## THIS WEEK IN PAC-12 SOFTBALL

- Arizona, Oregon and Utah all had a perfect weekend sweeping their Conference opponents, as Oregon remains the lone undefeated team in the NCAA. The Ducks are now only two wins shy of matching the NCAA record of 35 wins to start a season set by set by UCLA in 1999.

- Arizona's **Katiyana Mauga** hit her 78th and 79th career home runs this week during the Wildcats' sweeps of Grand Canyon and California to earn player of the week honors. Her 12 home runs so far this season lead the Conference and is only one home run shy of becoming the ninth player in NCAA history with 80 career homers. Oregon's **Maggie Balint** pitched in the Ducks' all four games allowing no runs and struck out 17 batters in 11 innings to earn pitcher of the week honors. Wildcat teammate **Alyssa Palomino** earned freshman of the week honors after having four extra-base hits, including two homers, in five games on the week.

- Seven teams continue to be ranked as Oregon remains at No. 2 and No. 1 in the USA Today/NFCA and USA Softball/ESPN.com polls respectively. Arizona follows with multiple first place votes and a No. 4/3 ranking. UCLA is at No. 9/12, Washington is at No 10 in both polls, Utah is at No. 15 also in both polls, California received votes and is tied for No. 21, and Arizona State is at No.23/24.

- Conference play is in full swing as a top-15 matchup of Oregon at UCLA highlights the week. California is at Utah after hosting a non-conference matchup with St. Mary's earlier in the week, Stanford visits Arizona, and Oregon State is at Washington.

- After the first three-game sweep California since 2010, Arizona is a perfect 9-0 in Conference play. The 9-0 conference mark is Arizona's best Pac-12 start since 2004 and is currently riding a 22 game winning streak, the second longest streak in the NCAA this year behind Oregon.

- Utah completed the sweep of Stanford this weekend to remain unbeaten in Pac-12 road games. Senior **Hannah Flippen** scored three times during game two to set a new Utah mark for runs scored during a career. She broke Sandy Rhea's career runs mark of 177, which had stood for almost two decades.

## PAC-12 SOFTBALL NOTES

• **ICYMI:** Two weeks ago 33rd year Arizona head coach Mike Candrea accomplished career win number 1,500. Carrera now has 37 wins in 38 games in 2017, and 1,505 career wins in 1,887 career games. Candrea is the fastest coach in NCAA history, in any sport, in any division, to reach 1,500 career wins. Candrea is 1,505-380-2 (.798), trailing only Michigan's Carol Hutchins 1,509-485-5 (.756), who spent time in Division II, in NCAA history.

• **PERFECT:** In the same weekend, Arizona's **Danielle O'Toole** threw her first career no-hitter, facing just two over the minimum in a seven-inning masterpiece with eight strikeouts and one walk on Friday night in the Wildcats' first victory over Oregon State. O'Toole's no-hitter was the 90th in Arizona history, and just the first seven-inning no-hitter since Taryne Mowatt no hit the Huskies in 2008. The no-hitter was Arizona's first non-mercy no-hitter against a top-10 team since Susie Parra threw an eight-inning no-hitter against No. 8 Cal in 1993. She earned both the NFCA and USA Softball National Player of the Week honors.

• **SENIOR CLASS:** Washington's **Ali Aguilar**, Utah's **Hannah Flippen**, and UCLA's **Delaney Spaulding** have been selected as candidates for the 2017 Senior CLASS Award in collegiate softball for their work both on and off the field. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists later in the season.

- She allowed no runs, either earned or unearned, and struck out 17 batters in 11.0 innings.
- She walked just three and allowed only four hits.
- Now has a team-best 0.86 ERA with 112 strikeouts and 16 walks in 81.2 innings this year.
- She owns a team-best 16-0 record.

### Freshman of the Week: Alyssa Palomino, Arizona

- 5 GP, 6 R, 2 HR, 5 RBI, .308 AVG
- Had four extra-base hits, including two homers, in five games on the week, helping Arizona go 5-0.
- The Wildcats now improve to a perfect 9-0 in Conference play with its third straight Conference sweep.
- Scored a run in every game and drove in five of her own.
- Led the team with a 1.000 slugging percentage for the week.
