THIS WEEK IN PAC-12 SOFTBALL

Pac-12 softball teams went a collective 42-4, including a perfect 10-0 on day one to start the 2017 season. ARIZONA STATE, OREGON, UCLA, UTAH, ARIZONA, and OREGON STATE went without a loss in their respective tournaments, and WASHINGTON upset the top-two ranked teams in the nation in No. 2 Auburn, 2-1, and reigning NCAA Champion and No. 1 Oklahoma, 1-0... Arizona's **Katiyana Mauga** was named the first Pac-12 Player of the Week after hitting four home runs in the Wildcats' five games. Washington's **Taran Alvelo** was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week and Stanford's **Teaghan Cowles** was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Week... All nine teams are headed to eight tournaments this week with both Oregon and UCLA headed to the Mary Nutter Collegiate Classic in Cathedral City, Calif. Stanford, Arizona and Arizona State stay local, hosting their respective tournaments... Three teams are set to travel to Southern California as Utah competes at the Long Beach State Tournament, Washington is at the Campbell/Cartier Classic in San Diego, and California is at the Palm Springs Classic. Oregon State heads to Las Cruces, New Mexico, to compete in the Troy Cox Classic... Seven teams are ranked this week in the USA Softball/ESPN.com poll as ARIZONA STATE enters the top 25 at No. 21 after going undefeated at the Kajikawa Classic. The other teams ranked are No. 5 UCLA, No. 7. Oregon, No. 9 Washington, No. 11 Arizona, No. 15 Utah and No. 22 California.

PAC-12 SOFTBALL NOTES

- **Score Big:** League teams outscored their opponents by more than double in the opening weekend, recording 308 runs while holding opponents to just 102. Seven of the nine league teams outscored their opponents by double digits this week: Arizona: 39-6; Arizona State: 37-7; California: 31-19; Oregon: 38-10; Oregon State: 12-3; UCLA: 48-2 ; Utah: 47-5
- **National Recognition:** UCLA's **Delaney Spaulding** has been named the National Field Player of the Week by *College Sports Madness* for her performances at the Stacy Winsberg Memorial Tournament that included multiple hits in four of her five games, and driving in a run in all five games with two home runs. The Bruins went a perfect 5-0 on the weekend.
- **Poll Watching:** The Pac-12 has five teams on the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll this week, and seven on the USA Today/NFCA poll. Arizona State and California joined the top 25 in the USA Softball polling, coming in at No. 21 and No. 22 respectively. UCLA continues to lead both polls at No. 6/5, Washington is at No. 8/9, Oregon is at No. 9/7, Arizona is at No. 10/11 and Utah remains at No. 16/15.
- **New Faces:** According to FloSoftball, seven Pac-12 recruiting classes are ranked in the top 25 including Oregon bringing in the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation this year. Arizona has the third-ranked class, followed by Washington, UCLA and Arizona State with the No. 6, 8 and 12 classes. Utah brings in the 13th-ranked recruiting class and Stanford rounds out at No. 14.
- **Welcome Back to the Pac:** **Trisha Ford** returns the Pac-12 in her first year at the helm of Arizona State's program after spending the last four seasons at Fresno State and spending nine seasons at Stanford from 2004-2012. Hanson joins a rank of coaches that have a combined 112 years of Division I coaching experience and more than 4,000 victories with a .703 winning percentage (4,360-1,833-8).
- **2017 Watch List:** Nine Pac-12 athletes were named to the 'watch list' for the 2017 USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year award. Arizona leads with three athletes including **Katiyana Mauga**, **Danielle O'Toole**, and **Mandie Perez**. Also included on the list are Oregon's **Kenna Lilley** and **Nikki Udria**, Washington's **Ari Aguilar**, Utah's **Hannah Flippen**, California's **Jazmyn Jackson**, and UCLA's **Delaney Spaulding**. Previous USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year award winners include UCLA catcher **Stacey Nuvean** (2002), Washington pitcher **Danielle Lawrie** (2009 and 2010), and Stanford shortstop **Ashley Hansen** (2011).

PAC-12 WEEKLY HONORS

Player of the Week: Katiyana Mauga, Arizona

- 5 GP, 6 R, 4 HR, 8 RBI, .429 AVG
- Hit four home runs in Arizona's five games to start the season 5-0, including her 70th career homer.
- She becomes the sixth player in Arizona history, eighth in Pac-12 history and 24th in NCAA history with 70 or more home runs.
- Led Arizona in RBI (8) and slugging percentage (1.357).
- This is Mauga's second career nod after taking the award in March of 2015 and a league-leading 158th for Arizona.

Pitcher Week: Taran Alvelo, Washington

- 3 GP (2 CG), 23 IP, 3-0 record, 0.91 ERA, 16K
- Started in three games, pitched 23 innings, including two full games in double header against Nebraska and No. 1 Oklahoma in the Puerto Vallarta College Challenge.
- Pitched a 2-1 win over No. 2 Auburn on Thursday and a 1-0 win over reigning NCAA Champion and No. 1 Oklahoma Saturday.
- Starting the 2017 season with a 3-0 record, allowed only four runs in three games, totaling 16 strikeouts.
- This is Alvelo's third career pitcher of the week honor.

Freshman of the Week: Teaghan Cowles, Stanford

- 6 GP, 7 R, 7 RBI, .619 AVG
- Hit .619 (13-for-21) on the weekend with seven RBIs, seven runs, two stolen bases and a triple.
- Had at least two hits in four of six games.
- Her four hits in the Cardinal's 16-9 win against Purdue tied her for the fifth-most in a single game by a Stanford player in program history.
