniel Lasco** (968 yards) and ARIZONA STATE's **D.J. Foster** (968) pick up 15 and 32 rushing yards respectively, they'll join five others who have rushed for 1,000 yards this season - UCLA's **Paul Perkins** (1,265), UTAH's **Devontae Booker** (1,255), USC's **Javorius Allen** (1,244), ARIZONA's **Nick Wilson** (1,085) and OREGON's **Royce Freeman** (1,050). Only the 2011 season saw seven running backs rush for 1,000 yards.

**ARIZONA STATE (9-2) at ARIZONA (9-2) for the Territorial Cup**  
**Fri., Nov. 28, 1:30 p.m. MT/3:30 p.m. ET, FOX/FOX Deportes**

**ARIZONA STATE:** Scored 31 second-half points on its way to a 52-31 victory over Washington State...With his second TD pass Saturday, senior QB **Taylor Kelly** passed Andrew Walter (510 points, 2001-04) for most points responsible for in a career. Kelly is now responsible for 528 points (88 TDs: 75 pass, 13 rush)...With two more touchdown passes, Kelly will join Walter as the only quarterbacks in program history to throw for 20+ touchdowns in three-straight seasons...Forced five turnovers against WSU (4 INT, 1 fumble recovery), turning them into five TDs (35 points). On the year, ASU has outscored opponents 125-44 in points off turnovers...RB **D.J. Foster** extended his streak to 38 consecutive games with a reception.

**ARIZONA:** Won its ninth game of the regular season with their 42-10 win over Utah, a regular season feat they have not accomplished since going 12-1 in 1998... RB **Nick Wilson** rushed for a career-high, and UA freshman record, 218 yards and 3 TDs at Utah. With 1,085 rushing yards this season, he provided Arizona with a 1,000-yard rusher for the third straight season, something the 'Cats have done only once before (1972-74). His 12 rushing TDs are the most ever by a UA frosh... Defense has forced 11 turnovers in the last three games. To date, the Cats have outscored opponents 90-15 off turnovers...Junior LB **Scooby Wright III** ranks first in the nation, averaging 2.0 tackles for loss per game.

**LAST TIME:** ASU notched its seventh consecutive win, defeating Arizona 58-21 in the Territorial Cup, clinching home-field advantage in the Pac-12 Championship. Taylor Kelly completed 13 of 25 for 274 yards and two TDs, while D.J. Foster rushed for a career-high 124 yards and two TDs. The Sun Devils forced five turnovers, including an interception by Damarious Randall, who returned it 64 yards for a TD.

**STANFORD (6-5) at UCLA (9-2)**  
**Fri., Nov. 28, 12:30 p.m. PT/3:30 p.m. ET, ABC**

**STANFORD:** Has scored at least 10 points in a national-best 93 consecutive games... Stanford has scored 101 points in its last two games against Cal, the most points in a two-game stretch by either team in the Big Game's history... Senior RB **Remound Wright** became the first Cardinal to run for four touchdowns in a game since Stepfan Taylor on Nov. 6, 2010, against Arizona, tying the program record for most rushing touchdowns in a single game. It also tied the Big Game record for rushing touchdowns in the rivalry's 117-game history...Senior PK **Jordan Willamson** has made 67 consecutive extra points, tied for the second longest streak in program history.

**UCLA:** Has won nine games for the third straight season, the first time in school history it has won nine in back-to-back-to-back years...The Bruins scored at least 35 points for the third straight game against USC, the first time they have accomplished that feat...Junior QB **Brett Hundley** completed 22 of 31 passes for 326 yards in the win over USC. Hundley moved past Cade McNown (1995-98 - 11,285 yards) to become UCLA's all-time leader in total offense with 11,353 yards. It was his third straight 300-yard total offense performance of the year and extended his own school record of 19 career 300-yard total offense games...Senior LB **Eric Kendricks** had a game-high 14 tackles against USC. He needs eight more tackles to tie Jerry Robinson's school record of 468. His 128 tackles are 10th on UCLA's single-season list... Junior K **Ka'imi Fairbairn** has made 28 straight field goals from 35 yards and in.

**LAST TIME:** Tyler Gaffney ran for 171 yards and two TDs, and No. 13 Stanford defeated No. 9 UCLA, 24-10, with a physical performance on both sides of the ball. The Cardinal outgained UCLA 419 yards to 266, and won the time of possession 37:11 to 22:49. Kevin Hogan completed 18-of-25 for 227 yards and one TD.

