



Pac-12 institutions have won 17 of the 41 all-time NCAA championships in women's volleyball, four more than the next closest conference (Big Ten), and four of the past 11 ... Pac-12 teams have compiled a 497-267 (.651) record in NCAA play ... Toss out the 48 postseason matches between Conference teams and the league's NCAA Tournament record against nonconference opponents stands at 449-219 (.672) ... Seven different Pac-12 programs have made NCAA semifinal appearances since 2001 and 14 of the past 21 championship matches have included at least one Pac-12 program ... A Pac-12 team has been one of the final four teams in all but five years of the NCAA Tournament (1993, 1998, 2009, 2015, 2021) and at least one Pac-12 team has played in 27 of the 41 NCAA title matches all-time, the most of any league ... Below are the records of current Pac-12 members in NCAA play. Note that, beginning in 1986, no third-place match was played. Third place is now awarded to both teams that lose in the semifinals.
