WASHINGTON TAKES OUTRIGHT LEAD AS SECOND HALF OF SEASON BEGINS

No. 3 WASHINGTON holds a slim lead over the rest of the league, but this past weekend proved the chase for the Pac-12 title is far from over ... The Huskies claimed the top spot outright in the Pac-12 standings after defeating fellow top-five team No. 4 USC in four sets and extending its win streak to seven-straight games. It marks the first time since Nov. 9, 2009 that Washington has led the Conference outright ... USC and No. 6 STANFORD share the second-place spot halfway through Conference play. A pair of victories over the weekend kept Stanford's home-court winning streak alive, having won 24-straight home matches in Maples Pavilion ... In dramatic fashion, CALIFORNIA, COLORADO and UTAH are tied for fourth-place in the Pac-12 standings. The Buffaloes and the Utes both swept the Arizona schools this past weekend, gaining steam as Utah earned its first-ever weekend sweep in Conference play and Colorado posted its third upset of the season in a 3-0 victory over then-No. 25 ARIZONA ... Pac-12 teams have recorded 14 upsets this season, nine of them coming in Conference play, and 12 of those upsets were posted by unranked league teams ... Five teams are ranked this week in the AVCA National Coaches Poll, with Washington, USC and Stanford remaining at their respective spots at No. 3, 4 and 6 for the second-straight week. The Bears, which earned victories over No. 20 OREGON and OREGON STATE, enter the weekend ranked No. 22 in the AVCA National Coaches Poll, while the Ducks are now ranked 23rd. Both Colorado and Utah received votes ... With nine games scheduled to be broadcast on the Pac-12 Networks, including two matchups between top-25 ranked teams, this upcoming week will prove to be another challenge for all Conference schools ... Washington's Lianna Sybeldon was voted Pac-12 Offensive Player of the Week, while Utah's Erin Redd-Brandon took home her second-career Defensive Player of the Week honor and California's Maddy Kerr earned Freshman of the Week.

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. - The Pac-12 Conference office announced the Pac-12 Volleyball Players of the Week for the week of October 21-27. WASHINGTON's **Lianna Sybeldon** was named the Conference's Offensive Player of the Week, UTAH's **Erin Redd-Brandon** was voted the Defensive Player of the Week and CALIFORNIA's **Maddy Kerr** was tabbed the league's Freshman of the Week.

Sophomore **Lianna Sybeldon** (Folsom, Calif.) helped the Huskies earn their first road sweep of UCLA and USC since the 2008 season, moving UW into sole possession of first-place in the Pac-12 with a 9-1 record. The middle blocker had 12 kills on a .400 attack percentage plus seven blocks in the four-set win at UCLA on Friday. She topped that with a new career-high 15 kills on a .462 percentage at No. 4 USC on Sunday evening, adding five more blocks for a career-high 18.0 points. The Huskies snapped a 16-match home-winning streak for the Trojans. For the weekend, Sybeldon averaged 3.38 kills per set and 1.50 blocks per set while hitting .431.

Senior middle blocker **Erin Redd-Brandon** (Spanish Fork, Utah) led an impressive Utah block last weekend, helping the Utes claim their first-ever Pac-12 weekend sweep with victories over Arizona State and No. 25 Arizona. Redd-Brandon averaged 2.67 kills and 0.56 service aces per set, and secured her fourth double-double of the season with 15 kills and 10 blocks on Thursday in a five-set victory over Arizona State. She posted a .333 hitting percentage on the attack with only five errors on a season-high 31 attempts against the Sun Devils. She was again dominant at the net in the upset win over the 25th-ranked Wildcats, recording eight blocks, while also serving a career-high four aces and hit .333 with nine kills. The win on Sunday was Utah's first victory over Arizona since Nov. 30, 2002 and the fifth all-time.

Freshman libero **Maddy Kerr** (San Diego, Calif.) had one of the most memorable defensive performances in Cal history during the Bears' five-set upset win over No. 20 Oregon. She registered a school-record tying 33 digs in the victory, also the second-highest in the Pac-12 this season. It was only the 10th time in Cal history someone has had at least 30 digs in a match. Kerr added 12 digs against Oregon State to average 4.50 digs per set for the week.

It is Sybeldon's first-career weekly honor and Washington's 40th all-time. It is the second-career weekly honor for Redd-Brandon, earning a defensive nod for her performance during the opening week of the season. It is the third weekly recognition all-time for the Utes, all coming this season. Kerr earns the freshman nod for the first time this season and the fourth for a Cal rookie all-time.

