OFFENSE

Travis Wilson, Sr., QB
Utah

Returned to action after missing last game with injury to post 327 yards of total offense (227 passing, 100 rushing) and 5 TDs (4 passing, 1 rushing) to lead Utah to a 62-20 win at Oregon. Went 18-of-30 passing with no interceptions and had a career-long rush of 60 yards.

DEFENSE

Kyle Kragen, Sr., DE
California

In Cal's 30-24 victory at Washington, Kragen registered a career-high six tackles and 2.5 sacks (-16 yards). In addition, he forced a fumble and had a pass breakup as teh Bears moved to 4-0 for the first time since 2007.

SPECIAL TEAMS

Tom Hackett, Sr., P
Utah

Had three punts for 181 yards (60.3 average), dropping all three punts inside the 10-yard line (8, 1 and 4-yard lines). Career-long punt of 76 yards ranks seventh in school history. Also rushed 33 yards on a fake punt that led to a Utah touchdown on the possession to take a 48-13 lead.

PAC-12 QUICK HITS

ROAD WARRIORS: In six Conference games played to date, the visiting team has won all six by an average of 21.7 points.

AT THE POLLS: UTAH is in the Top 10 for the first time since 2010 and received its first ever first-place vote in the AP Top 25 ... CALIFORNIA is ranked for the first time since 2010.

The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

AROUND THE PAC-12

POLL WATCHING: CALIFORNIA makes its first appearance in the AP Top 25 since 2010 ... UTAH moves up to No. 10 in this week's AP poll, becoming the fourth different Pac-12 team this season to be ranked in the Top 10. Utah also received its first ever first-place vote in the regular season AP poll ... UCLA moves up to No. 7 in this week's AP Top 25. It's the highest ranking for the Bruins since coming in at No. 7 in the Oct. 20, 2005 poll ... Over the last two seasons, nine different Pac-12 teams have been ranked among the AP Top 25, while six different Conference teams have been ranked among the Top 10 ... With OREGON falling out of the AP poll, the Ducks had their streak of Top 25 appearances snapped at 98 weeks. It had been the nation's second-longest active streak.

I'LL TAKE QUARTERBACKS FOR 100: There have been 29 100-yard rushing performances in the Pac-12 this season, with five turned in by quarterbacks. Three different quarterbacks have rushed for 100 or more yards this season:

Seth Collins, Oregon State - 152 vs. Weber State, 114 vs. San Jose State
Jarred Randall, Arizona - 149 vs. Northern Arizona, 128 vs. UCLA
Travis Wilson, Utah - 100 vs. Oregon

ALL-PURPOSE: STANFORD sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** is currently averaging a Conference-best 222.2 all-purpose yards per game, which is third in the FBS. Since 1978, only four other Conference players have averaged 200 or more all-purpose yards per game for an entire season - USC's Marcus Allen in 1981 (232.6 avg), Stanford's Glyn Milburn in 1990 (202.0 avg), USC's Reggie Bush in 2005 (222.3 avg) and USC's Marqise Lee in 2012 (206.4 avg). Coincidentally, Milburn's teammate in 1990 was Ed McCaffrey (father of Christian), who had 61 receptions for 917 yards and a Conference-leading 91.7 receiving yards per game.

60+ POINTS ON THE ROAD: With its 62-20 win at Oregon, UTAH is the fifth different Pac-12 team to score 60 or more points on the road in league play since 2013. Here's the list:

PAC-12 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

#100Pac12: The Pac-12 Conference is set to celebrate 100 years of excellence. The yearlong celebration of the Conference centennial, including marking the date of the official formation 100 years ago on December 2, will kick off with the start of the football season and continue throughout the 2015-16 academic year.

The Conference's storied history dates back 100 years to Dec. 2, 1915 when four schools - the University of California, Oregon Agricultural College (now Oregon State University), the University of Oregon and the University of Washington - gathered at the historic Imperial Hotel in Portland, Ore., to form the Pacific Coast Conference.

