THIS WEEK IN PAC-12 SOFTBALL

• Arizona is the new number one as the Wildcats posted a perfect 3-0 weekend to continue Pac-12 softball Conference play. Oregon tied NCAA history recording 35 consecutive victories before falling to UCLA Friday night and Utah recorded two wins against California.

• Arizona's **Katiyana Mauga** earned her second consecutive player of the week nod after hitting four home runs in nine at-bats to help Arizona sweep Stanford. She leads the Conference in home runs (16) and moved into a tie for seventh in NCAA history in career home runs (83). UCLA's **Rachel Garcia** was named both pitcher and freshman of the week after not allowing a run in her two victories against previous No. 1 Oregon, tossing a complete-game, five-hitter with three strikeouts in Friday's 2-0 win. She also added four hits in eight at-bats in the three-game series, scoring the game-winning run on Friday and posting a pair of doubles on Sunday.

• Seven teams continue to be ranked with Arizona taking the number one spot in the USA Softball/ESPN.com poll. Previous No. 1 Oregon slid to No. 4 in both polls. UCLA remains at No. 8/9, Washington is at No. 12/13, Utah is at No. 14/16, Arizona State is at No. 23/24 and California received votes in the USA Today/NFCA ranking and is at No. 23 in the USA Softball/ESPN.com poll. At least six teams have been ranked since the beginning of the season.

• A top-10 matchup of Arizona at Utah highlights the week. Washington visits Oregon, Arizona State heads north to Stanford, and UCLA is at Oregon State. California hosts non-conference opponents Santa Clara and Fresno State.

• Oregon swept a double header against Portland State Tuesday to tie the NCAA record for consecutive wins with 35. The UCLA Bruins in 1999 also opened the season 35-0. The Ducks then fell two games to UCLA on the weekend but avoided a sweep with a 11-4 victory Sunday.

• UCLA game the Ducks their first loss of the season in a 2-0 win over the previous No. 1 lead by player of the week Rachel Garcia's five-hit, complete-game shutout.

• Arizona head coach and former Team USA skipper **Mike Candrea** will be inducted into the National Softball Hall of Fame this October. On the international level, Candrea was the head coach of the Team USA's 2004 Olympic Gold Medalists and 2008 Olympic Silver Medalists. Candrea has won eight national championships at Arizona and won more than 1,500 games, both the most in NCAA Division I softball history.

• **ICYMI:** Three weeks ago 33rd year Arizona head coach Mike Candrea accomplished career win number 1,500. Carrera now has 37 wins in 38 games in 2017, and 1,505 career wins in 1,887 career games. Candrea is the fastest coach in NCAA history, in any sport, in any division, to reach 1,500 career wins. Candrea is 1,505-380-2 (.798), trailing only Michigan's Carol Hutchins 1,509-485-5 (.756), who spent time in Division II, in NCAA history.

• **PERFECT:** In the same weekend, Arizona's **Danielle O'Toole** threw her first career no-hitter, facing just two over the minimum in a seven-inning masterpiece with eight strikeouts and one walk on Friday night in the Wildcats' first victory over Oregon State. O'Toole's no-hitter was the 90th in Arizona history, and just the first seven-inning no-hitter since Taryne Mowatt no hit the Huskies in 2008. The no-hitter was Arizona's first non-mercy no-hitter against a top-10 team since Susie Parra threw an eight-inning no-hitter against No. 8 Cal in 1993. She earned both the NFCA and USA Softball National Player of the Week honors.