Weekly awards have been selected every week of the season since the Conference began sponsoring women's volleyball in 1986. It is the third year the Pac-12 has announced an offensive, defensive and rookie honoree. Freshman of the week honors are not included in the all-time totals for each institution.

CONFERENCE NOTES

AROUND THE LEAGUE

• **AVCA Rankings...** For the eighth time this season, five Pac-12 teams are ranked in the top 25 of the AVCA Coaches poll. Three of those teams are in the top 10: No. 3 Washington, No. 4 USC and No. 6 Stanford. Also ranked are No. 22 California and No. 23 Oregon.

At least five Pac-12 teams have been ranked in the poll since Sept. 9, 2002; that is a span of 184-straight weeks.

Eight of the 12 Pac-12 teams have earned a top-25 ranking at least once this season.

• **Spreading the wealth...** Every Pac-12 team has three or more players with at least 100 kills on the year, showing the depth of offense throughout the Conference. Utah leads with six players registering more than 100 kills. Nineteen student-athletes throughout the Pac-12 have 200 kills or more through the season so far and three with 300-plus.

• **Double-double whammy...** An astonishing 45 players have registered a double-double so far this season, led by Penina Snuka of Arizona who has 11 total on the year. Nine student-athletes have recorded eight or more, including two freshmen: Snuka and Kyra Holt of Washington State.

• **A note on records...** ARIZONA's 10 non-conference victories are the most since 2010. That year, the Wildcats posted its 11th 20-win campaign and advanced to the NCAA Tournament ... ARIZONA STATE matched its non-conference win total from a year ago, logging 11 victories.

Last year's 11 non-conference wins was the first time since 1992 the Sun Devils had recorded double-digit non-league wins ... CALIFORNIA's seven non-conference wins are one win better than a year ago when it won just six matches. The best start in recent history was in 2011 when the Bears went 10-0 in non-conference play ... COLORADO's eight non-conference wins are two fewer than last season, when the Buffs went 10-2 through the pre-conference season ... OREGON's seven non-conference wins marks the tenth-consecutive year the Ducks have recorded at least that many non-league victories. UO has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in all but two years during that span ... OREGON STATE's nine non-league wins marks the fourth time in six years the Beavers have won at least that many non-conference matches ... STANFORD's 7-2 non-conference record is the eighth time in the past nine years that the Cardinal has posted two or fewer losses heading into Pac-12 play... UCLA's nine non-conference wins are the most since winning 10 in 2010 ... It is the fourth time in six years USC has posted double-digit non-conference victories ... UTAH's 10 non-conference wins marks only the second time in the last seven years the Utes have recorded double-digit non-conference victories ... WASHINGTON recorded eight victories in this non-conference season, which is the first time since 2001 that the Huskies have posted fewer than nine...

UPSET CITY

Pac-12 teams have pulled off impressive victories this season, including several upsets.

The biggest non-conference upset to-date, was a straight-set victory by Arizona State over then-No. 2 Texas. In just the first two weeks of the Conference season, Colorado knocked off two ranked opponents, including then-No. 1 Washington. A second No. 1 team went down when then-unranked Arizona knocked off top-ranked USC on Oct. 20 in straight sets. With five Pac-12 teams nationally ranked, the potential for upsets is imminent each week.

WASHINGTON STATE's 13 non-conference wins are the most since 2002 when the Cougars equaled that mark and made the NCAA Tournament.

- **Break out the brooms...** Of the 29 victories earned by Pac-12 squads in the opening weekend, 18 of them were three-set sweeps. Only three teams saw a match go five sets (Utah vs. Utah State, Washington vs. Gonzaga, Washington State vs. Seton Hall); all other matches took four or fewer sets to resolve. Pac-12 teams posted a 73-4 record in three-set matches in non-conference, regular-season play for a 94.8 winning percentage.

- **Underclassman power...** This year's incoming class has already made their mark on Pac-12 volleyball. At least one freshman and/or one sophomore rank in the top 10 in the Conference in kills, assists, service aces, digs, and points. Of those underclassmen, four rank in the top-25 nationally in their respective categories as listed below:

Samantha Bricio, SO, USC: 1st in aces per set (.78)
 Macey Gardner, SO, ASU: 16th in kills per set (4.51); 23rd in points per set (4.85)
 Madi Bugg, SO, STAN: 11th in assists per set (11.58)
 Inky Ajanaku, STAN: 21st in hitting percentage (.405), 22nd in blocks per set (1.36)

- **Tournament honors all around...** In the third week of play, nine league teams won their respective tournaments outright. Utah, Washington State and USC all won their third-consecutive regular-season tournament. In total, Pac-12 teams have won 23 tournaments through three weeks, and all 12 teams have earned at least one tournament title.

