## PAC-12 VOLLEYBALL WRAPS UP REGULAR SEASON WITH RIVALRY MATCHES

Pac-12 volleyball teams head into the final week of the regular season with historic performances and sights set on the NCAA Tournament. The season finales are highlighted by a slate of six rivalry matches on Friday, five of which will be televised on Pac-12 Networks with the contest between USC and UCLA to be broadcast on ESPNU ... Also coming up this week is one of the most anticipated matches of the year as No. 5 WASHINGTON hosts top-ranked STANFORD. The top-two teams in the league face off Wednesday on the Pac-12 Networks. The Cardinal can clinch the Pac-12 title with a victory while the Huskies could get a share of the crown if they get a win ... Stanford won its 28th-straight match to set a program record for wins to start a season, and OREGON STATE enters the final week with the most wins by an OSU team since 1996. OREGON reached the 20-win mark for the fourth-straight season, and ARIZONA has back-to-back 20-win seasons for the first time since 2001 and 2002 ... Eight Pac-12 volleyball teams are ranked in this week's AVCA Coaches poll, with 10 of the 12 league teams receiving votes for the third-straight week. Stanford has anchored the top spot in the polling for 11-straight weeks, while Washington has received a top-five ranking every week this season. Last week saw nine Pac-12 teams ranked, a league record ... Weekly honors went to UCLA's Karsta Lowe for Offensive Player of the Week, UW's Cassie Strickland for Defensive Player of the Week, and OSU's Mary-Kate Marshall for Freshman of the Week ... A Pac-12 volleyball player leads the nation in five different statistical categories, and four Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top 16 in national hitting percentage ... The NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Selection Announcement will take place this Sunday, Nov. 30 at 8:30 p.m. ET and will be televised live on ESPNU. Last year, the Pac-12 had a league-record nine teams in the NCAA Tournament.

## PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

**OFFENSIVE: Karsta Lowe, UCLA**

**DEFENSIVE: Cassie Strickland, Washington**

**FRESHMAN: Mary-Kate Marshall, Oregon State**

**SAN FRANCISCO** - The Pac-12 Conference office announced today the Pac-12 Volleyball Players of the Week for the week of Nov. 17-23. UCLA's **Karsta Lowe** was voted the Conference's Offensive Player of the Week for the fifth time this season, while WASHINGTON's **Cassie Strickland** was named the Defensive Player of the Week and OREGON STATE's **Mary-Kate Marshall** was tabbed the Freshman of the Week.

**Karsta Lowe** (Rancho Santa Fe, Calif.) recorded a pair of 20-plus-kills matches, averaging 6.00 kills and 7.07 points per set on a .260 hitting percentage as the Bruins improved to 19-10 and 10-8 in Pac-12 play. The senior opened the week with 22 kills, eight digs, two aces and two blocks in a 3-0 loss at No. 14 OREGON on Friday. On Saturday at Oregon State, Lowe posted her sixth double-double of the year on 20 kills and 10 digs, adding three aces and three blocks as the Bruins beat the Beavers, 3-1. The outside hitter continues to lead the nation with 5.96 kills per set and 6.60 points per set, adding a team-best 29 aces.

**Cassie Strickland** (Huntington Beach, Calif.) helped the Huskies hold No. 13 ARIZONA and No. 22 ARIZONA STATE to a combined .134 attack percentage in a pair of 3-0 wins this weekend. The junior libero averaged 5.00 digs per set and anchored a Husky passing game that helped UW hit a .362 clip, with zero reception errors in her 32 attempts. Strickland had 14 digs in the win over Arizona, and added 16 more in the sweep of Arizona State on Sunday. The Huskies improved to 27-2 with the two wins and 16-2 in Pac-12 play.

**Mary-Kate Marshall** (Portland, Ore.) posted two double-doubles, averaging 3.88 kills and 3.00 digs per game as the Beavers upset No. 25 USC, 3-1, and dropped a four-set match to No. 17 UCLA. The outside hitter opened the weekend with 12 kills and 11 digs against the Trojans, adding a block and a service ace. Marshall then recorded 19 kills and 13 digs against the Bruins for her 13th double-double on the season. She already holds the record for kills by a freshman at Oregon State, and she now has the eighth-most digs from a freshman in OSU history.

