### REGULAR-SEASON FINALE TO CROWN PAC-12 SOFTBALL CHAMPION

► The Pac-12 softball champion will be crowned in the last week of the regular season as three teams remain in contention for the title. The three ranked Pac-12 softball teams shifted in the top-10 of the USA Today/NFCA Coaches poll as No. 2 WASHINGTON (42-7, 17-4) hurdled No. 3 UCLA (45-3, 19-2) and ARIZONA (40-11, 17-4) holds at No. 6.

► UCLA, Arizona, and Washington enter the weekend with the potential to either win the Pac-12 title outright or share it with another team, depending on two highly-anticipated league matchups. No. 3 UCLA hosts No. 6 Arizona and No. 2 Washington welcomes Stanford for a three-game series and all six games are set for broadcast on Pac-12 Networks. ARIZONA STATE travels to Eugene to face OREGON in a three-game series, while OREGON STATE hosts UTAH to close out the 2019 regular-season campaign.

► UCLA controls its destiny atop the Conference standings with a 19-2 record and can win the title outright with two wins against the Wildcats. Arizona and Washington are two games back of UCLA and tied in second place with a 17-4 league mark. The Wildcats can win outright if they sweep UCLA, but is contingent on Washington losing at least one game. Washington could share a piece of the title depending on the series outcome.

► The 2019 Pac-12 Softball Players of the Year and All-Conference Teams, including All-Pac-12, All-Defensive and All-Freshman Teams, were announced today by the Conference office. UCLA's **Rachel Garcia** collects her second-straight Player of the Year honor and becomes the first player in Conference history to win both Player and Pitcher of the Year in the same season. Bruins teammate **Megan Faraimo** was tabbed Pac-12 Freshman of the Year, marking their third consecutive rookie honor. Washington's **Sis Bates** garnered Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year for the second consecutive year. Stanford head coach **Jessica Allister** was voted Pac-12 Coach of the Year after leading the Cardinal to eight Conference wins, which are more than the previous four years combined (7).

**UCLA VOTED FAVORITE IN SOFTBALL PRESEASON COACHES POLL**

**SAN FRANCISCO** - UCLA was voted first in the 2019 Pac-12 Softball Preseason Coaches Poll as announced by the Conference office today. The Bruins garnered 61 points and five first-place votes to sit atop the poll after advancing to the Women's College World Series Championship game last June. WASHINGTON, one of four league teams in the 2018 WCWS, was selected to finish second by a single point garnering 60 points and four first-place votes.

ARIZONA was picked third with 50 points, ARIZONA STATE was selected fourth with 43 points, followed by OREGON STATE and CALIFORNIA in a tie for fifth with 31 points apiece. UTAH tallied 19 points to rank seventh, STANFORD placed eighth with 17 points and OREGON rounded out the poll with 12 points.

Pac-12 teams occupy the top two spots in the ESPN.com/USA Softball preseason poll with No. 1 UCLA and No. 2 Washington. No. 6 Arizona makes the top-10 for its best preseason ranking since 2011 (No. 1) and is joined by No. 12 Arizona State while California, Oregon State and Oregon are receiving votes.

PAC-12 SOFTBALL NOTES

**RECAP:** UCLA pulled away in the league standings to gain a huge advantage after taking 2-of-3 games against Stanford (1-2, 7-4, 4-0) last week. The Bruins clinched their seventh Pac-12 series with outstanding pitching efforts from Pac-12 Freshman of the Year Megan Faraimo and sophomore Holly Azevedo in their three-hit shutout on Sunday. UCLA is on the brink of its 10th Conference Championship (1988-89, 1990-91, 1993, 1999, 2002, 2006, 2009) while its current Conference winning percentage (.905) would stand as the best record since the 1993 team went 25-1 in league play.

Second-ranked Washington drew closer in the Conference standings after sweeping then-No. 4 Arizona (2-1, 3-1, 7-4) on the road last week in a crucial league series. Senior Taran Alvelo threw 18 strikeouts (0.57 ERA) in 12.1 innings and collected her Conference-leading 22nd victory to earn Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week, Louisville Slugger/NFCA Pitcher of the Week and USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Week honors. Alvelo is two wins away from joining Danielle Lawrie and Jennifer Spediacci as the only Huskies ever to win 100 career games.

The Huskies earned their 17th Pac-12 win last weekend, tied for the most in a single season in head coach Heather Tarr's 15-year tenure (2010). Washington will try to pick up its seventh Pac-12 series win and sixth sweep of the year to reach 20 Conference wins for the second time in program history (1996, 23-4).

Stanford knocked off then-No. 2 UCLA, 2-1, in the series opener behind freshman Emily Schultz's two-run homer and a stellar pitching performance from senior Carolyn Lee, who allowed just one run on five hits. The victory marked its first win over a top-two ranked team since 2014 and now owns two wins over top-10 opponents this year after defeating then-No. 7 LSU on the road in non-conference play. The Cardinal has notched several historic wins this season, including its first Pac-12 series victory since 2013 and snapped a 19-game losing streak to Oregon that dates back to 2012.

