LATIN BERRY, 1990 PAC-10 LONG JUMP CHAMPION, UNIVERSITY OF OREGON

"(How does this compare to your other titles?) "This one meant more than any other. It's been a real frustrating season. It's been tough on me in terms of focusing. Going 26 today was like setting a P.R. We got first-place points, which was nice. Coach Dellinger told me that getting this many titles in a career is pretty rare. It really makes up for the rest of the season."

(Will you go tomorrow, even with heal injury?) "I'll sacrifice for the team. It will hurt, but I don't think I can injure it any worse. It shouldn't bother me for the NCAA's. If it means team points, I'll go."

(On technique) "Coach told me I was going up too high. He said to jump out more."

(What about getting ready for the NCAA meet?) "The other guys don't have to play football. I leave for mini-camp this week. I just have to come back after that and do my best to get ready for NCAA's."

"I didn't think the NCAA mark would come today. I'm going to go home and enjoy this and then suck it up and get ready for tomorrow."

QUOTES FROM PAULA BERRY (OREGON) - WOMEN'S JAVELIN THROW WINNER (178-1)

It (winning) feels great. I'm real happy right now. Not so much with qualifying for the NCAA's, but for throwing a PR. I hadn't PR'ed since high school, when I threw 174-11 (1987), and my collegiate best was 171-9 as a freshman in 1988, so it feels great.

I got my mark on my first throw in the finals. I felt good with it, and was having a good day. I was confident. It was getting to the point where I had to start throwing farther, and today I just said, "it's time."

(ON ADVANCING TO THE NCAA's) I'm just happy to get there. It's always everyone's dream to win an NCAA title, but I just want to get a PR. Then we'll see what happens.

NOTES ON BERRY: A 5-9, 160 lb. junior from Dayville, OR... Previous PR and collegiate bests are listed above . . . Season best was 168-4, set at the Oregon Preview back on March 17 (2nd meet of the season) . . . Sixth in Pac-10 javelin as a frosh and soph . . . NCAA qualifier as a frosh in '88 . . . Today's throw is sixth-best in Duck history.

SHANE COLLINS, 1990 PAC-10 SHOT PUT CHAMPION, ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY

"I thought I'd hit a big one today. I felt that I had a 66 or 67 foot toss in me today.

"I was inconsistent and sloppy all week with my spin, and everything in my throw was off. I got nothing behind the ball all day today.

"Maybe I was trying too hard to break out a big throw, but this was a learning experience for me, and I will be back for the NCAAs ready to go. I have to become more patient when I am not throwing well.

Collins becomes ASU's first Pac-10 shot put champ. He finished second in 1988 and redshirted last season.

Brian Cullen - Winner of the Pole Vault  
University of Oregon

"I really expected 17-4 to win the meet. This erases memories from last year (no heightened in last year's meet at Stanford). I really put a lot of pressure on myself by watching other people in the competition. Today I just told myself to relax, and play mind games with myself. I felt very comfortable within myself. We felt a lot of pressure. You could sense it from the coaches. It was really great to make 17-0 1/4 on my first attempt."

BILL DELLINGER, HEAD COACH, UNIVERSITY OF OREGON

"We know we have to score our points on the first day. The sprint schools have their day on the second day and whack away at our lead pretty good on the second day. There will be a lot of points scored tomorrow in the sprints and we won't be getting many of them.

"I felt if we scored 75 points today, we had a chance to win the meet. With 89, we have a better chance, but we haven't won it yet. Getting 18 points in the pole vault, was a real bonus. We've been favored in the pole vault in the past and felt good about those points and then didn't get any. If we were lucky, we felt we could get 10 points in the vault. We were picking up points all along our form chart today.

"There's nothing wrong (weather) with this day. It may not be that way tomorrow. It was a good day for (distance) running.

"Latin Berry may have been third or fourth on the marks list, but knowing Latin Berry, he's a guy you want on your team when the chips are down. Two things about his jump today: He not only scored points for the team, but he also qualified for the NCAA meet, where I think he can score as well."