Lowe's weekly honor is the seventh of her career, which is tied for third-most by a single player, and UCLA's 75th all-time. Her five honors this year are the most since Stanford's Logan Tom earned the honor five times in 2001. Strickland takes home her second-career weekly accolade and the 49th for the Huskies overall. Marshall picks up her fourth freshman of the week honor this season and the sixth freshman of the week honor for the Beavers all-time.

## PAC-12 NOTES

### AROUND THE LEAGUE

• With eight teams ranked in this week's AVCA Coaches poll, the Pac-12 has had at least seven teams ranked for 11-consecutive weeks. An astonishing 10 of the 12 league teams are receiving votes for the third-straight week. The Pac-12 made history last week with nine teams ranked in the top 25 of the AVCA Coaches poll, the best mark in league history.

STANFORD leads the way at No. 1 for the 11th-straight week, while WASHINGTON weighed in at fifth. ARIZONA and OREGON swapped spots, with UO at No. 13 while UA is No. 14. UCLA remained at No. 17, while COLORADO jumped to No. 18 and ARIZONA STATE stayed at No. 22. UTAH rounded out the league teams in the poll at No. 23, while USC and OREGON STATE are receiving votes. OSU has received votes for five-straight weeks.

An impressive 75 percent of Pac-12 teams were represented in the Preseason AVCA Coaches Poll, with four teams starting the season ranked in the top 25 and an additional five more receiving votes.

• **Records Watch ...** USC's **Samantha Bricio** of USC etched her name in the Pac-12 record books, earning her 200th-career service ace in Friday's match against California, besting the Pac-12 record of 198, previously set by UCLA's Daiva Tomkus.

UCLA's **Claire Felix** tied a Pac-12 single-match record on Sunday as she hit 12-for-12 for a 1.000 attack percentage, a school record. The mark has only been reached by two other players and is the first such instance since 1990. Records account for a minimum of 10 attempts.

Note: Pac-12 records date back to 1986, the first year the Conference sponsored the spot.

• **Seeing Double ...** Fifteen players from Pac-12 teams have 10 or more double-double matches this season with two weeks remaining in the regular season. Arizona's Penina Snuka has cracked the 20-match mark with 22 double-doubles, three more than she finished with last season. Last year, 18 players finished with 10 or more double-doubles, while 12 reached double-digits in 2012 and 11 in 2011 and 2010. 2011 was the last year a player had 20 or more double-doubles (20, Stanford's Rachel Williams & Karissa Cook).

### UPSET CITY

*Pac-12 teams have pulled off impressive victories this season, including several upsets. Three of those upsets came at the expense of perennial powerhouse Hawai'i on the road, arguably the toughest place to play in NCAA Division I volleyball.*

• **Join the Club ...** Three players have joined the 1,000-career dig club this month as Stanford's Jordan Burgess, Arizona's Ronni Lewis and Oregon's Liz Brenner passed the 1K mark the week of Nov. 3-9. With the achievement, Brenner became one of five active players to have 1,000 digs and 1,000 kills, joining Arizona's Madi Kingdon, UW's Krista Vansant, Washington State's Jaicee Harris and Utah's Chelsey Schofield.

• **Senior CLASS Award ...** Oregon's Liz Brenner and Arizona's Madi Kingdon, both outside hitters, were named as two of 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the honor focuses on the total student-athlete and encourage students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities.

• As evidenced by the early preseason record, teams have won 27 regular-season tournaments, Stanford's Pac-12/Big Ten Challenge win, Washington's win at the Pac-12/Big Ten Showcase, Arizona State claiming the Hawai'i Tournament, Oregon winning the Wahine Volleyball Classic, USC winning at the Commonwealth Classic, Washington winning the BYU Invitational and UCLA capturing the Outriggers Volleyball Challenge hosted in Honolulu.