**UTAH (7-4) at COLORADO (2-9)**  
**Sat., Nov. 29, 11 a.m. MT/2 p.m. ET, P12N**

**UTAH:** Senior DE **Nate Orchard** increased his single-season sacks record to 17.5 sacks (FBS best 1.59/game)... He broke the previous school record of 15 (Jimmy Bellamy, 1991)...Junior RB **Devontae Booker** rushed for 142 yards on 23 carries, his sixth 100-yard game this season. Booker has 1,255 rushing yards this season, moving into fourth on Utah's single-season list...Junior PK **Andy Phillips** is 20-for-24 in field goals for the season. His 20 field goals is tied for second-most in a season at Utah (Joe Phillips, 2009). Louie Sakoda owns the school record with 22 in 2008... Junior P **Tom Hackett** had three punts of 50+ yards, giving him 23 for the season, which is the second-most all-time at Utah.

**COLORADO:** Set its single-season record for the most offensive plays, pushing its season total to 933 points. The Buffaloes previous mark was 897 set in 2007... Junior WR **Nelson Spruce** reached the 200 career catch mark. He has caught at least one pass in 24-straight games and caught multiple passes in 20 straight games. He has a CU single-season record 101 receptions...Senior PK **Will Oliver** has now made 98 consecutive extra points (school record)...QB Sefo Liufau was only in for 22 snaps at Oregon, but continued his trek with at least one TD pass in 19-straight games.

**LAST TIME:** Utah jumped out to 21-0 first-half lead and hung on to beat Colorado 24-17. Trevor Reilly posted 14 tackles and intercepted a pass with 2:01 remaining to seal the win. Adam Schulz got his first college win, passing for 233 yards and a TD. Kelvin York rushed for a career-high 132 yards and two TDs.

**Notre Dame (7-4) at USC (7-4) for the Shillelagh**  
**Sat., Nov. 29, 12:30 p.m. PT/3:30 p.m. ET, FOX/FOX Deportes**

**USC:** The Trojans dropped their third-straight game to UCLA, 38-20, for the first time since the three year stretch of 1996-98...Junior QB **Cody Kessler** continues to have the most efficient and accurate season of any Trojan quarterback ever (he has hit nearly 70% of his passes with 30 TDs and just 4 picks)...Junior RB **Javorius Allen** has rushed for 1,244 yards in 2014 with 8 100-yard outings this season, and tops the Pac-12 with 1,669 all-purpose yards (151.7 avg)...USC has outscored foes by 100 points in the first quarter and has yet to allow an opponent to score on its opening possession this season.

**LAST TIME:** Notre Dame snapped a 5-game home losing streak to USC by holding off the Trojans, 14-10. All the scoring was done in the first half as the teams managed just 173 total yards between them in the second half (only 52 by the Irish). Silas Redd rushed for 112 yards, while Nelson Agholor posted 209 all-purpose yards.

**BYU (7-4) at CALIFORNIA (5-6)**  
**Sat., Nov. 29, 1:30 p.m. or 3:30 p.m. PT/4:30 p.m. ET, P12N**

**CALIFORNIA:** Cal has 33 touchdown passes this season, which set a school single-season record, surpassing the previous record of 32 set in 1996...Sophomore QB **Jared Goff** set the school single-season record for passing yards, now with 3,580, surpassing the record he set in 2013 as a freshman (3,508). He now has 31 touchdown passes this season, he tied Pat Barnes' 31 passing scores in 1996 for the school single-season record. Goff's 49 career passing touchdowns are sixth in school history. Kevin Riley is fifth with 50. Now with 7,088 career passing yards, Goff remained fifth all-time in school history. Rich Campbell (1977-80) is fourth with 7,174... **Daniel Lasco** posted his fourth 100-yard rushing game of the season with 103 yards on 18 carries vs. Stanford.

**LAST TIME:** In a 35-28 Las Vegas Bowl victory, California's Marshawn Lynch rushed for career highs of 194 yards and three TDs to win the game's MVP award. DeSean Jackson caught two scoring passes before Cal's defense held off BYU for the win.

**OREGON (10-1) at OREGON STATE (5-6) in the Civil War**  
**Sat., Nov. 29, 5 p.m. PT/8 p.m. ET, ABC**

**OREGON:** The Ducks have now won 10 or more games in seven straight seasons, tied for the fifth-longest streak of college football's modern era...Junior QB **Marcus Mariota** became the sixth FBS player in history to pass for at least 9,000 yards and rush for 2,000 or more yards in a career. Mariota set the Pac-12 single season record for total touchdowns at 42 (32 pass, 8 rush, 1 rec). His eight games with four or more touchdowns is the most in the FBS this season...**Royce Freeman** became the first true freshman to rush for 1,000 yards in a season at Oregon (1,050).