GEA JOHNSON, 1990 PAC-10 LONG JUMP CHAMPION, ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY

"I did not know that I had won until I went to the high jump competition. I figured that someone jumped 20-10 and I had to worry about the high jump and the hurdles.

"My first two jumps were my best, but I was just over the board, so I knew that I had a good jump in me.

"I never thought that I would win a Pac-10 championship this year, since I did not compete in the heptathlon.

"I think the fact that I won the long jump helped me with my performance in the hurdles. My confidence rose a great deal of the win. (Johnson posted the fastest qualifying time in the prelims of the 100 hurdles -- 13.35, a personal best).

DANNY LOPEZ, 1990 PAC-10 3000M STEEPLECHASE CHAMPION, UNIVERSITY OF OREGON

"I was hoping that someone would take it out, but the pace was slow during the first two laps. I thought I could pick up the pace, so I pulled out in front.

(On late rush from WSU's Marty Stroschein): "I sensed him right after the final water jump. I saw him studder-step just before the last barrier and I knew that I would win the race. He has a good kick, and the problem he had before the barrier really helped out.

"It was nice to run against Marty, because he did not run in the two meets that they ran in Eugene.

"No matter their times, I do not take anybody lightly."

Lopez will also run in the 800 meters, and could also see action in the 5,000.

SCOTT MCGEE, 1990 PAC-10 HAMMER CHAMPION, UNIVERSITY OF OREGON

"Things went well for me today. I had hoped to get off to a better start. I had to work for it today.

"Today is the day that we (Oregon) need to score the points.

"I did not feel any added pressure because of that, but I did feel some pressure in that everyone expected me to win.

"In a meet like this, you try to get off to a good start and let things go from there. If you worry about your technique now, you're in trouble.

"Now I will work on fine tuning everything in getting ready for the NCAAs."

McGee finished fourth at last year's Pac-10 Championship and his throw of 225-4 is a personal best and he remains third on Oregon's best marks list.

TRACIE MILLETT, 1990 Pac-10 Shot Put Champ, UCLA

"I felt solid in the warmups: The shot was going out further than I've ever thrown it. That got me really excited for the competition."

"When Reed got a big throw in her flight, I knew for sure that I would have to p.r. to win the event. It probably would have been better to have been in the same flight(as Reed) so that we could slug it out head to head, but it worked out for me anyway."

(Reed is from WSU)

Millett's mark was a personal best and a UCLA school record. It was the fourth best throw in the Pac-10. Her previous outdoor best was 51-9 3/4 at the Texas Relays earlier this season (4/6/90). This was Millett's first ever Pac-10 title.

STEPHANIE WESSELL, 1990 PAC-10 WOMEN'S 10,000 Meter CHAMPION, UNIVERSITY OF OREGON

"I've never run this race before. I ran a very conservative race. Having never competed in this race before, I wanted to take it very easy in the beginning, get through halfway (5,000 meters) and just go from there."

"I never felt any pressure. It was a very even pace, so there were no fast moves. I was pretty relaxed; it was pretty easy. On a scale of 1-10 concerning the challenge, mentally it was a 10+, physically it was a 6. I treated like a fast tempo training run. Looking at it that way made it very easy."

"It was a mutual agreement (deciding to run the 10,000 meters) between the coach and I. I brought up the possibility to him and I think it surprised him. I came into it an ardent 1500, 3000 meter runner and I really didn't think I'd ever move up to the longer distances."

It's so much easier than the 1500 meter race, where you're just hammering the entire way . It felt very good, very comfortable."



LIZ WILSON, 1990 PAC-10 WOMEN'S 3000 Meters Champion, University of Oregon

"I knew it ( the race) wasn't going to go very fast because we always run tactical; we just kind of messed around. It's more or less that I ran smart. It feels good to be able to say that,because all the other races I've run, I've come in second place, or gotten beat in the last few laps. This time with three laps to go, I started thinking 'these laps are mine.'"