• **No. 1 vs. No. 2 ...** Pac-12 teams have been involved in 1-vs.-2 matches 12 times since 1982, the first year the NCAA starting sponsoring women's sports. Pac-12 teams are 4-2 in matches where it involved a non-conference foe, including STANFORD's (No. 2) win over Penn State (No. 1).

• **Pac-12 coach gets milestone victory ...** ARIZONA STATE's Jason Watson and OREGON's Jim Moore are the latest Pac-12 head coaches to claim milestone wins, with Watson recording his 100th win at ASU on Oct. 10. Moore won his 200th match with the Ducks on the same evening.

UCLA head coach Mike Sealy picked up his 100th-career victory in an upset of USC on Sept. 23. Sealy's head coaching career has spanned five seasons, all at UCLA, and includes a NCAA title in 2011. OREGON STATE's Taras Liskevych won his 100th match in Corvallis on Aug. 30 against Idaho State. In his 10th year with the Beavers, he is the program's winningest coach.

• **Pac-12 coaches reach milestones ...** Pac-12 volleyball coaches are amongst the most respected in the country, with the group having combined to win over 5,000 matches heading into the season, won six NCAA titles and reached the NCAA semifinals 21 times. Their successful careers within the Pac-12 and outside the Conference has led the following to celebrate milestone seasons:

Jason Watson, ARIZONA STATE is celebrating 10 years as a Division I head coach.

Rich Feller, CALIFORNIA is celebrating 30 years as a Division I head coach.

Liz Kritza, COLORADO is celebrating 10 years as a Division I head coach.

Jim Moore, OREGON is celebrating 10 years as head coach in Eugene.

Taras Liskevich, OREGON STATE is celebrating 10 years as head coach in Corvallis.

John Dunning, STANFORD is celebrating 30 years as a Division I head coach.

Mike Sealy, UCLA is celebrating five years as a Division I head coach and as head coach of the Bruins.

Beth Launiere, UTAH is celebrating 25 years as a Division I head coach and as head coach of the Utes.

Jim McLaughlin, WASHINGTON is celebrating 20 years as a Division I head coach.

• **Pac-12 teams work fast...** With the non-conference season wrapped up, the Pac-12 has gotten off to a strong start to the 2014 campaign posting a 113-19 (.856) record heading into league play. Pac-12 teams have traditionally gotten off to a fast start to start the season, starting the 2014 season with a 32-3 (.914) in the opening weekend, including three-set sweeps in 20 of those matches. Two of those wins also came against home teams ranked in the AVCA Preseason Top 25, including a 3-0 upset of then-No. 17 Hawai'i at the hands of then-No. 25 ARIZONA STATE in Honolulu. Then-No. 3 STANFORD easily handled then-No. 7 Nebraska in straight sets.

Last season, Pac-12 teams were 110-22 (.833) against non-conference opponents. Of those 132 matches, 79 lasted just three sets where the Pac-12 posted an impressive 73-6 record (.924).

- **Bring it on...** In order to prepare for the rigors of the Pac-12, league teams scheduled tough non-conference matches. Of the 134 non-conference tilts on the 2014 docket, 40 were against teams that competed in last year's NCAA Tournament.

- Eight Pac-12 players have been named AVCA National Player of the Year since 2001, including the last four-straight years. In all, a league player has earned the national honor 13 times. Washington's Krista Vansant was the most recent honoree, leading the Huskies to their first NCAA semifinal appearance in 2005. She became the first junior to earn the honor since former Stanford standout Foluke Akinradewo in 2007.

- **All-Tournament honors ...** With the Conference getting off to a hot start in 2014, going 63-5 (.926) in the first two weeks of play, several Pac-12 players have earned honors at various preseason tournaments. That's a total of 11 FAB 50 recruits (including one sand), second-most among all conferences, which breaks down to 22 percent of the list. Here's the list by conference: Big Ten (22); **PAC-12 (11)**; SEC (9); Big 12 (3); ACC/Big East/Big West/Mountain West/Sun Belt (1).