**OREGON STATE:** A win over the Ducks, and the Beavers would become bowl eligible...Senior QB **Sean Mannion**, the first Pac-12 Conference with quarterback with more than 13,000 passing yards, threw for 314 yards on 30-for-46 passing at Washington. His two touchdown strikes gave him 82 for his career, tying former Stanford QB Andrew Luck for seventh-most in conference history...**Victor Bolden** had 10 receptions for a career-best 145 yards.

**LAST TIME:** Marcus Mariota threw a 12-yard touchdown pass to Josh Huff with 29 seconds left and No. 12 Oregon sealed its sixth straight 10-win season with a 36-35 win over Oregon State in the 117th edition of the Civil War rivalry. Mariota threw for 285 yards and three touchdowns - all to Huff, who had nine catches for a season-high 186 yards.

**WASHINGTON (7-5) at WASHINGTON STATE (3-8) for the Apple Cup**  
**Sat., Nov. 29, 7:30 p.m. PT/10:30 p.m. ET, FOX Sports 1**

**WASHINGTON:** Senior LB **Hau'oli Kikaha** has recorded a sack in 11 of 12 games this season. He now has 17.5 on the season, 34.5 in his career. He has sole possession of fifth all-time in Pac-12 single-season history and eighth on the career list. Kikaha is tied with Nate Orchard of Utah for the national lead. The sack also moved Kikaha past Ron Holmes (23 in 1983) for most tackles for loss in a season with 23.5...Sophomore QB **Cyler Miles** threw for over 200 yards for the second straight game as he was 18-of-23 for 253 yards and 2 TDs against OSU, connecting with eight different receivers.

**WASHINGTON STATE:** Over the last three games in place of the injured Connor Halliday, freshman QB **Luke Falk** has completed 127-of-192 (.661) for 1418 yards and 10 touchdowns...With a school-record 15 receptions for 252 yards at ASU, senior WR **Vince Mayle** extended his WSU single-season records with 101 receptions and 1,404 receiving yards...**Jamal Morrow** caught four passes to up his season total to 61, breaking Steve Broussard's 1987 school record for catches in a season by a running back (59).

**LAST TIME:** Bishop Sankey blitzed Washington State for 139 of his 200 yards rushing in the second half to become Washington's all-time single-season rushing leader, and the Huskies reclaimed the Apple Cup with a 27-17 win over the Cougars.

## PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 5 at 9 p.m. ET/6 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played at Levi's® Stadium in Santa Clara. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's berth into the College Football Playoff.

### TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all Conference games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the Conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

#### Two-Team Tie.

- A. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
- B. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
  1. Record in inter-divisional games.
  2. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the division.
  3. Record in common Conference games.
  4. Highest ranking in the CFP poll entering the final weekend of regular-season games.
  5. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
    - i. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
    - ii. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
  6. Coin toss.

#### Multiple-Team Ties.

In the event of a tie for a division championship between more than two teams, the following procedure shall be used to eliminate all but two tied teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure shall be used.

- A. Head-to-head (best record in games among the tied teams).
- B. Record in inter-divisional games.
- C. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the division.
- D. Record in common Conference games.
- E. Highest ranking in the CFP poll entering the final weekend of regular-season games.

#### Pac-12 Championship Game - Determination of Home Team

The home team in the Pac-12 Championship Game will be determined by the record in all Conference games. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the home team.

#### Tie-breaking Procedure.

- A. Head-to-head, if applicable.
- B. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the Conference (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the Conference.
- C. Record in common Conference games.
- D. Highest ranking in the CFP poll following the final weekend of the regular-season games.
- E. Coin toss.

## PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2014-15

The Pac-12 is in the first year of a six-year agreement with seven bowl partners that should provide the Conference with a competitive post-season bowl experience. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl Game presented by Northwestern Mutual, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion. In addition to the Rose Bowl, Pac-12 bowl partners include the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, the National University Holiday Bowl in San Diego, the San Francisco Bowl, the Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the Royal Purple Las Vegas Bowl, and the Cactus Bowl in Tempe. In 2014-15, the Rose Bowl Game is slotted as one of the College Football Playoff semifinal games. If no Pac-12 team was in the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2014 season it would not have a team in the Rose Bowl. The displaced Pac-12 Champion and any other Pac-12 team ranked high enough would fill a berth in the other four bowls (Orange, Atlanta, Fiesta and Cotton Bowls). When the Rose Bowl does not host a semifinal game, the Pac-12 champion would play in the Rose Bowl unless it was ranked in the top four and would play in one of the semifinal games. The Pac-12 would back-fill the Rose Bowl game if the Pac-12 champion was in the top four and playing in one of the semifinal games.