"I ran smart and felt really tough at the end. I did what I really wanted to. I just kept thinking that if I was going to do it, I had to do it now and push it to the end. It was hard, but I felt really relaxed, except near the end. "

"We had four laps to go and nobody would take it. The girl from Arizona and the girl from Washington and Jennifer (Robertson, WSU) and I were behind these two and were thinking we'll just get these two to do it (push out in front). You could tell what we were all thinking, they'll just fo the work and we'll leave them. I knew Jennifer's got a good kick, she's a tough competitor - fast - with a lap or two to go and I realized that the entire time. There just was too many people in there, and I felt like saying 'get off' as we were just pushing everyone around."

"Behind the Arizona and Washington girls, I felt like I wasn't running my own stride. So I figured I was going to run in the second or third lane, or I was going to go up in front."

STEFAN WIKSTROM, 1990 PAC-10 JAVELIN CHAMPION, WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY

"I didn't feel too good today; I don't think anybody felt good. But I feel very happy to win. I didn't feel up to throwing today. Everyone had a bad day, especially Skipper and Robeson."

"(When did the winning throw come) In the second round, then I kept on passing until it was over. (What do you attribute your improvement to) Being healthy. I've been injured for five years, so this is very important."

(Are they going to perform surgery on your shoulder) "I'm not going to let them do it because after they cut on it (shoulder), I won't be able to throw anymore. It's the right shoulder, and I feel it every time I throw. It's worse in the warm-ups. If I really get going, it doesn't hurt as much."

"I never throw in practice. I just lift, do sprints and do runway workouts. I don't think that's a factor - you don't have to throw in practice. I think I've proved that."

"I have the Swedish championships in August and the European championships in late August.. .then I'll talk to my doctor to see if I should continue to compete. If it's dangerous to my health I'll quit. I'm pushing myself right now."

"Right now I want to prove everyone wrong that didn't believe me before...last year and the year before. (Coach) Chaplin believed in me and I think I owe it to him to continue to compete and I'm glad I won this for him."

BILL DELLINGER, HEAD COACH, UNIVERSITY OF OREGON

May 20, 1990

1990 PACIFIC-10 CONFERENCE TRACK & FIELD CHAMPIONS--MEN

"We came into the meet with no clear-cut favorite, then we scored 89 yesterday. We figured we needed to score 40 points today, and we scored 50. The 1600m relay showed how our guys competed the whole meet. We scored the points we had to get, and then a couple extra. Our distance runners really performed well in this meet. Our two guys in the horizontal events also qualified for the NCAA meet, and I think that's going to help us. We now have 10 automatic qualifiers. Four or five guys can win the NCAA. I'd rather go into it after winning the Pac-10 and having a full team."

MICHAEL BATES, 1990 PAC-10 100 METER CHAMPION, UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA

"The race was tough and there was wind, but I can't use the wind as an excuse. I was ready mentally for both the 100m and 200m. I just thought nothing was going to stop me."

"I felt good after running a strong relay leg. I felt good both mentally and physically. The wind was strong in the 100m and I was not sure what effect it would have."

"It was great to win the 100m. We (Arizona sprinters) had a good day."

MICHAEL BATES, 1990 PAC-10 CHAMPION, 200 METERS, UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA

"It was almost like practice out there (having four Arizona sprinters in 200m). That made me much more relaxed. I think it really helped me."

"I felt the same way about the 200m as I did about the 100m. I was ready mentally and physically."

"It was hard to tell if I had caught Mahorn. I caught even with him and I thought he dove a little early and then I beat him at the end."

MELANIE BLOCH, 1990 PAC-10 1,500 METER CHAMPION, STANFORD UNIVERSITY

"My goal was to win the race and I did. I would obviously have liked to be faster, but I'm pleased to win.

"It's hard to plan before the race because so many things can happen to alter your expectations. The early pace was right on for me. It was very windy, and that had an effect.