Since that day, the Conference has been known for its widespread excellence – on the field, in the classroom, and with the contributions its graduates make in the world. No other Conference can match the collective achievements and distinctions accomplished over the last century.

#COMPLETE12

COMPLETE CAMPAIGN: Pac-12 students are known for their success on the field, but they are also impressive, complete people with outside interests, diverse backgrounds, extracurricular activities, interesting families, busy schedules, and full lives. Here's a look at some of the off-field accomplishments:



COMMUNITY SERVICE: WASHINGTON STATE football students combined for 171 hours of community service projects during the 2015 spring semester and 357 total hours of community service during the 2014-15 academic year. Senior LB **Jeremiah Allison** has been involved with many community service projects in and around Pullman, including assisting in Habitat for Humanity, the Washington State Athletics Reading Buddies with local elementary schools, Sr. Buddies at the local retirement home and Butch's Holiday Bash for local children. He also helped with National Women in Sports Day and is a member of the Student-Athlete Advisory Committee for football. He was the recent recipient of the WSU athletic community service award, as he volunteered the most hours among WSU student-athletes. He also serves as an outlet to local individuals who lost their parent or parents to share words of inspiration.

THIS WEEK'S GAMES

WASHINGTON STATE at CALIFORNIA

Sat., Oct. 3 • 1 p.m. PT • PAC12

WASHINGTON STATE: Following a bye weekend, the Cougars now hit the road for three of their next four games ... WSU looks for its third straight win. It's won three straight just once in the last eight seasons and that occurred in 2013 when it included a Pac-12 road-opening win at No. 25 USC ... The Cougars lead the Conference in passing, averaging 362.7 yards per game. They have given up just five sacks in 156 pass attempts (1 every 31.2 attempts) ... Junior WR **Gabe Marks** leads the Pac-12 with 8.3 receptions per game, while averaging 91.0 receiving yards per game.

CALIFORNIA: Ranked in the AP Top-25 for the first time since 2010 ... 4-0 for the first time since 2007, Cal is one victory shy of matching the school's best start over the last 65 seasons since the 1950 squad won its first nine games during a 9-1-1 campaign ... Cal picked up five sacks and utilized five turnovers to defeat Washington, 30-24 ... The Bears lead the FBS with nine interception and turnovers gained with 14. They had 12 and 17 respectively all of last season ... Junior WR **Kenny Lawler** recorded a season-high 112 receiving yards on seven catches (he's caught a pass in all 27 games he's played at Cal). His 8-yard TD reception in the third quarter gave him 19 career TD receptions, which ranks seventh all-time at Cal.

Last Meeting: Jared Goff threw for 527 yards and 5 TDs as California held on to beat Washington State 60-59. WSU quarterback Connor Halliday broke the NCAA passing record as he threw for 734 yards and 6 TDs. The two teams combined for 1,400 yards of offense. Goff's 51-yard touchdown pass to Trevor Davis with 3:18 left in the game provided the winning points for California. Davis also ran two kickoffs back for TDs in the wild third quarter when the two teams combined to score 56 points.

ARIZONA STATE at UCLA

Sat., Oct. 3 • 4:30 p.m. MT • FOX

ARIZONA STATE: Sophomore RB **Demario Richard** carried 14 times for 131 yards (9.4 avg) and two TDs in the loss to USC. He now has 10 touchdowns in his last five games. ... Senior WR **D.J. Foster** became just the fourth player in NCAA history to reach 2,000+ rushing and receiving yards, joining Stanford's Darrin Nelson, Tulane's Mewelde Moore and Texas Tech's Taurean Henderson. Foster is the first player to accomplish the feat since Henderson in 2005 ... Foster has accounted for at least one reception in each of the 44 games he has played at ASU, the longest active streak in FBS. That ties the ASU record held by John Jefferson from 1974-77.