- With Oregon's appearance in the NCAA Championship match last season, it marked the third-straight year, and 11 of the last 12 years, a Pac-12 team has played in the national championship match.

- Seven Pac-12 players have been named the AVCA National Player of the Year since 2001, including the last three-straight years. In all, 12 league players have earned the national honor. Oregon's Alaina Bergsma was the most recent honoree, leading the Ducks' to their first-ever NCAA final in her final campaign.

- **Bring it on...** In order to prepare for the rigorous Pac-12 schedule, league teams schedule tough non-conference matches. Of the 125 non-conference tilts on the 2013 docket, 25 are against teams that competed in last year's NCAA Tournament.

- **Fear the Underclassmen...** The underclassmen in the Pac-12 are the majority again this year, but they do not outnumber the upperclassmen as much as they have the last couple of years. In 2010, the underclassmen outnumbered the upperclassmen 2-to-1. The scales tipped a little less in 2011, but there was still a large disparity (127 freshmen/sophomores to 69 juniors/seniors). In 2012, the gap between lower and upperclassmen was a little closer at 109-77. In 2013, freshmen and sophomores account for 112 of the 197 Pac-12 volleyball players, nearly 57 percent of league rosters. Pac-12 rosters include 59 freshmen, 53 sophomores, 50 juniors and 35 seniors. COLORADO has the most number of freshmen with seven, while OREGON STATE and WASHINGTON have the fewest at just three. With what looks to be a young league again, the Beavers have just one senior on the team (but six juniors), while four teams have just two seniors on the roster.

- **FAB Freshmen...** Pac-12 volleyball continues to recruit marquee student-athletes. Eight Pac-12 institutions landed at least one *Volleyball Magazine* FAB 50 recruit. Here's a list of those freshmen who should make significant contributions to Pac-10 volleyball:

HISTORICALLY SPEAKING...

- The Pac-12 has captured six of the last 12 NCAA crowns (2011 - UCLA, 2005 - Washington, 2004 - Stanford, 2003 - USC, 2002 - USC, 2001 - Stanford) and 14 NCAA titles overall.

- The Pac-12 has had 10 or more All-Americans selections in six of the last eight years. Last year, eight were named to the AVCA All-America squad. First team selections in 2012 were Alaina Bergsma (ORE), Natalie Hagglund (USC), Tabi Love (UCLA), Lauren Plum (ORE) and Carly Wopat (STAN). Second team selections were Lis Brenner (ORE) and Krista Vansant (WASH), while Katie Fuller (USC) was named to the third team. Twelve former Pac-12 players have earned All-America honors four times, while another 27 players in all have earned All-American honors three times. Since 1990, Pac-12 players garnered AVCA Player of the Year honors 12 times, including the last three years - CAL's Carli Lloyd (2010), USC's Alex Jupiter (2011) and ORE's Alaina Bergsma (2012). The NCAA Honda Sports Award honor has been bestowed upon a Pac-12 volleyball player 12 times, including Bergsma in 2012.

- The current group of Pac-12 volleyball coaches enters the 2013 season having compiled 4,764 Division I victories in a combined 209 years of head coaching experience. That averages out to nearly 23 wins a season for each coach per season.

In addition, these coaches have guided NCAA Division I teams to 36 NCAA Final Four appearances and eight NCAA titles. In the last 11 years, seven different coaches have been named the ASICS/Volleyball Magazine Coach of the Year and/or the AVCA Coach of the Year - Arizona's David Rubio (2001 ASICS), California's Rich Feller (2007 ASICS, 2010 ASICS and AVCA), Stanford's John Dunning (2001 AVCA), UCLA's Mike Sealy (2011 AVCA), USC's Mick Haley (2003 AVCA), Washington's Jim McLaughlin (2004 ASICS and AVCA), and UCLA's Andy Banachowski (2006 ASICS and AVCA). Pac-12 coaches have won the national coach of the year honor in two of the last three seasons.