- **Fear the Underclassmen...** The underclassmen in the Pac-12 are the majority again this year, outnumbering the upperclassmen, 110-83, accounting for nearly 57 percent of combined Pac-12 rosters. The freshman class is the biggest in the Conference with 57 rostered players with no collegiate experience, edging out the sophomore class by four. The junior class is the smallest with just 39 players with two years of playing experience remaining. CALIFORNIA has the most freshmen with eight, followed by UTAH and WASHINGTON who both have seven each. The Golden Bears have the most underclassmen with 13 combined freshmen and sophomores. Cal, STANFORD and the Huskies each have a mere two seniors on this year's roster for the smallest senior classes in the league. Class designations are based on playing eligibility.

### HISTORICALLY SPEAKING...

- The Pac-12 has captured six of the last 13 NCAA crowns (2011 - UCLA, 2005 - Washington, 2004 - Stanford, 2003 - USC, 2002 - USC, 2001 - Stanford) and 14 NCAA titles overall.

- The Pac-12 has had 10 or more All-Americans selections in seven of the last nine years. Last year, 11 were named to the AVCA All-America squad, the most since 13 were selected in 2009. First team selections in 2013 were Inky Ajanaku (STAN), Natalie Hagglund (USC), Ebony Nwanebu (USC), Krista Vansant (WASH) and Carly Wopat (STAN). It marked the fourth-straight year at least four players were named to the first team. Second team selections were Liz Brenner (ORE), Samantha Bricio (USC), Madi Bugg (STAN) and Christina Higgins (CAL), while Kaleigh Nelson (WASH) and Alexis Olgard (USC) were named to the third team. Ten former Pac-12 players have earned All-America honors four times, while another 17 players in all have earned All-American honors three times. Since 1990, Pac-12 players garnered AVCA Player of the Year honors 13 times, including the last four years - CAL's Carli Lloyd (2010), USC's Alex Jupiter (2011), ORE's Alaina Bergsma (2012) and WASH's Krista Vansant (2013). The NCAA Honda Sports Award honor has been bestowed upon a Pac-12 volleyball player 13 times, including Vansant in 2013.

- The current group of Pac-12 volleyball coaches enters the 2014 season with over 5,000 Division I victories to its credit, having compiled 5,009 wins in a combined 204 years of head coaching experience. That averages out to nearly 25 wins a season for each coach per season.

In addition, these coaches have guided NCAA Division I teams to 37 NCAA semifinal appearances and eight NCAA titles. In the last 12 years, seven different coaches have been named the ASICS/Volleyball Magazine Coach of the Year and/or the AVCA Coach of the Year - Arizona's David Rubio (2001 ASICS), California's Rich Feller (2007 ASICS, 2010 ASICS and AVCA), Stanford's John Dunning (2001 AVCA), UCLA's Mike Sealy (2011 AVCA), USC's Mick Haley (2003 AVCA), Washington's Jim McLaughlin (2004 ASICS and AVCA), and UCLA's Andy Banachowski (2006 ASICS and AVCA).

## PAC-12 COACHES PICK STANFORD AS 2014 FAVORITE

**SAN FRANCISCO** -- In a polling of the Pac-12 Conference's 12 women's volleyball coaches, STANFORD was voted the favorite to win the 2014 regular season, the Conference office announced today. The Cardinal, who finished second last season, nabbed the top spot with 114 points, just one point more than USC.

In addition to the annual coaches poll, the Pac-12 announced the Preseason All-Pac-12 team, as voted on by the league coaches. 10 of the 14 all-Conference honorees from a year ago appear on the 15-player pre-season squad (there was a tie for last place), including seven first-, second- or third-team AVCA All-Americans.

Both Stanford and USC had five first-place votes each, with defending champion WASHINGTON receiving the last two and 106 points to place third.

The Cardinal return a lineup that includes four All-Americans and a pair of all-conference picks. Led by Hall of Fame coach John Dunning, Stanford will be seeking its Conference-record 16th crown this season. Stanford has five starters returning from last year's team that finished second in the Pac-12 standings, including four preseason all-Conference selections as well as the 2013 Pac-12 Setter of the Year Madi Bugg.

USC has a packed lineup this season, led by the last two Pac-12's Freshman of the Year and Volleyball Magazine's National Freshmen of the Year in junior Samantha Bricio (2012), also an AVCA All-American in 2013, and Ebony Nwanebu (2013).