UCLA: With the win over then-No. 16 Arizona last Saturday, the Bruins are now 6-1 in last seven games vs. ranked opponents, and 11-6 vs. ranked teams under Jim Mora ... With 85 rushing yards at Arizona, junior RB **Paul Perkins** now has cracked UCLA's the top 10 career rushing list with 2,662 yards ... Senior WR **Jordan Payton** grabbed seven receptions for 136 yards and one TD in the win at Arizona. He has caught a pass in a team-best 20 straight games and is tied for sixth all-time at UCLA with 142 career receptions.

Last Meeting: Defensive back Ishmael Adams returned a kickoff 100 yards and an interception 95 yards for another score, sparking No. 11 UCLA to a big win over No. 15 Arizona State. In posting the 62-27 victory, the Bruins scored the most points by an opponent in the 55-year history of Sun Devil Stadium. Brett Hundley returned from a left arm injury to throw for 355 yards and four TDs, including a pair of 80-yard scoring throws to Eldridge Massington and Jordan Payton.

OREGON at COLORADO

Sat., Oct. 3 • 8 p.m. PT • ESPN

OREGON: In the 62-20 loss, Oregon gave up the most points by opponent in Autzen Stadium ... The Ducks have rushed for 200 or more yards in 23 of 32 games under Mark Helfrich, but it's the first time Oregon has dropped a game in which it has rushed for 200 or more yards in those 23 games. It is now 22-1 in such games ... Sophomore RB **Royce Freeman** totaled 123 all-purpose yards and hauled in a TD in the loss to Utah. He has scored a TD in each game this year and has 25 overall.

COLORADO: CU has won three straight for the first time since the first three games of the 2008 season, and will go for four in a row for the first time since winning five straight in 2002 ... For the second time this season, CU had a pair of running backs each post 100 or more yards rushing in the same game as **Phillip Lindsay** (113 yards on 17 carries/6.6 avg) and **Donovan Lee** (103 yards on 10 carries/10.3 avg) accomplished the feat in the win over Nicholls ... WR **Nelson Spruce** set the all-time mark in receiving yards with 2,570. He is still chasing the career TD mark (he has 20, two shy of Scotty McKnight's record).

Last Meeting: The Ducks put together perhaps their most dominating performance of the season, rolling up 597 yards of offense and allowing just 226 in a 55-10 win at Autzen Stadium. Touchdowns on four of Oregon's first five drives put the game out of reach early. Marcus Mariota accounted for 396 yards of offense and four TDs, in the process becoming just the sixth player in major college history with 9,000 career passing yards and 2,000 rushing yards.

ARIZONA at STANFORD

Sat., Oct. 3 • 7:30 p.m. PT • PAC12

ARIZONA: Senior QB **Jerrard Randall** filled in for injured starter **Anu Solomon** in the second quarter of its loss to UCLA. Randall's first snap resulted in a 39-yard TD run. It was his shortest TD run of his career as he also has TD runs of 73, 72, and 57 yards. Randall rushed for 128 yards on 16 carries (8.0 avg) against the Bruins for his second straight 100-yard rushing game ... With 136 yards on 24 carries (5.7 avg), sophomore RB **Nick Wilson** has rushed for 100 or more yards in three straight games and 10 for his career. He has rushed for 2,035 yards/21 TDs in 17 career games.

STANFORD: After opening Pac-12 play at 2-0, with both wins on the road, the Cardinal begins a three-game home stand ... Sophomore RB **Christian McCaffrey** ran for a career-high 206 yards on 30 carries (6.9 avg) and racked up 303 all-purpose yards in the win at Oregon State. It was the first Cardinal performance over 300 yards since 2009. Over the last two games, McCaffrey has 552 all-purpose yards (321 rush, 75 receiving, 156 kick return). He leads the Conference, and is third in the FBS, in all-purpose yards, averaging 222.2 yards per game ... Senior LB **Blake Martinez** had a team-high 12 tackles in the win at Oregon State. It was his fourth straight game with double-digit tackles, and is currently third in the FBS with 12.5 tackles per game.