- The 2010 campaign marked the 25th anniversary of women's sports in the Pac-12 Conference. The Conference expanded to include women's sports in 1986-87 in 10 sports, among which was volleyball. The Conference now competes in 11 women's sports, to go along with 11 men's sports.

- The Pac-12 has had a long and storied history at the Olympics, and the 2012 London Games was no exception. The Conference was well represented in London, sending over 250 athletes, delegates and officials with Pac-12 ties. In the sport of volleyball, the Conference's influence could be seen in the indoor competition and on the sand.

In the indoor competition, five former Pac-12 players were named to the Team USA squad and two on the coaching staff also had Conference affiliations with the league. In addition, former Husky Janine Sandell represented host-nation Great Britain. The USA team went on to win the silver medal.

The Conference's ties on the sand could not be overlooked. Both of Team USA's sand women's teams had Pac-12 ties. Three of the four players in the "All-American Final" were Pac-12 alumni, as the Conference added a gold and silver medal to its total medal count.

Pac-12 athletes claimed 45 total medals at the London Olympic games - 19 gold, 14 silver and 12 bronze. If the Conference was a nation, it would have ranked fifth in overall medals and in gold medals.

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- In a polling of the Conference's 12 women's volleyball coaches, STANFORD was voted the preseason favorite to win the 2013 Pac-12 regular season, the Conference office announced today. The defending Pac-12 Champion Cardinal received 120 points and 10 first-place votes.

In addition to the annual coaches poll, the Pac-12 announced the first-ever Preseason All-Pac-12 team, as voted on by the league coaches. 10 of the 14 all-conference honorees from a year ago appear on the 14-player preseason team, including five first- or second-team AVCA All-Americans.

The Cardinal claimed its league-record 15th Pac-12 regular-season crown last year despite four freshmen in the starting lineup. This year, Hall of Fame coach John Dunning welcomes back the entire starting lineup, as well as AVCA first-team All-American Carly Wopat.

Voted second in the poll was USC, who picked up 111 points and two first-place votes. The Trojans return armed with 2012 Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and Volleyball Magazine National Freshman of the Year Samantha Bricio, as well as two-time Pac-12 Libero of the Year and two-time All-American Natalie Hagglund.

Third in the polling is WASHINGTON with 96 points, followed by NCAA runner-up OREGON with 91 points. UCLA, who is just two years removed from winning the NCAA title, garnered 76 points to place fifth in the poll. ARIZONA STATE had its best finish in Pac-12 play since 2000 last year, ending the year tied for sixth. The league coaches predicted another sixth-place finish for the Sun Devils in 2013.

CALIFORNIA is just four years from its NCAA runner-up showing and was voted to finish seventh this season, collecting 59 points. ARIZONA was voted eighth with 52 points, while UTAH was voted ninth with 49 points. COLORADO was voted to finish 10th in the Pac-12 standings in 2013 (30), while WASHINGTON STATE was 11th in the polling (21) and OREGON STATE was 12th (19).

The preseason coaches poll has been administered every year since the first season of Pac-12 women's volleyball in 1986. It has predicted the regular-season champion correctly 17 times in 27 years.

Pac-12 teams have traditionally been among the best in the nation. In 2012, six teams were ranked in the top 25 in the nation at some point during the season, with five spending most of the year in the top 10, including two teams earning No. 1 rankings for several weeks. In addition, seven teams earned NCAA Tournament bids in 2012, with the Ducks advancing to the national championship match for the first time in the history of the program.

PAC-12 VOLLEYBALL TELEVISION SCHEDULE

Pac-12 volleyball teams will see an unprecedented amount of television coverage for the second-straight season as the Pac-12 Networks enters its second season. In 2013, 90 matches are scheduled to be broadcast live on the Conference's Networks, eight more than last season. In addition, ESPN selected three matches to be televised on ESPNU. In addition, authenticated Dish Network and cable subscribers can watch all matches televised on the Pac-12 Networks online at www.pac-12.com and on the Pac-12 Now app.

Teams that make the postseason will also have the opportunity to have televised matches. ESPN has broadcast the regional semifinals on ESPN3.com, and the regional finals on ESPNU. The national championship matches are slated to be televised on ESPN2 on Dec. 19 and 21 from Seattle where the University of Washington will play host to the NCAA Division I Volleyball Championship semifinals and championship matches.

With the launch of the Pac-12 Networks last season visibility and exposure for league teams across all sports increased exponentially. Pac-12 volleyball teams, alone, saw a 272 percent jump in television appearances, going from 22 televised matches to 82.
