"I was surprised about my time in the 100. I felt like I got out good and I was controlling my speed.

"Myxxg Last year I wanked waited for the very, very last jump to win the long jump. Today I said I wanted to put a good one out there on the first jump and from there I could adk adjust. I don't really practice the long jump much."