Last Meeting: Trailing 48-34 with fewer than 10 minutes left in the fourth quarter, the Cardinal rallied behind quarterback Josh Nunes to defeat Arizona 54-48 in overtime. Nunes completed 21 of 34 passes for 360 yards and 2 TDs and ran for three more scores. Arizona QB Matt Scott set school records in attempts (69) and completions (45) for 491 yards and 5 TDs.

OPEN DATE

OREGON STATE: Freshman QB **Seth Collins** completed 20 of 36 passes for 275 yards and a TD in the loss to Stanford. He now has 306 yards rushing in four games and is on pace to shatter Don Shanklin's 1994 school record of 630 rushing yards by a quarterback ... Junior LB **Caleb Saulo** led the defense with a career-best 13 tackles. Additionally Saulo forced a fumble, one of two turnovers forced by the defense. Sophomore FS **Justin Strong** had eight tackles to match his season high.

USC: Senior QB **Cody Kessler** continues to move up in the USC record book. He is now fifth in career completions (642), third for career TD passes (74). Kessler has now thrown for at least one TD pass in 27 of 31 starts, at least two TDs 19 times, at least four TDs nine times and has thrown for five or more TDs four times ... Sophomore WR **JuJu Smith-Schuster** had five receptions for 105 yards and a pair of TDs in the win at Arizona State. It was his third straight 100-yard receiving game. He currently leads the Pac-12 with 134.2 receiving yards per game, averaging 19.9 yards per catch.

UTAH: With its 62-20 win at Oregon, Utah is collecting some national honors this week. The FWAA tabbed the Utes as the AutoNation National Team of the Week. Senior P **Tom Hackett** was named the Ray Guy Award Player of the Week after he averaged 60.3 yards per punt on three boots. All three landed inside the 10-yard line (8, 1, 4-yard lines). Hackett is the reigning Ray Guy Award winner. Senior QB **Travis Wilson** was named one of eight winners of the Manning Award Stars of the Week after he completed 18 of 30 pass attempts for 227 yards and 4 TDs with no interceptions, and ran for 100 yards on six carries (16.7 avg).

WASHINGTON: In the 30-24 loss to California, the Huskies scored their first 1st quarter touchdown, with junior TB **Dwayne Washington** accounting for all the yards on the five-play, 71-yard drive with a 14-yard touchdown. Washington posted his fifth career 100-yard game as he rushed for 109 yards on 10 carries (10.9 avg) ... Defensively, four Huskies combined for five sacks and sophomore LB **Azeem Victor** and LB **Keishawn Bierria** each recorded 12 tackles ... The Huskies have given up just 20 points in the second half all season, outscoring opponents 65-20 ... Senior WR **Jaydon Mickens** sits fifth all-time in UW history with 158 receptions and is nearing No. 4 Paul Skansi (161) and No. 3 Kasen Williams (162).

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS

The Pac-12 is in the second year of a six-year agreement with seven bowl partners that should provide the Conference with a competitive postseason bowl experience. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl Game presented by Northwestern Mutual, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion. In 2015-16, the Cotton Bowl and Orange Bowl are slotted as the College Football Playoff semifinal games. If the Pac-12 champion is ranked among the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2015 season and play in either the Cotton or Orange Bowl, the Pac-12 would back-fill the Rose Bowl game.

USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

USC was chosen as the favorite to win the 2015 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll vote of 45 media members. The Trojans received 21 of 45 votes to earn the preseason favorite pick. USC collected 254 points for the top spot in the South Division, holding 32 of 45 first-place votes. Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON holds the second-most Championship votes, as they garnered 17 votes for the Pac-12 title. The Ducks also picked up 262 points to lead the Pac-12 North. Additionally, ARIZONA STATE tallied three votes for the Pac-12 crown and amassed 200 points for second in the Pac-12 South.

STANFORD was picked to finish second in the Pac-12 North Division, collecting 231 points with eight first-place votes. The Cardinal garnered one vote as the Pac-12 Champion. In the South Division, UCLA was picked to finish third with 180 points and collected six first-place votes, ahead of reigning South Division winner ARIZONA, which tallied 155 votes for fourth place.