"When I moved out in the second lap, the pace was slow and I wanted to pick it up.

"I knew Bridget Smyth (Arizona) wasn't going to hand the race to me. She's very competitive by nature and I knew she would come back at me. Fortunately, I was able to hold her off.

"The facilities are super. They can't get any better than the combination of the indoor track and outdoor stadium. It's great to be able to run indoors before the race.

NOTE:

Stanford competitors swept the conference 1,500-meter titles. William Crowley won the men's 1,500 event (3:47.79) and Melanie Bloch won the women's 1,500 (4:24.2)

## MEN'S DISCUS

Winner, Brian Blutreich, UCLA, with a throw of 188-10, winning on his last throw. Blutreich also won the title last year.

"The wind was terrible. I waited a couple of minutes on my last throw for the wind to die down and it did. I'm glad I had the experience to wait because it worked. My coach isn't here\* but I know he'll be thrilled to death with this.

There was a contingent of UCLA fans there but after the throw they didn't yell so I didn't know how good my last throw was. But then the official yelled my mark and I was flabbergasted. I could not believe it. I've been criticized in the past for not having a good throw on my final effort. But today I proved that wrong.

WILLIAM CROWLEY, 1990 PAC-10 1,500 METER CHAMPION, STANFORD UNIVERSITY

"I was going to go at 500 (meters) so it wouldn't come down to a sit and kick. I feel confident with my kick, but you never know what's going to happen. I felt that if I die, I die, but I was going to give it all I had.

"The person that made it all happen was Mark Mastalir (Stanford). He went and cleared the pack out. We were in lanes one and two and we had to get out of traffic. Both of us went out and he took the lead to clear out of traffic.

"At the end, I couldn't really tell how far ahead I was. I just went hard to the finish line.

"The race pretty much went as I hoped. It was at 300 (meters) that I wanted to make my move and I ended up changing gears about 500.

"The facility here is gorgeous. The track is fantastic; it gives you back everything you put into it when you're running."

E.J. GUO, 1990 PAC-10 5,000 METERS CHAMPION, WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY

"After yesterday's 10,000 meter race, my stomach was bothering me. So today's slower pace in the beginning of this race was good for me. I was very lucky; my stomach didn't hurt me today."

"The slow start was good for me, it's better for me as a runner to start slow and then kick in. The wind didn't bother me because I usually follow the guy in front at the beginning."

"I didn't know how close Lopez (Oregon) was to me. I just ran and didn't pay any attention. I caught the leader around the last turn behind the scoreboard."

Mike Harris - Winner of the triple jumper from Cal

"It is always a good competition with Spencer (Williams of Oregon). We'll have to wait and see for Nationals. This year at Nationals, I will not high jump like I did last year and I think it will help. I went to NCAA's Indoors this year, felt good and got fifth."



## MEN'S 400m

Winner, Steve Lewis, UCLA, with a time of 46.10. Lewis also won this event last year and finished second (to teammate Danny Everett) as as freshman in 1988.

"The wind off the track was really blowing. That's why I wanted to try and put together the first part of my race because with the wind blowing like it was for the last part, all you could do was just take it home.

My hamstring felt OK. Now I've just got to get some races in.

The challenge was the wind. Travis Hannah (from USC) had a good race, too.

I at least wanted to win. I wanted to see how I felt, how my body felt and it all worked out.

It's been discouraging (the last year with the right hamstring injury).

I had to go back to basics and go from there.

The nationals are the next level. Hopefully I'll run well there and be injury free."

Lewis won two golds medals at the 1988 Summer Olympics, in the 400m and on U.S. 1600m relay that also tied the world record.

Tony Liu - Winner of the 110 meter hurdles

"I thought I won the race, but I wasn't sure. I felt like I hit a lot of hurdles, but I was able to stay under control. This was the first time this year that I have run against him (Mark Crear of USC). He is a good hurdler. I was watching him warm up and noticed that he had good technique. My strategy is to stay cool, don't get nervous.. After the fifth hurdle, I think I caught him."