ARIZONA STATE (30-18, 10-11) earned the series win against California (7-2, 3-8, 10-6) and has reached the 30-win threshold for the 24th consecutive season. UTAH won its series against Oregon (4-3, 9-4, 11-6) for the first time in program history. Oregon freshman Jasmine Sievers was the only Duck named to the All-Pac-12 First Team and also landed on the Pac-12 All-Freshman and All-Defensive Teams with a team-leading slugging percentage (.574), extra-base hits (19) and doubles (14).

**NATIONAL STAT LEADERS:**

The Pac-12 is home to some of the most powerful pitching talents in the country with three teams in the top-10 ERA led by UCLA (1.22) in second, Arizona (1.58) in fifth and Washington (1.60) in sixth. Equally as impressive, UCLA ranks third in the nation in batting average (.348), followed by Arizona in 11th (.329) and Arizona State in 17th (3.18).

League teams not only have the toughest pitchers in the country, but also have some of the best scoring offenses in the country, led by third-best Arizona State (7.48 runs per game), UCLA in fourth (7.25) and Arizona in ninth (6.90). Strikeout-to-walk ratio has been a highlight all season long, led by UCLA (5.82), Washington (5.37) and Arizona (4.29) ranking Nos. 2, 3, and 7 respectfully in the country. On base percentage has been exceptionally high this year with three teams in the top-15 including No. 6 UCLA (.423), No. 8 Arizona State (.419) and No. 13 Arizona (.410).

Arizona's lineup features two of the top home-run hitters in the country with Jessie Harper owning the second-most (23) and teammate Dejah Mulipola close behind in seventh (20). Harper also ranks seventh nationally in RBIs (61) and ninth in total bases (136) this season as the junior shortstop has been a key factor in the team's success. California's All-Pac-12 First Team selection Lindsay Rood is tied for the nation's most hits with 78. UCLA's Kelli Godin tops the Conference and 13th in the country in batting average (.441) followed by Arizona's Reyna Carranco in 18th (.433).

A Pac-12 Player of the Week, Pitcher of the Week and Freshman of the Week are selected throughout the regular season from nominations submitted by each school's media relations office.

» **AWARDS AND HONORS**

The Pac-12 names a 20-member All-Pac-12 team, a nine-player All-Defensive Team, a 14-player All-Freshman Team, a Player of the Year, Pitcher of the Year, Freshman of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, and Coach of the Year. The award winners are nominated and voted upon by the Pac-12 head coaches. The Pac-12 also recognizes a Batting Champion, which is awarded to the player with the highest batting average through the regular season. The honorees will be announced in a press release at the end of the regular season.

**SENIOR CLASS AWARD:** Washington pitcher **Taran Alvelo** has been named 1-of-10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award. Alvelo leads the Pac-12 in strikeouts (172) and victories (15) and ranks second in shutouts (5). Her 2.09 career ERA is the seventh-lowest in UW history while the American Ethnic Studies major is a three-time All-Pac-12 honoree and was a 2018 second team All-America selection.

**RETURNING ALL-AMERICANS:** Six NFCA D-I All-America team members are returning for the 2019 season, including the NFCA Player of the Year in UCLA pitcher **Rachel Garcia**. Four first-team selections headline Pac-12 rosters with Arizona's **Alyssa Palomino**, Washington's **Sis Bates**, and the UCLA duo of Garcia and **Aaliyah Jordan**. The Huskies lead all league teams with three total returning All-Americans including second-team member **Taran Alvelo** and third-team honoree **Gabbie Plain**.

**WATCH LISTS:** Twelve Pac-12 student-athletes appear on the USA Softball Top 50 Collegiate Player of the Year Watch List for the second most of any Conference (SEC-13). Arizona and Washington lead all institutions with four representatives each, while UCLA is tied for the second most (Florida, Oklahoma) with three players on the Watch List. Reigning Player of the Year, UCLA pitcher **Rachel Garcia**, highlights the list.

**3 GP, 4 hits, 1 2B, 4 RBIs, .400 AVG, .500 SLG**

- The freshman hitter drove in four runs to lead No. 3 Washington to a weekend sweep over No. 4 Arizona (2-1, 3-1, 7-4) and improve to 42-7 overall and 17-4 in Conference action heading into the regular-season finale.
- Had a crucial performance in Washington's pivotal series that kept its Pac-12 title hunt alive by accounting for a third of the Huskies' 12 runs against Arizona.
- On Sunday, hit a double in the first inning and later scored to give the Huskies a 1-0 lead before driving in two runs with a single into centerfield for a 3-1 victory.
- Capped Washington's comeback-win with a line drive to center for pair of RBIs in the fourth inning to complete the sweep on Sunday.

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Taran Alvelo, Sr., P, Washington (Carroll, Ohio)**

**3 GP, 3 wins, 12.1 IP, 18 K, 2 BB 0.57 ERA**

- Threw 18 strikeouts (0.57 ERA) and collected her Conference-leading 22nd win this year and is now undefeated in six consecutive appearances against the Wildcats.
- Stifled Arizona's top-10 nationally ranked scoring offense and batting average after allowing one run in 12.1 innings to clinch the Huskies' sixth-consecutive series win (2-1, 3-1, 7-4).
- The clutch reliever finished game one with her second save of the year after striking out the only batter she faced with three pitches in a narrow 2-1 victory.
- Notched her 12th double-digit strikeout game this season and second-straight start with at least 10 strikeouts to rank fourth nationally in strikeouts per seven innings (10.5).
- Broke her single-season career-high with 244 strikeouts, including 36 in her last 23.1 innings of work, for the eighth-most in the country.

## PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE YEAR

**Pac-12 Player of the Year & Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year – Rachel Garcia, Jr., P, UCLA (Palmdale, Calif.)**

Garcia earns back-to-back Pac-12 Player of the Year honors and was named the 2019 Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year while leading UCLA to a 45-3 overall record and 19-2 league mark heading into the final weekend of the regular season. Garcia is the first player in Conference history to win both Player and Pitcher of the Year in the same season. The Bruins topped the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll for five-straight weeks and have maintained a top-3 ranking throughout the year. Garcia received four Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week honors this season, including winning both Player and Pitcher of the Week on March 19 when she also collected Louisville Slugger/NFCA DI National Player of the Week honors. Garcia becomes the 16th all-time Bruin to receive the Pac-12 Player of the Year recognition. The Palmdale, Calif., native notched her third and fourth yearly awards after being selected Pac-12 Freshman of the Year in 2017 and Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year in 2018, and is a three-time All-Pac-12 First Team selection.

The reigning USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year has been selected as one of 26 finalists for the 2019 honor. Garcia has recorded either a win (20) or a save (2) in 22 of her 23 pitching appearances and has posted nine double-digit strikeout games, including a season-high of 15. While starting 47 games, she has reached base in 24 of her last 25 games, owns the sixth-best batting average on the team (.348), has hit eight home runs with 40 RBIs. Garcia is majoring in history and leads the Conference in ERA (0.71), strikeout-to-walk ratio (7.92) and hits allowed per seven innings (3.78) which also rank second, fifth and ninth, respectively, in the country. Her impressive list of credentials also touts a 2019 Honda Sport Award and NFCA and ESPNW National Player of the Year awards from last season.

**Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year – Sis Bates, Jr., INF, Washington (Ceres, Calif.)**

Bates is tabbed the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year for the second-straight season after leading current No. 2 nationally ranked Washington to a 42-7 overall mark and 17-4 Conference record entering the regular-season finale. Bates is a three-time All-Pac-12 honoree along with being selected to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team in 2017 and earns UW's fourth all-time defensive nod. The junior owns the fewest errors of any middle infielder in the Pac-12 and the highest career fielding percentage of any shortstop in Washington history (.980). Bates is the only player in the Pac-12 with at least 30 putouts and 30 assists accompanied by fewer than four errors as she has committed one error in 41 league games over the last two years. The social science major has started all 49 games and leads all league players with a .485 batting average during Conference action. Bates is also the Huskies' leader offensively, registering a .395 overall batting average to go along with 50 runs scored, 90 assists, and 62 hits. Her 203 career hits are the second-most of any active Pac-12 player, behind only California's Lindsay Rood (251 hits), and she became the sixth Husky in program history with 200+ hits in their first three seasons. The returning NFCA All-American First Team member has been selected as a finalist for the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year award.

**Pac-12 Freshman of the Year - Megan Faraimo, Fr., P, UCLA (Vista, Calif.)**

Faraimo has collected 15 victories this season, the sixth-most in the Conference, to become the third-straight Bruin to win Pac-12 Freshman of the Year (Rachel Garcia, 2017; Aaliyah Jordan, 2018) and the eighth all-time. The freshman has guided UCLA to a league-leading 19-2 record and the brink of its 10th all-time Conference title with only one three-game series remaining. Faraimo boasts the second-best ERA in the Conference (1.31), which ranks 17th nationally and fifth among freshman. The 2019 Schutt Sports/NFCA Freshman of the Year top-25 candidate became the first Bruin to throw two no-hitters in the same season since 2015 including the first UCLA freshman to accomplish the feat since 2005. Faraimo is a member of the All-Conference First Team and All-Freshman Team after collecting five Pac-12 Freshman of the Week honors this year.

**Pac-12 Coach of the Year – Jessica Allister, Stanford**

In her second season at the helm, Allister has guided Stanford to a 32-15 overall record for the program's most wins in a season since 2013 (39-21) and to an 8-10 Pac-12 mark. The Cardinal enters the last weekend of the regular season in fourth place in the league standings after being picked to finish eighth in the Pac-12 Coaches Preseason Poll. The Cardinal opened Pac-12 play with a 7-2 record for its best start since the 2005 team started 8-2 and went on to claim a share of the Conference title. Stanford has surpassed its overall (24) and Pac-12 (3) win totals from 2018 while its eight Conference wins are more than the previous four years combined (7). Allister also led Stanford to a 12-game win streak, the program's longest since the 2014 season opened 13-0. Allister was a four-year starting catcher on The Farm and made NCAA Women's College World Series appearances in 2001 and 2004. A Second Team All-American in 2004 and three-time All-Conference selection, Allister holds the Stanford record for career games (266).