Defending Pac-12 Champion WASHINGTON is third in the poll and will look to the 2013 Pac-12 Player of the Year Krista Vansant to lead the team in defense of its title, its first since 2005 and third overall. The Huskies are also coming off a trip to the national semifinals last year, the first 2006 and second since winning the NCAA title in 2005.

ARIZONA STATE was fourth in the polling with 73 points, the team's highest since being picked to finish that high in 1999. The Sun Devils are coming off back-to-back seasons with NCAA Tournament appearances. Both CALIFORNIA and OREGON collected 70 points each to tie for fifth in the polling. Both teams have made recent trips to the NCAA title match, with the Golden Bears advancing that far in 2010, while the Ducks did so in 2012.

Predicted to finish seventh this season is COLORADO with 62 points. The Buffs are coming off a season where they earned an NCAA Tournament bid, the team's first since 2006. UCLA, the 2011 NCAA Champion, was eighth with 58 points, followed by ARIZONA with 51 points. The Wildcats won its first-round match for the first time since 2005. UTAH also had a standout season earning its first NCAA Tournament bid last year since 2008. With 25 points, WASHINGTON STATE is 11th in the poll, with OREGON STATE placing 12th with 11 points.

Pac-12 volleyball is coming off a historic season with a league-record nine teams earning NCAA Tournament bids in 2013. UW's appearance in the national semifinals marked the fourth-consecutive year a Conference team has advanced that far. Four teams ended the season ranked in the final AVCA Coaches Poll, including three in the top 10, as eight different Pac-12 teams earned top-25 rankings at some point during the 2013 season.

## PAC-12 CELEBRATED 25 YEARS OF WOMEN'S SPORTS

The 2010 campaign marked the 25th anniversary of women's sports in the Pac-12 Conference. The Conference expanded to include women's sports in 1986-87 in 10 sports, among which was volleyball. The Conference now competes in 11 women's sports, to go along with 11 men's sports.

## PAC-12 VOLLEYBALL AT THE LONDON OLYMPICS

The Pac-12 has had a long and storied history at the Olympics, and the 2012 London Games was no exception. The Conference was well represented in London, sending over 250 athletes, delegates and officials with Pac-12 ties. In the sport of volleyball, the Conference's influence could be seen in the indoor competition and on the sand.

In the indoor competition, five former Pac-12 players were named to the Team USA squad and two on the coaching staff also had Conference affiliations with the league. In addition, former Husky Janine Sandell represented host-nation Great Britain. The USA team went on to win the silver medal.

The Conference's ties on the sand could not be overlooked. Both of Team USA's sand women's teams had Pac-12 ties. Three of the four players in the "All-American Final" were Pac-12 alumni, as the Conference added a gold and silver medal to its total medal count.

Pac-12 athletes claimed 45 total medals at the London Olympic games - 19 gold, 14 silver and 12 bronze. If the Conference was a nation, it would have ranked fifth in overall medals and in gold medals.

## PAC-12 VOLLEYBALL TELEVISION SCHEDULE

Pac-12 volleyball teams will see an unprecedented amount of television coverage for the second-straight season as the Pac-12 Networks enters its third season. In 2014, 96 matches are scheduled to be broadcast live on the Conference's Networks, six more than last season. In addition, ESPN selected three matches to be televised on ESPNU. In addition, authenticated Dish Network and cable subscribers can watch all matches televised on the Pac-12 Networks online at [www.pac-12.com](http://www.pac-12.com) and on the Pac-12 Now app.

Teams that make the postseason will also have the opportunity to have televised matches. ESPN has broadcast the regional semifinals on ESPN3.com, and the regional finals on ESPNU. The national championship matches are slated to be televised on ESPN2 on Dec. 18 and 20 from Oklahoma City where the NCAA Division I Volleyball Championship semifinals and championship matches are slated to take place.

With the launch of the Pac-12 Networks three years ago visibility and exposure for league teams across all sports increased exponentially. Pac-12 volleyball teams, alone, saw a 272 percent jump in television appearances, going from 22 televised matches to 82.