MAICEL MALONE, 200, 400 and 4x400 METER RELAY PAC-10 CHAMPION, ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY

"Because it was so cold and windy, I feel worse after this meet than after the 1988 Pac-10 Championship. I have enjoyed a great season so far, and coach Jones, my teammates and the Lord have been the reason.

"I have been healthy all season, and things have been going well. We have a good chemistry with the relay, and I think we have a chance to win the NCAAAs.

"I felt more pressure this year than in 1988, because of the way I've been running all season. With the interviews and all the added attention I've received this season, I know I have to run my best or I will be disappointed."

"I am excited about my chances at the NCAAAs this year, but coach Jones and I have to figure on what I will run at the NCAAAs. I am not sure if I'll run both the 200 and 400, in addition to the relays.

MALONE CAPTURED THE 200, 400, 4x100 and 4x400 METER RELAYS DURING HER FRESHMAN SEASON IN 1988 at the PAC-10 CHAMPIONSHIP. SHE LATER WENT ON TO FINISH SECOND IN THE 400 and RUN ON THE WINNING 4X100 RELAY AND FINISHED THIRD IN THE 4X400.

"This is a tremendous honor for me to win the athlete of the meet award, but we still have a lot of work to do until the NCAAAs and hopefully a busy summer of running.

TINA N'DRIN, 1990 PAC-10 WOMEN'S 800 METERS CHAMPION, WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY

"Well, I noted there was lot of wind at the finish line, especially from the 100 meter mark to the finish. I was really concerned about that before my race, and imagined myself running in this wind. But finally when I got into the race I did not think about the wind. I just ran."

"Most of the time I don't really think about how the girls behind me are going to run - fast or not - I just thnk about my own time. So that's what I did. I know the girl behind me had a best time of 2:07 or 2:08, so I needed to run against myself to beat that time." But I did not really care about leading or anything."

(About coming back for Goodwill Games for Native country of Ivory Coast) "Well, iunfortunately not. I haven't heard from my country, telling me to get ready for the Goodwill Games. So I guess maybe not."

About Summer plans) "I plan on taking some classes and am concerned about my school work. I will also keep in shape, in case they call me up to come over here (for Goodwill Games)."

## MEN'S HIGH JUMP

Winner, Rick Noji, from Washington with a winning leap of 7-2½. Noji was second at the Pac-10 in 1987 and '88.

"I was mentally prepared to jump in the rain, but it was probably better to jump in the wind than the rain, because it would have been slippery. At my attempts at 7-4½, the bar was always moving (because of the wind).

If the conditions would have been better, I think I could have jumped higher.

It seemed the higher I tried to go the wind would start to pick up more.

I wanted to win today very badly. I put the past years behind me.

GEORGE PORTER, 1990 PAC-10 CHAMPION 400M HURDLES, USC

"My coaches Don Quarrie and Jim Bush told me to get the lead early and hold on. Some of our other people who had run previous races said the head wind was strong down the straightaway. So we figured that if I got the lead it would be difficult for someone to make up ground late in the race. 7

"The last 110 meters was tough because of the wind. I was hoping to run in the mid 49s. I think I'm in the shape to run that kind of the race and coming in the conditions here were good. But it was just too windy.

(on a planter's wart surgically removed off his right foot on March 21)  
"It's basically healed but it's a tad bit sensative. The only thing that hurts me now is that I haven't been running. Last week was the first time I practiced the hurdles this season. I stayed in shape by working out in water and swimming."

QUOTES FROM DAVE STRANG - WINNER OF THE 800 METERS  
STANFORD UNIVERSITY

" I hate the wind. The strong wind didn't help coming down the backstretch. However, I'm happy. I knew I had to kick out at the end, nobody else in the field was going to do it. I pushed hard at the 300 meter mark, and got away.
